- **Recommendation, Bali Concorde II (2003)**

- **Enhance competitiveness of ASEAN economies and goods in response:**

- Adopting the Single Window approach
- Electronic processing of data and information



- **Ultimate goal: Accelerating the customs clearance of goods and commodities in achieving higher economic efficiency through:**

- Streamlining and simplifying related procedures
- Standardization of data and information
- Adoption of international best practices

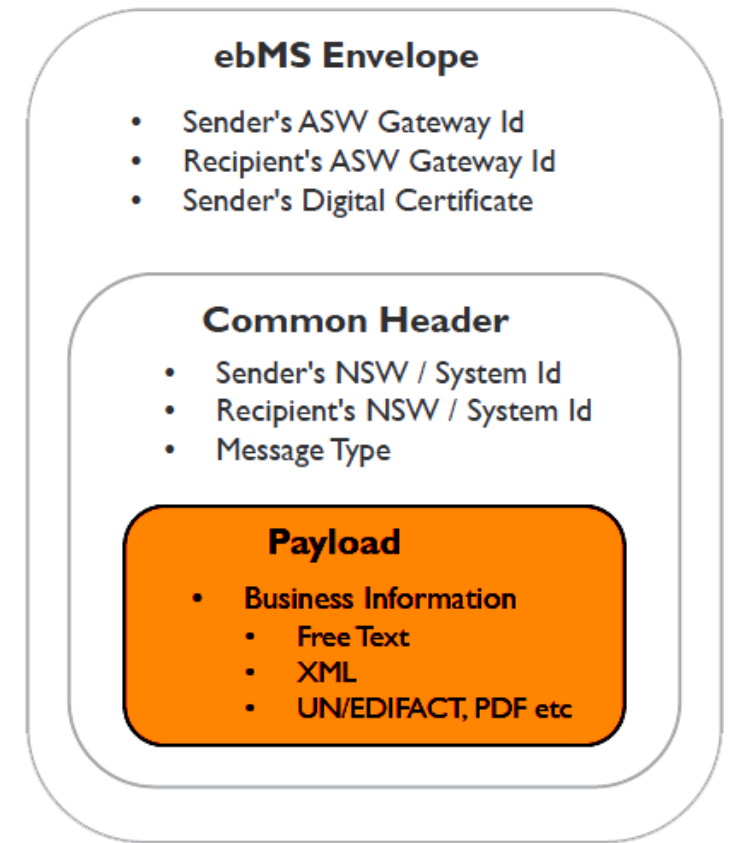
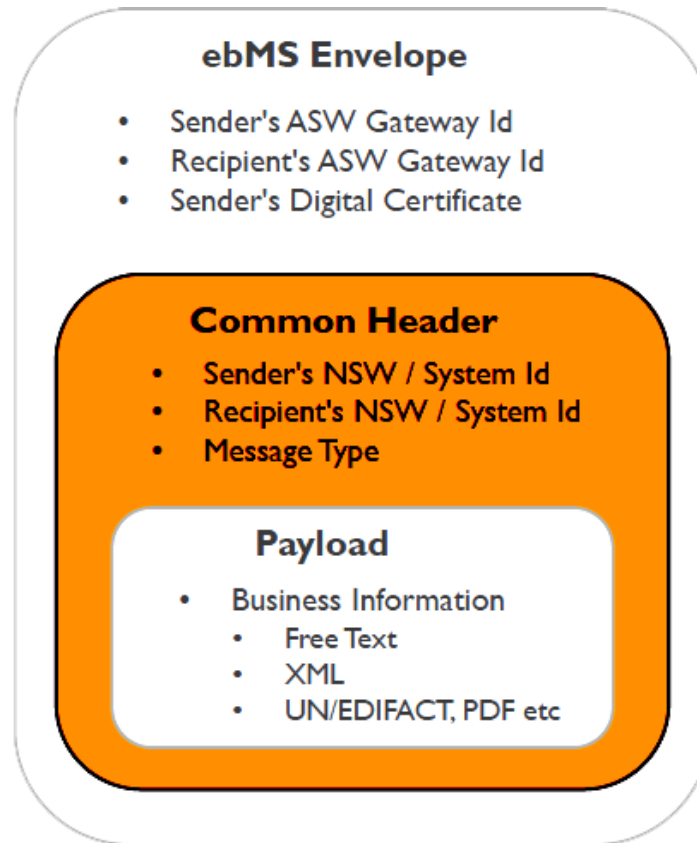
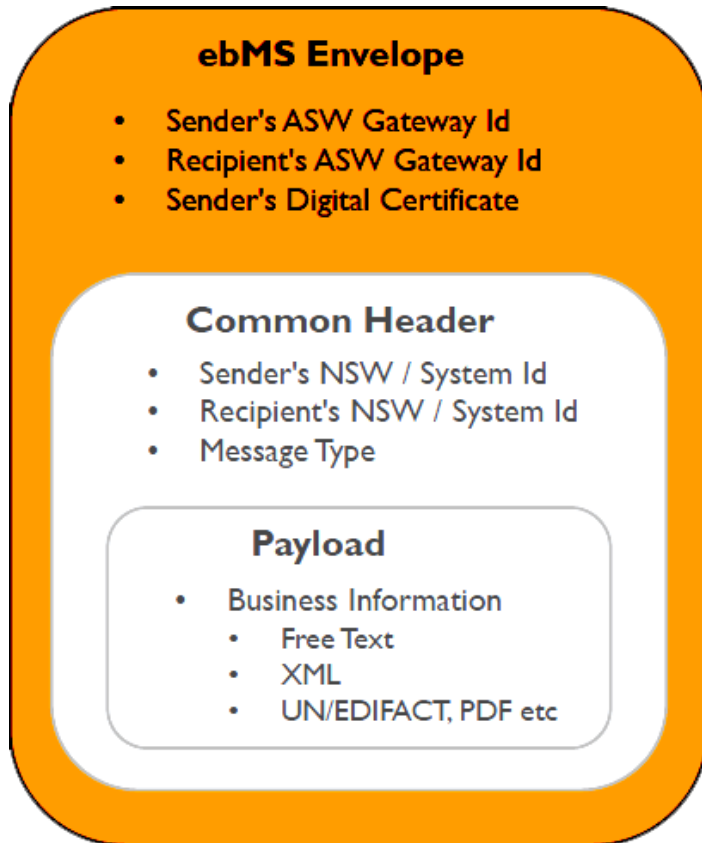
- ❖ In 2007, the Business Process for ASW including CEPT Form D
- ❖ In 2008, Mapping Data Elements and Creating the Business Process of the CEPT Form D
- ❖ 2009–2011, Development of the CEPT/ATIGA Form D application, XML schema, and Adjustment of the data elements
- ❖ 2012–2013, Pilot and parallel testing
- ❖ 2014–2015, Revision of the ATIGA Form D data structure and its technical documents
- ❖ 2016–2017, OCP Acceptance and Live Implementation of the ATIGA Form D
- ❖ In 2018, Starting the Live Operation of the ATIGA Form D
- ❖ In 2019, 10 AMS having live exchange of the ATIGA Form D



