






### **TRANSPORTATION**

"The action of moving someone or something or the process of being moved using power, labor, infrastructure, and mode."







### **LOGISTICS**


"Logistics is the strategic coordination of activities of transportation and warehousing that fuel the production and trading of goods and services."



- Lack of centralized data on transport, logistics and shipping
- Limited marketing and promotion


### Enterprise constraints

- Limited capacities of seaport terminals and airports



#### **Strengths**

- Located on busy East-West maritime trade links
- Trans-shipment hub for India
- Modern port facilities to handle large container vessels (>9,000 TEUs)
- Availability of land

#### **Opportunities**

- E-commerce hub for South Asia
- Ability to offer higher value chain activities in global trade
- Growth in vessel size and consolidation of shipping lines
- Belt and Road initiatives, able to act as hub for South Asia for trade

Indian growth

#### Weaknesses

- Port capacity limited by facilities and equipment
- The airport, Jaya Container Terminal and South Asia Gateway

#### **Threats**


- India is revamping its port operations and the Indian Government has worked to reduce the reliance of Indian shippers on Colombo
