Three National SDGs consultations and PSA review of indicators released by the IAEG SDGs in its first meeting

- **First Technical Workshop on the Universal Goals and National Targets**
 - Organizer: planning ministry
 - Participants; different sectors
 - September 2013
 - review and discuss the global post-2015 development agenda goals and targets submitted by the High-Level Panel of Eminent Persons on the Post-2015 Development Agenda (HLPEP)

1. National SDGs consultations(cont'n)

- Second Technical Workshop on the Proposed SDGs
 - Organizer: planning ministry
 - Participants: different sectors with PSA giving statistical perspective
 - September 2014
 - 17 SDGs were discussed, examined and analyzed to determine what the country will hope to achieve in 2030 and what data are needed to monitor our progress
 - a venue in identifying responsible agencies, committees and other actors responsible for monitoring achievements

1. National SDGs consultations(cont'n)

- Second Technical Workshop on the Proposed SDGs(continuation)
 - overarching recommendation of the consultations:
 - SDGS should be grounded on respect for universal human rights
 - core SDG is eradication of extreme poverty with a mutually agreed timeline among countries (Goal 1)
 - SDGs need to be guided by a set of unified and universal goals or outcomes that apply to all countries
 - final list of SDG targets are measurable, indicators are available or can be made available, and relevant

1. National SDGs consultations(cont'n)

- Third Technical Workshop on the Zero Draft Outcome Document for the UN Summit in September 2015
 - Organizer: planning ministry
 - Participants:planning ministry
 - June 2015
 - review and discuss the zero-draft of the outcome document for the United Nations Summit entitled “Transforming Our World by 2030 – A New Agenda for Global Action”

1. National SDGs consultations(cont'n)

- PSA review of the list of SDGs indicators from the IAEG SDGs and the national review in September 2014
 - Internal assessment by the Social Sector Statistics Service of PSA
 - August 2015
 - Assessment used:
 - National priority indicators as provided in the national development agenda;
 - Indicators that have clearly demonstrated its actual policy/program use
 - Feasibility of monitoring the indicators (e.g., availability and/or established methodologies); and
 - Past and current experience in monitoring the MDGs.
 - Output is the list classified as:
 - Indicators **already in the proposal** whose inclusion in the list is perceived to be imperative
 - Indicators **not included in the proposal** whose inclusion in the list is perceived to be necessary

3. SDG targets for national/global monitoring

- All targets are being considered for monitoring in the national level but shall do a fourth workshop in October 2015 after UNGA in September 2015
- PSA listed indicators that should stay in the list for global monitoring and suggested others not in the list of IAEG SDGs

Goal 1	Maintain poverty line but address different dimensions of poverty>>MPI	Based on Phil Development Plan and MDGs
Goal 4	Primary completion rate, literacy rate of 15 to 24 years old	Based on Phil Development Plan and MDGs

Goal 5	Ratio of girls to boys in primary education, share of women in wage employment in the non-agricultural sector, proportion of seats held by women in the national parliament	Based on Phil Development Plan and MDGs
