City Profiling & Benchmarking Process

Collection of **statistical data** via remote research in January 2014.

Interviews with, e.g. representatives from city administrations in UB (11), Da Nang (11) and Korat (9) in February 2014.

Develop 13 Success Factors for sustainable urban development in the Urban Nexus cities and a list of impact factors, March-May 2014.

Expert evaluation: local experts rating the influence an impact factor has on every single success factor in their city in June 2014.

Assessment of expert evaluation: most promising success factors and defining most important impact factors per city in June 2014.

Organization & Structure


- Usage of cross-sectoral communication models within the city administration.
- Municipal authority as motivation for responsible development.
- Civil Participation enables sustainable urban development.
- Improving general education and specialized epertise structures.

Strategy & Planning


- Defining a city's management model for strategic value creation.
- Comprehensive Sector strategies for strategic urban development.
- Good financial condition as door opener to urban development.
- Usage of statistical data for informed municipal decision-making.

Methods & Levers

- Accomplishing successful law enforcement.
- Urban Services: Regulation and Incentives creating municipal income.
- Sustainability awareness and motivation for sustainable actions.
- Establishing successful urban planning tools.
- Acknowledging private sector inclusion in urban development.

- Most supportive impact
 - Collective understanding
 - International attention
 - Fast city growth
 - Specialized expertise
 - Transparency

- Most limiting impact
 - Continuity of actions
 - Delay of budget allocation
 - Bureaucratic and long processes
 - Outdated infrastructure





Evaluation Korat

- Most promising Urban Governance Success Factors for Korat
 - Municipal authority as motivation for responsible urban development
 - Defining a city's management model for strategic value creation
 - Including Civil Participation Structures for sustainable development
- Most supportive impact
 - Specialized expertise in municipal administration
 - Cross-departmental knowledge sharing
 - Collective understanding
 - Transpareny

- Most limiting impact
 - Delay of budget allocation
 - Bureaucratic and long processes





High-Potential Success Factors for the Urban Nexus Partner Cities

Usage of statistical data for informed municipal decision-making

- Not yet recognized for its value by decision-makers
- Collection, analysis, interpretation, provision

Usage of cross-sectoral communication models


- Active implementation from top level needed
- Cross-departmental / interdisciplinary exchange and joint projects
- Integrating constructive feedback mechanisms into municipal administration structures

Improvements in specialized expertise

Comprehensive capacity building programs for municipal personnel
