


The LAC region (21 countries) has an average implementation rate of





The 11 countries that participated in the 2019 and 2021 surveys increase their average implementation rate by 7 percentage points






The best results are achieved in the core areas of the WTO Trade Facilitation

Very high implementation rates for many TF measures


LAC (11 COUNTRIES): MOST IMPLEMENTED TF MEASURES, 2021 (%)

Final remarks

- ■LAC obtains a high average in 2021 which reflects real progress since 2019. However:
 - The Caribbean was underrepresented.
 - Much remains to be done on cross-border paperless trade and inclusiveness dimensions of TF.
- •Increased digitalization of trade procedures in response to the pandemic should remain in place after it.
- Encouraging progress at the regional level:
 - MRAs of AEO schemes within the Andean Community, MERCOSUR & Pacific Alliance; ongoing negotiations of a region-wide MRA.
 - Electronic exchange of trade documents within regional integration agreements, especially Central America and Pacific Alliance.
