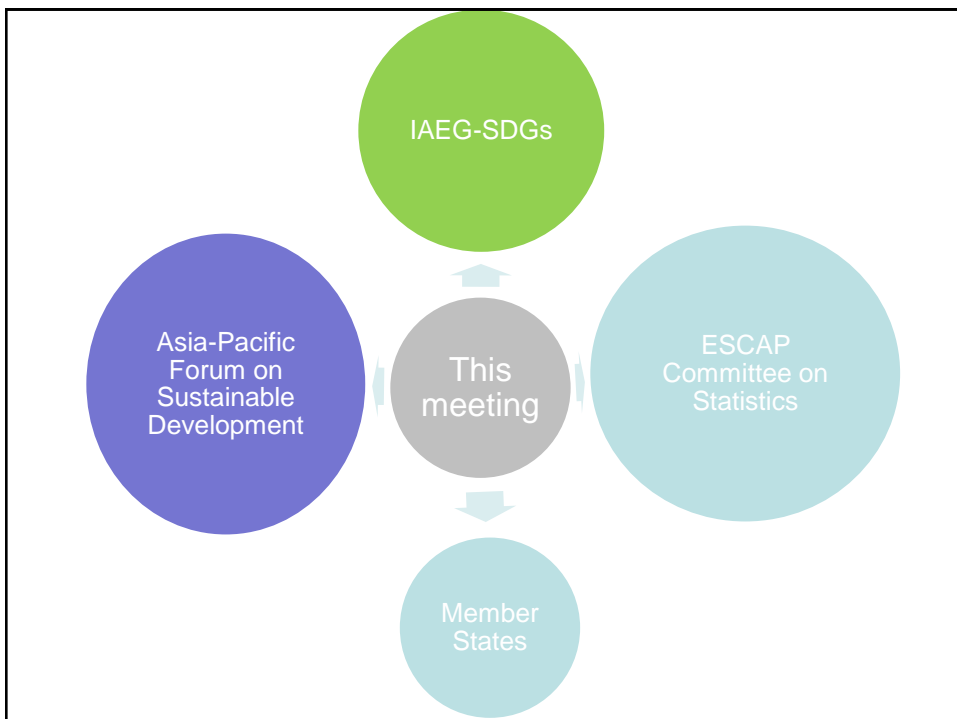

 - Review of existing regional initiatives for improved coordination, in view of SDGs agenda

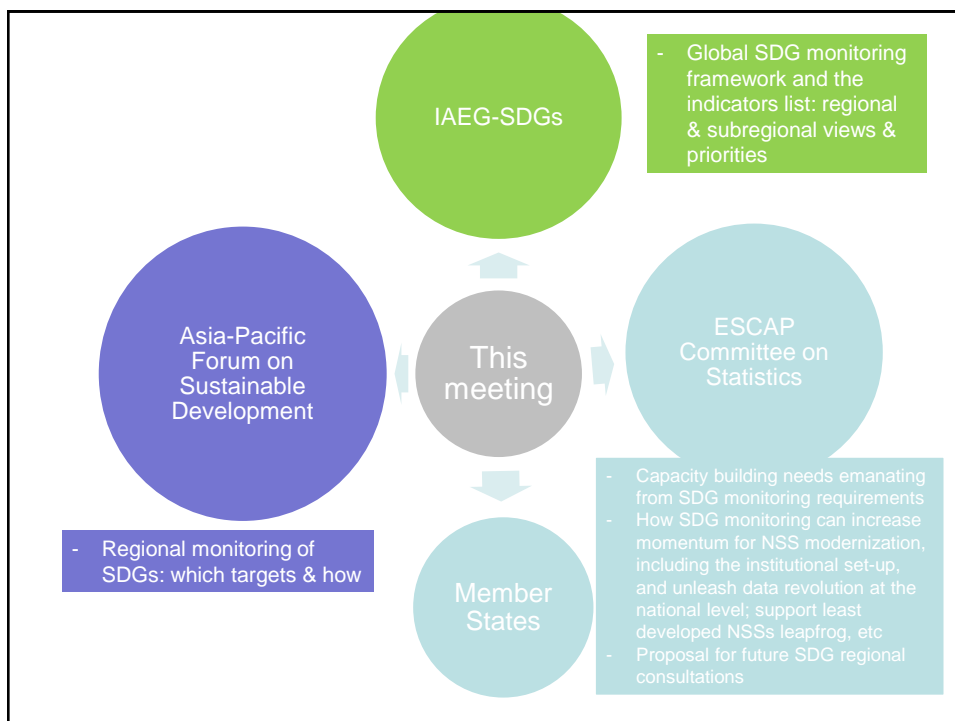

Example of two targets

Target 1.1 By 2030, eradicate extreme poverty for all people everywhere, currently measured as people living on less than \$1.25 a day.

Target 1.2 By 2030, reduce at least by half the proportion of men, women and children of all ages living in poverty in all dimensions according to national definitions.