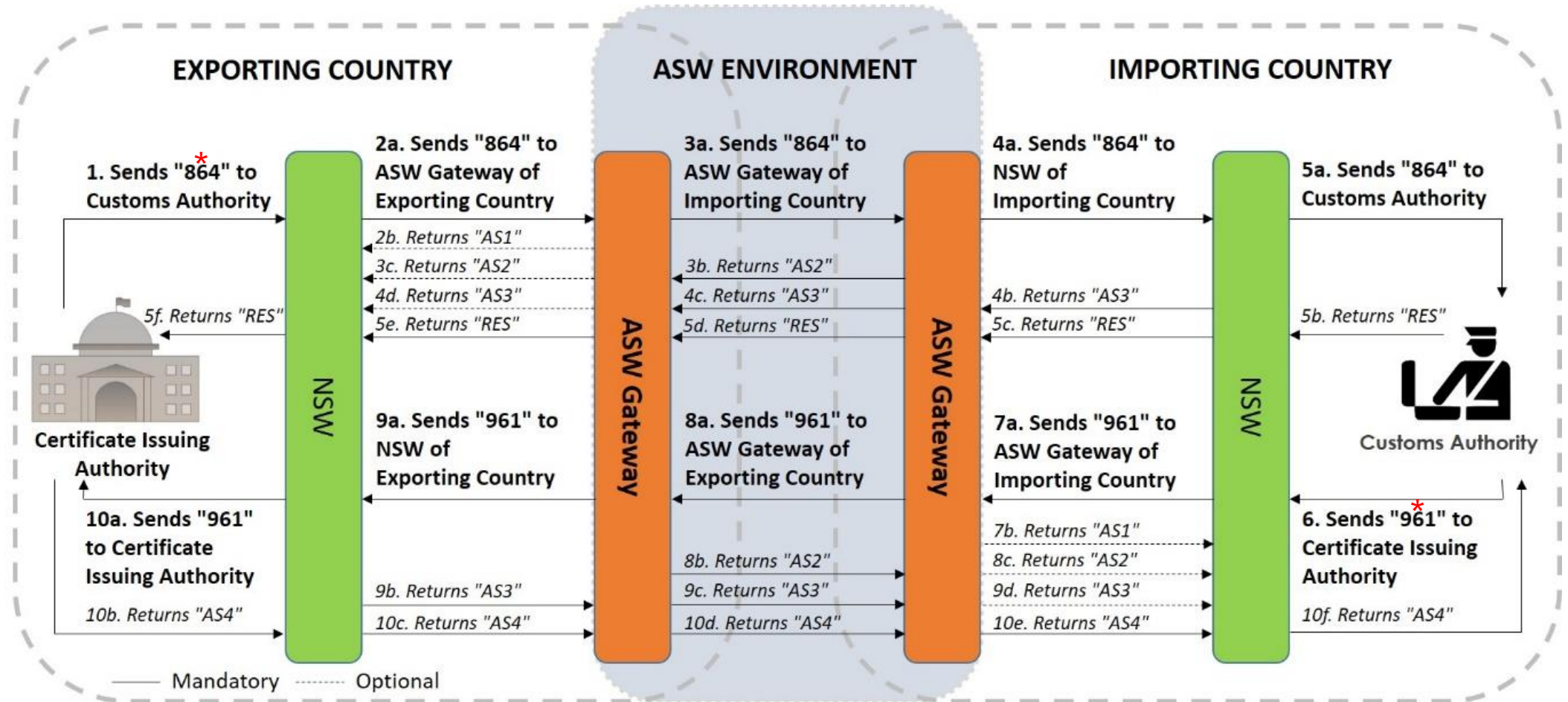
TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION



