## Objectives of top-top ISIC

- To have a common top-top ISIC structure for international data reporting system of about 10 aggregate categories.
- To keep changes as little as possible in order to maintain consistency in historical time series.
- To show important top-top category such as information industry that did not exist before. This includes:
  - Publishing, audiovisual, broadcasting
  - Telecommunications
  - IT services
- However, a break seems to be unavoidable. For instance, publishing is part of manufacturing in ISIC Rev 3.
