What is Global P & R on Censuses?

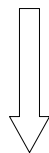
- 2010 World Programme on Population and Housing Censuses (2005-2014)
- UNSD to revise P & R for Population and Housing Censuses Rev 1
- P & R guides countries on census planning, implementation and dissemination

The Process

- International consultative process
 - UN Regional Commissions
 - Sub-regional organizations
 - NSOs from various regions
- Unprecedented consultation
 - Reflect views of stakeholders
 - Joint ownership

Highlights of Rev 2

- Topics non-core in Rev 1, proposed as core in Rev2
 - Births/Deaths in the past 12 months
 - Infant deaths in the past 12 months
 - Disability status
 - Year or period of arrival
 - Fuel used for cooking
 - Main source of drinking water
 - IT & communication devices in the HH

Highlights of Rev 2.....

- Outputs that are crucial for
 - Evidence based decision making
 - National policy planning and monitoring
 - Essential data needs of individual countries
 - International comparability

Highlights of Rev 2.....

P & R provides guidelines to generate

- Set of essential/recommended tabulations
- Variables
- Detailed statistics at the lowest geographical level

Highlights of Rev 2.....

- 27 basic/essential tabulations (top priority)
- 54 Recommended tabulations
- Optimum set (Basic + Recommended +60 additional tabulations)
- In Rev 1 – 103 tabulations not classified

Promoting Global P & R

- Objectives
 - To raise awareness of P & R
 - To increase national capacity in implementing international standards
 - To systematically adapt international standards

Proposed activities

- Regional workshop
- Targeted SIAP training courses
- Advisory services
- Establish network of regional experts
- Exchange expertise through South-South Cooperation, on-line working group or census newsletter