- ebMS, supported by international standards organizations, such as OASIS, UN/CEFACT
- The Acknowledgement Status in XML format (AS-1, AS-2, AS-3 and AS-4)
- HTTP/S over the Internet with message level signatures and encryption in line with ISO 15000-2

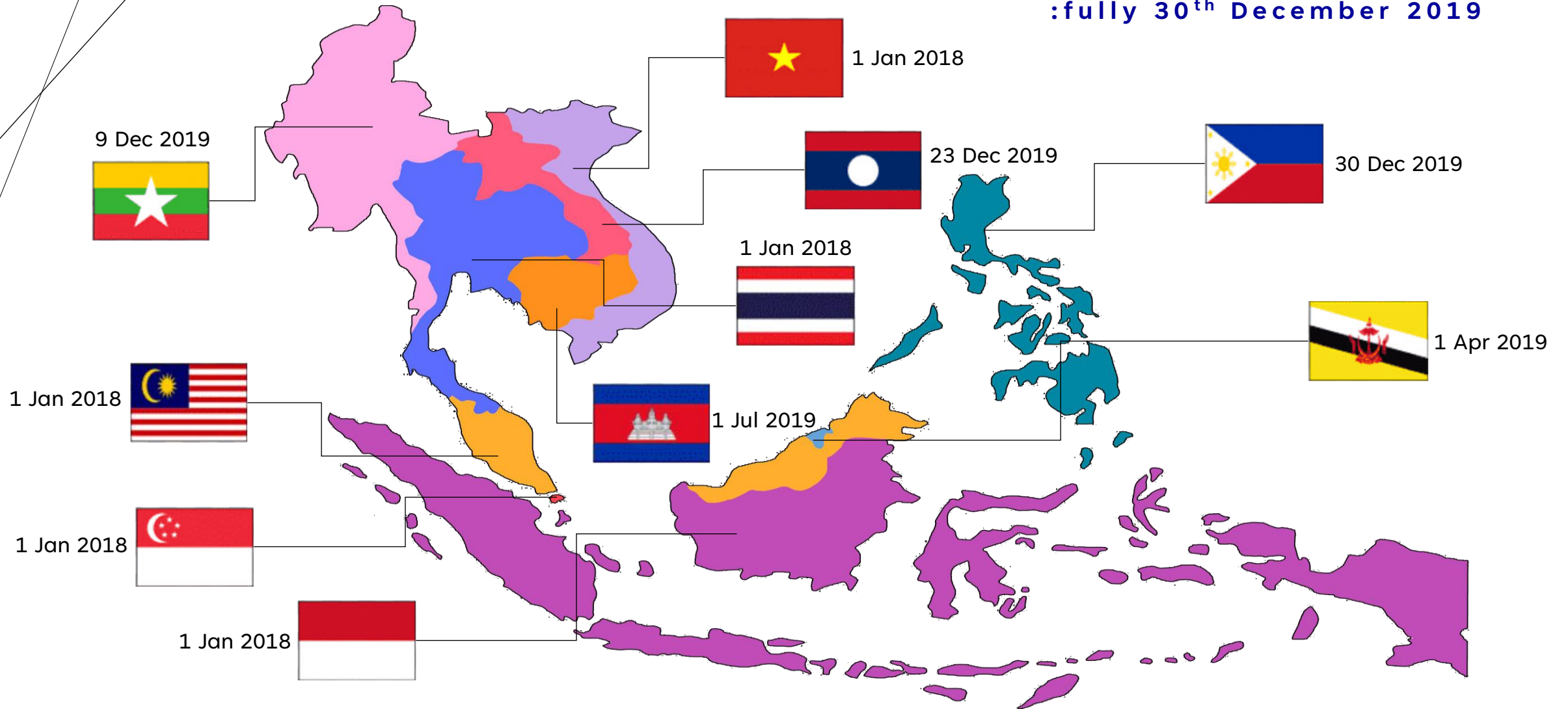

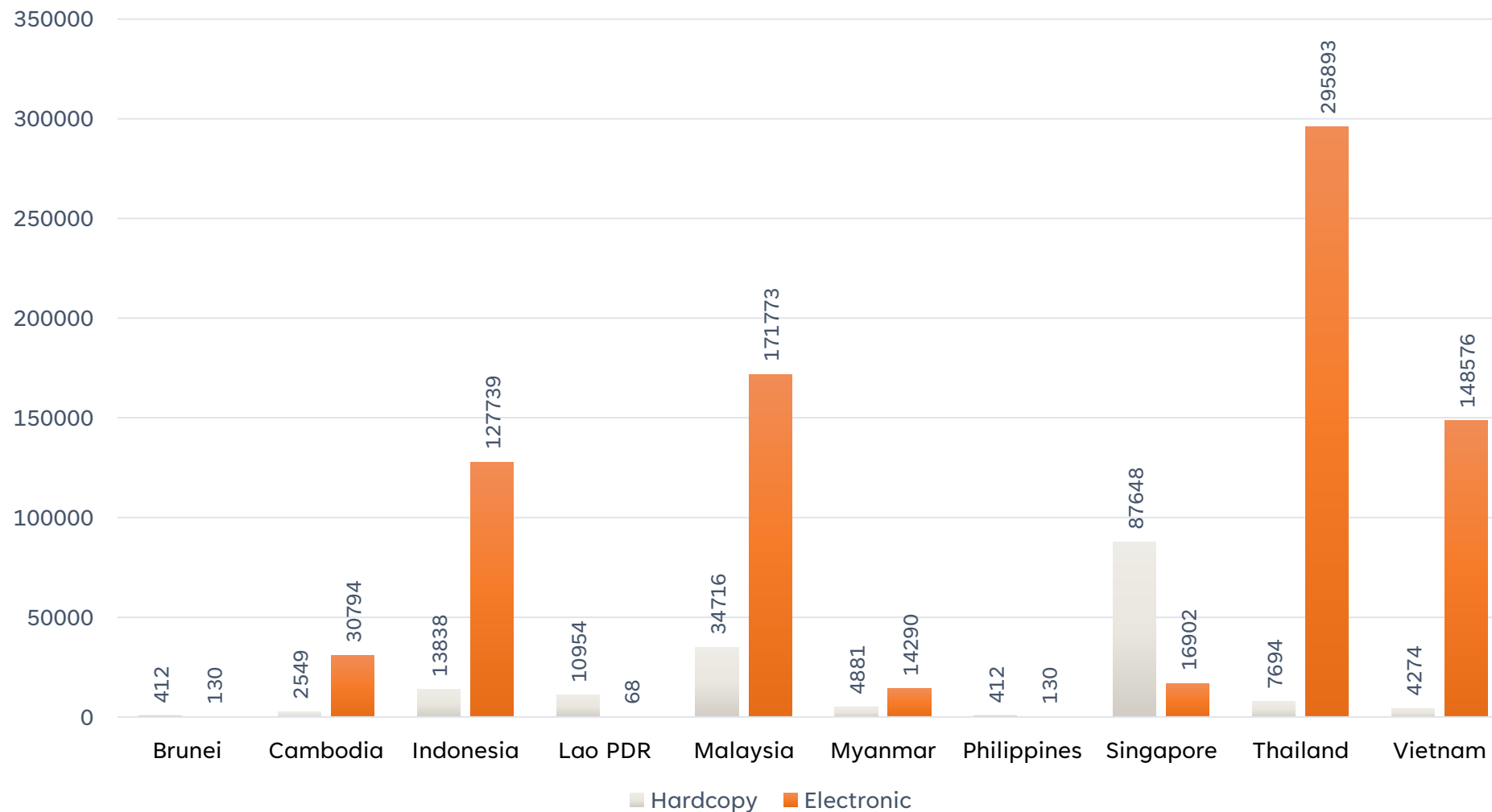
THE IMPLEMENTATION

THE IMPLEMENTATION

Processing Time






- Inputs from ~ 50 of 500 respondents
- **31 % - a response from customs immediately**
- **21 % - a response within a day**
- **48 % - a response at request**

Time and Cost Benefit

- Inputs from ~ 120 of 500 respondents
- **Saving USD 1500 / shipment**
- **Saving 20 hours / shipment**
- **Saving 2.7 days for clearance / shipment**

