

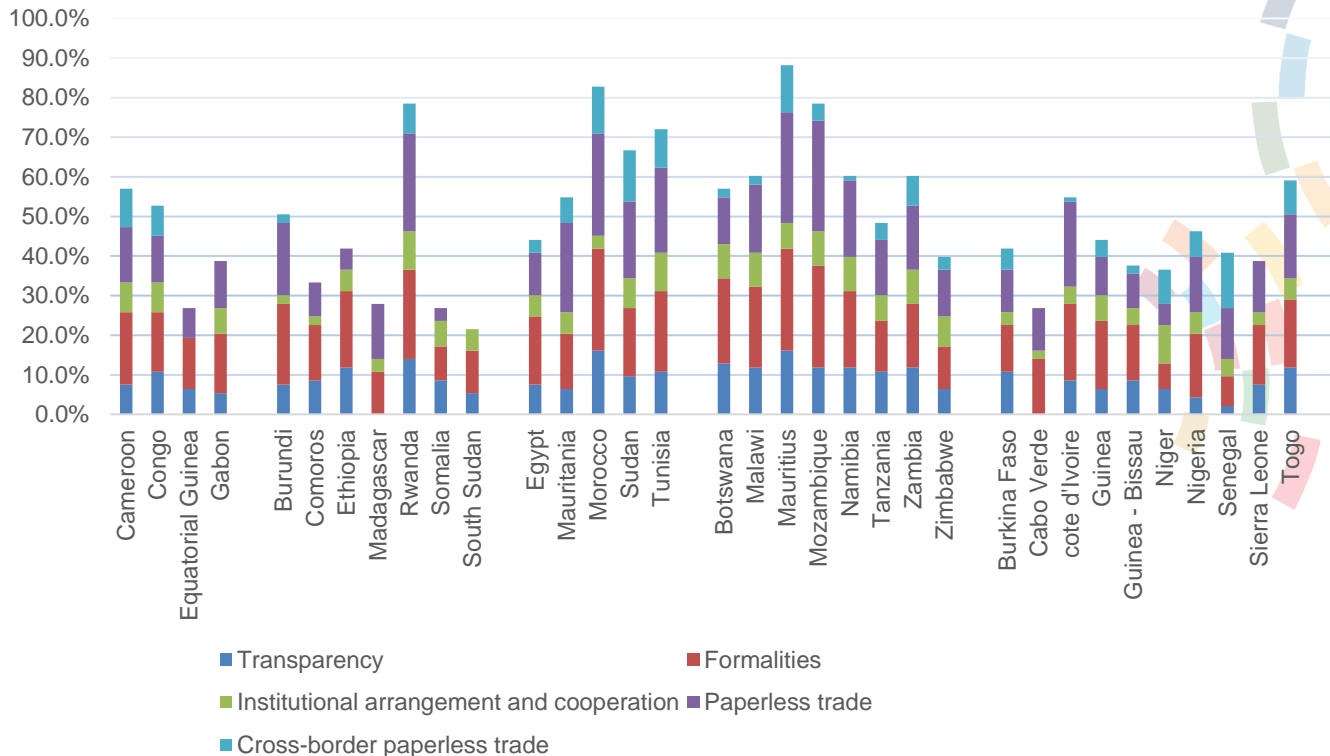

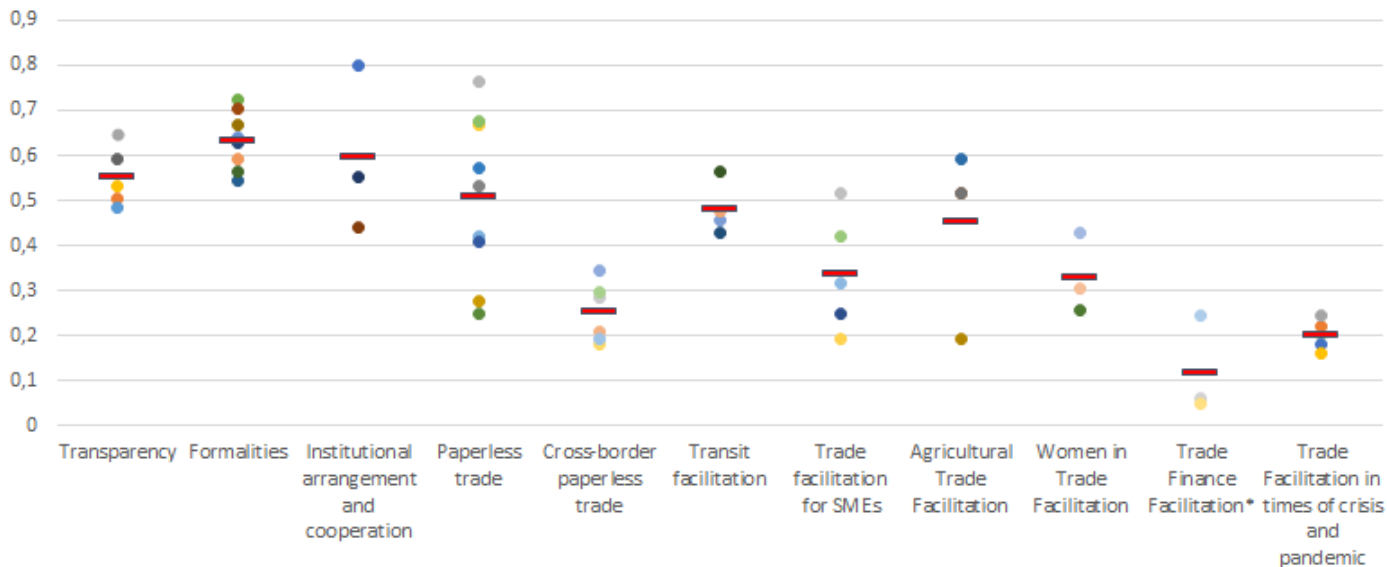
Implementation of Trade Facilitation in Africa

