# Modernisation of German-Vietnamese Development Cooperation (2011-2013) Momentum for Change

- Viet Nam is a Middle Income Country, not ODA-dependent
- 'Socio-economic Development Plan' and 'National Green Growth Strategy' of the Vietnamese Government describe new strategic priorities
- Strategic Partnership a new quality of cooperation between Germany and Viet Nam
- Institutional reforms initiated by BMZ: Merger of GIZ;
   Strengthening of political dialogue via placement of second development counselor at German Embassy






# Modernisation of German-Vietnamese Development Cooperation (2011-2013) Challenges

- Sectoral fragmentation: De facto 8 sectors covered including subsectors
- Regional fragmentation: Project sites located in too many regions: challenge for the steering and administration of projects (high transaction costs)
- High diversity of project partners as a challenge for the policy dialogue
- Lack of coherence: Too many stand-alone projects
- 'Energy' Highest financial commitment (financial cooperation) but not yet a priority area



## Modernisation of German-Vietnamese Development Cooperation (2011-2013) Elements





#### **DOING MORE in LESS AREAS:**

From traditional development cooperation to a strategic partnership

- Selectivity: From 8 sectors to 3 priority areas
- Green Growth as the overarching framework
- Selected alignment to Viet Nam's development priorities and goals
- Concentration on 1-2 strategic regions in each sector
- Strengthening of the policy dialogue Embassy/VNM-Government
- Integrated programmes instead of projects: Technical and financial cooperation under one programme concept and set of goals
- Integration of matters of social inclusion, participation (political) and partnership with private sectors into the priority areas

# Contributions of GDC to environmental and climate protection

- Sustainable Forestry of over 270,000 hectare forest
- Preservation and sustainable protection of biodiversity within and outside of protected areas
- Implementation of FSC-certification for sustainable forest management of natural forests of State Forest Enterprises (so far about 50,000 hectares of natural forest have been FSCcertified)
- Protection of coastal cities from flooding through climate-proof flood risk management (drainage plans, early warning systems, emergency plans)
- Development and promotion of approaches for coastal protection (amongst others sustainable mangrove and melaleuca-forest cultivation and reforestation) in the Mekong Delta
- Raising public awareness about the consequences of climate change and the meaning of coastal forests
- Development of **educational material** to raise environmental awareness in secondary schools and senior classes.

# Programme Reform of Technical and Vocational Education and Training

# **Contribution of GDC to Vocational Training in Viet Nam**

- Development of a vocational training strategy until 2020
- Advisory on TVET law revision
- Strengthening the cooperation between vocational training institutes and enterprises (e.g. PPPs with German enterprises).
- Development of demand-oriented vocational training courses in metal work, electrotechnics/electronic and mechatronics
- Development and piloting of practiceoriented training models for TVET teachers
- Development of TVET sector monitoring (e.g. first Vietnamese TVET report)
- Strengthen regional exchange of experiences in vocational training.
- Raise awareness on vocational training

# Contribution to renewable energy/energy efficiency in Viet Nam

- Objective until 2020: Increase the share of renewable energies in overall electricity production to 4.5 per cent, resp. 6 per cent until 2030
- Design of legal and regulatory framework conditions for wind, bio and PV solar energy
- Strengthen professional and institutional capacities on local and central Government level and private sector;
- Promote technology development through cooperation among private sector and scientific institutions in Viet Nam and Germany
- Foster policy-making for EE promotion through systematic stocktaking and data-analysis as well as macro-economic cost-benefit analysis
- Reduction of energy losses on supply side (transmission and distribution) and improvement of demand side management (DSM) as well as introduction of smart grid technology





#### **KEY ACTIVITIES OUTSIDE PRIORITY AREAS**

### Wastewater Management for Provincial Centers

**Key targets:** supports the framework conditions for effective, efficient and sustainable wastewater (WW) management.

#### 3 Components:

- National level: Policy advice to the Ministry of Construction
- Provincial level: Policy advice for the Provincial People's Council and public administration in nine provinces
- Local level: Training and advice for nine wastewater service providers

# Contribution of GDC to sustainable wastewater management in Viet Nam

- Improvement of financial and institutional incentives for sustainable WW management through new national wastewater legislation.
- Provincial orientation plans facilitate effective implementation of local regulation, WW tariffs and performance-based management contracts with WW service providers.
- 850 000 customers of WW service providers in the nine cities benefit from improved operation and maintenance of sewerage systems and better customer management.
- Vertical and horizontal sector dialogue builds consensus and creates ownership at all levels.
- → Multi-level approach encourages replication and scaling-up!








# Programme locations (Phase 3)

 9 provinces in the North, Central and South of Vietnam