ISSUES AND CHALLENGES

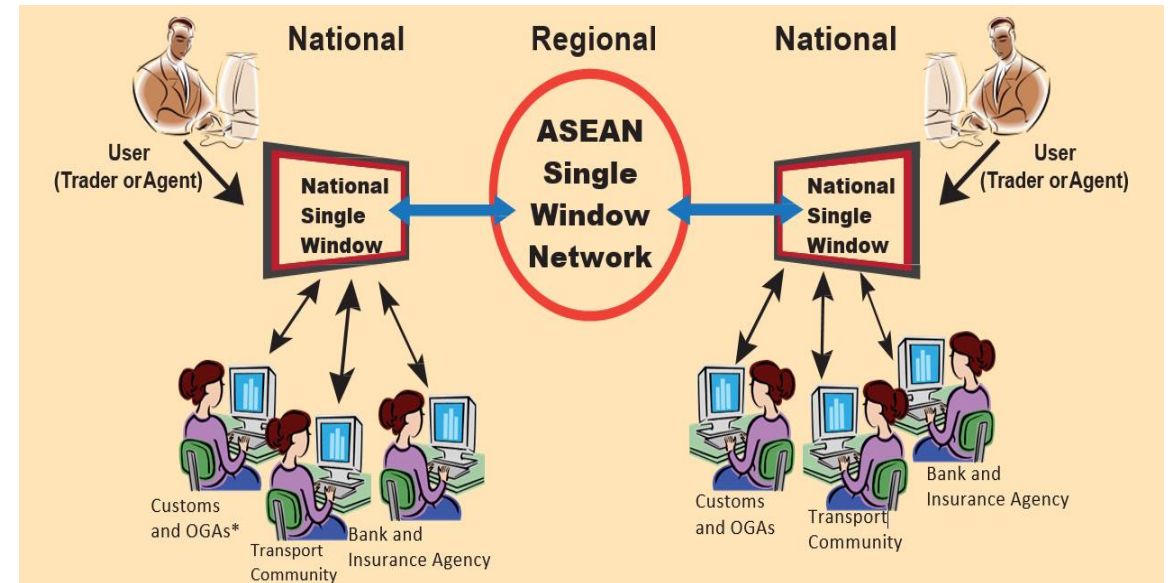


- Invalid codes (such as: location codes, codes of unit of measurement) which resulted on rejection 
- Delayed acknowledgement message to inform the received ATIGA e-Form D 
- Delayed response of the government officers of the partner countries 
- Preference to still use hardcopy by most of the Customs broker and consignee to avoid Customs post-audit problem in the future 
- Improper Cancellation and Replacement of the ATIGA e-Form D against the existing procedure 

NEXT STEP



- ❖ **ATIGA e-Form D new structure** will be implemented by Dec 2021
- ❖ **Utilization Report (Customs Response)** is expected to be start piloting in 2022
- ❖ **Verification Process** is being discussed the messaging rule
- ❖ **Cancellation Process** is agreed and seemed to be leveraged to solve the current issue
- ❖ **Access for the whole ATIGA e-Form D data by the trader** is needed the solution to accommodate
- ❖ **Electronic ASEAN-Wide Self-Certification** is the interesting document to be optionally used for Preferential Treatment



NEXT STEP



- ASEAN member countries' ports and points of entry are able to accept the ATIGA e-Form Ds



- The remaining ASEAN member countries are able to exchange of the ASEAN Customs Declaration Document (ACDD)



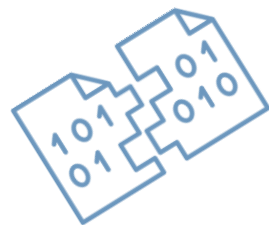
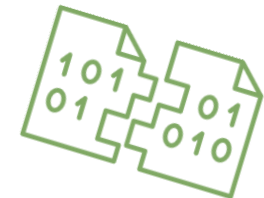
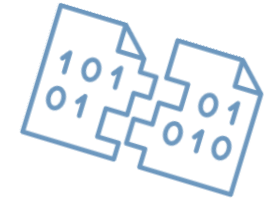
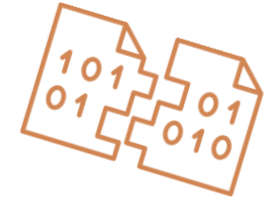
- Conduct the test of e-Phyto Certificate among ready ASEAN member countries
