Markus JELITTO is a Counsellor with the Trade in Services Division at the World Trade Organization (WTO), Geneva. He has close to 20 years of experience in the field of trade in services and served as Secretary to the Committee on Specific Commitments (2002-2007), Secretary to the Working Party on Domestic Regulation from 2007-2010, and 2014 - present.

Between 2010 -2013 Markus worked as Senior Trade in Services Advisor to the Southern African Development Community (SADC), working on the SADC services integration process, as well as on EPA services negotiations on behalf of SADC Member States.

Since his return to the WTO Trade in Services and Investment Division, he has been responsible for assisting negotiations on domestic regulation in both the WPDR and the Joint Initiative on Services Domestic Regulation. He is the Trade in Services Division lead on legal issues concerning the GATS, responsible for LDC services issues including the services waiver, and coordinates all WTO technical assistance in trade in services. Markus is also the Secretariat expert on legal services.

Before joining the WTO Secretariat in 1996, he obtained an M.A. in international law and economics from the Johns Hopkins University (SAIS) in Washington, DC (1995). He also holds a J.D. equivalent law degree from Frankfurt University in Germany (1992).
