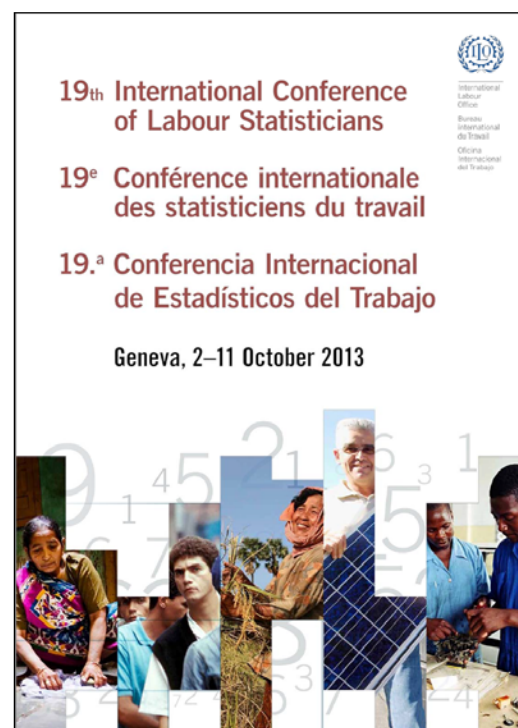

In October 2013 the 19th ICLS adopted a *Resolution concerning statistics of work, employment and labour underutilization* updating the previous standards on the economically active population, employment, unemployment and underemployment (13th ICLS, 1982), used by most countries as a basis to produce their official national statistics on the labour force.

The new standards introduce major advances: a conceptual framework for work statistics, a refined definition of employment, and expanded measures of labour underutilization beyond the traditional unemployment rate.

The Seminar will discuss the above new advances in labour statistics standards, with a particular focus on the new definition of employment and its possible implications for employment indicators.
