


Development Sustainable

- Coordinating the line government agencies in the national implementation framework of the SDGs
- Identifying national priorities and their indicators related global goals and targets
- Ensuring yearly country report on SDGs
- Ensuring adaptation of the state programs and strategies to SDGs covering country's socio-economic fields
- Attracting local and foreign experts, specialists, international organizations and scientific institutions to its activity
- Establishing working groups in different directions related SDGs



Line government agencies - centeral and local executive authorities as well as legal entities that control package shares (interests) belonging to the state

Identifying national priorities and their indicators related global goals and targets




3 Working Groups under the State Statistical Committee (SSC)

Aim of the working groups including officials from the relevant government agencies is to ensure necessary measures:

- to eliminate duplication on data submitted to government agencies
- > to enlarge usage of administrative data in official statistics
- to integration of the administrative data to the SSC's database



3 working groups was established under the State Statistical Committee in accordance with administrative records on statistical domains:



3 Working Groups under the State Statistical Committee (SSC) are going:

- to investigate opportunities of usage of the administrative and register data of government agencies for the purposes of official statistics;
- to align methodologically applicable indicators by statistical domains for official statistics and reviewing SDGs;
- to take necessary measures about integration of the data on appropriate indicators to statistical databases

Total 117 responsible persons for statistics from relevant government agencies by <u>SSC's initiative & Concil's mandate</u> on the basis of <u>PRESIDENTIAL DECREE</u>:

- ✓ Ministries 17
- ✓ State Committees 5
- ✓ Services 5
- ✓ Stock companies 10
- ✓ Law enforcement authority 1
- ✓ Transport organization 1
- ✓ Bank 1
- ✓ Law Enforcement Agencies 2
- ✓ Local executive authorities 77

4 and 8th items of the Presidential Decree



Responsibility of SSC in measuring & monitoring of SDGs indicators as a Council member:

- · Production statistical data and metadata for SDGs global indicators
- Coordination production SDGs indicators in country
- · Developing SDG indicators according to national conditions
- · Developing new data source
- Sharing information and communication
- Quality control
- Checking data

Strategic support for development of National Statistics System

- Long-term strategy on the use of administrative data, adopted by the Order № 31/01s of the State Statistical Committee of the Republic of Azerbaijan dated 26 September 2014
- Strategic Plan of The State Statistical Committee of The Republic of Azerbaijan for 2014-2017 adopted by the decree of the State Statistical Committee of the Republic of Azerbaijan dated October 29, 2014, № 151/t)
- The State Program on Improvement of the Official Statistics in the Republic of Azerbaijan in 2018-2022, under drafting