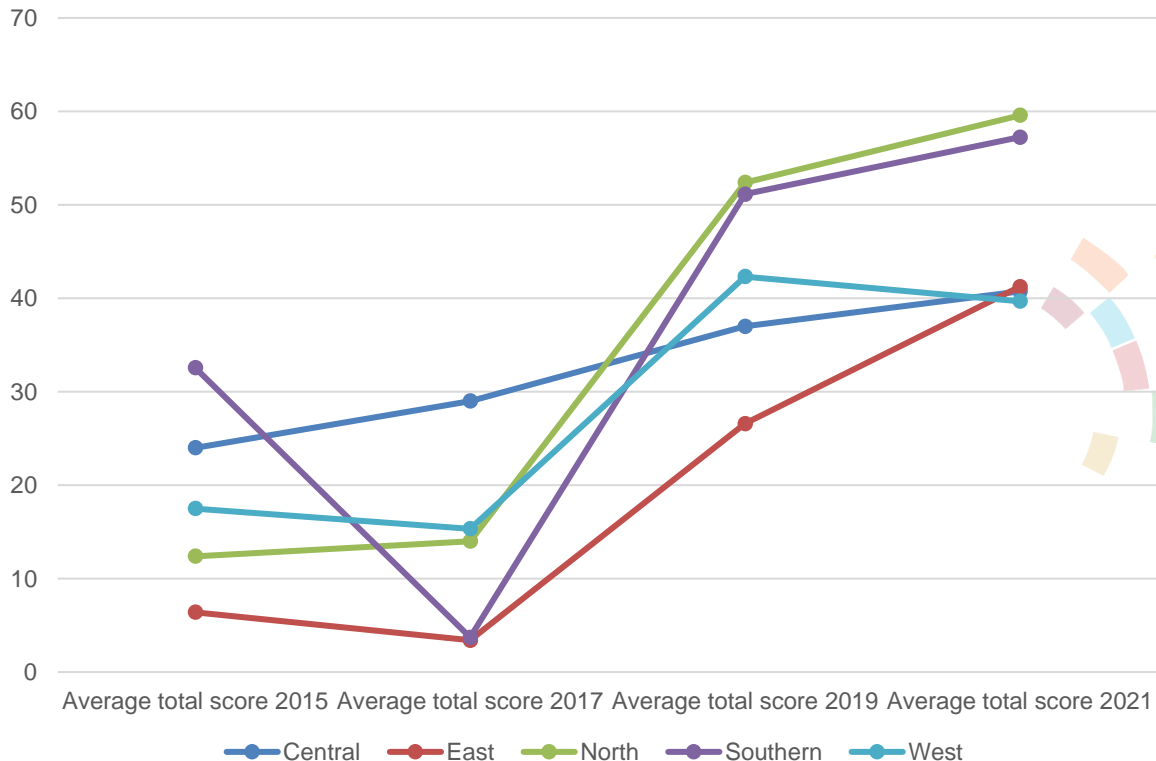
Average Rates by Measure

Comparison of implementation rate in 2015, 2017, 2019 & 2021

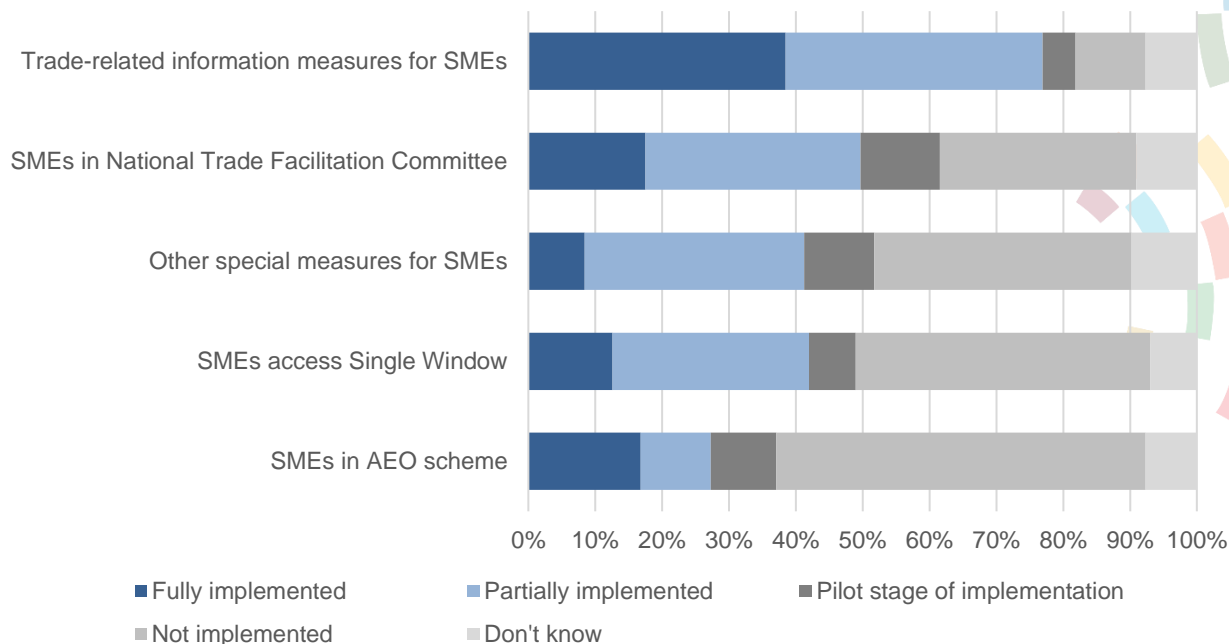

- Slight progress in TF implementation in spite of COVID-19 implications
- Compared to the Global level of TF implantation Africa is lagging behind
- Paperless Trade has spiked since 2019 from 45% to 51% implementation score
- More efforts can be done to ensure inclusive TF measures targeting women and SMEs.
