



### Mandate of the 7<sup>th</sup> APPC





- ESCAP resolution 74 (XXIII) of 17 April 1967:
  - Asian and Pacific Population Conference to be convened every 10 years to consider all aspects of population questions and their impact on economic and social dev. (statutory organ of ESCAP)
- Programme of Action of the International Conference on Population and Development (Cairo, 5-13 September 1994) (ICPD PoA) – global guiding document on population and development
- Asian and Pacific Ministerial Declaration on Population and Development (Bangkok, 16-20 Sept. 2013) – regional guiding document on population and development
- ESCAP/CSD/2020/3, decision 2 Asia-Pacific Voluntary Indicator Framework
- **CPD decision 2022/101 -** 30-year review of the ICPD PoA at the Commission on Population and Development in 2024





- b) identify good practices, lessons learned, priority actions and emerging trends in implementing the afore-mentioned documents in the context of the 2030 Agenda; and
- c) prepare a regional input to the global review of the Programme of Action of the International Conference on Pop. & Dev. 57th session of the Commission on Population and Development in 2024
