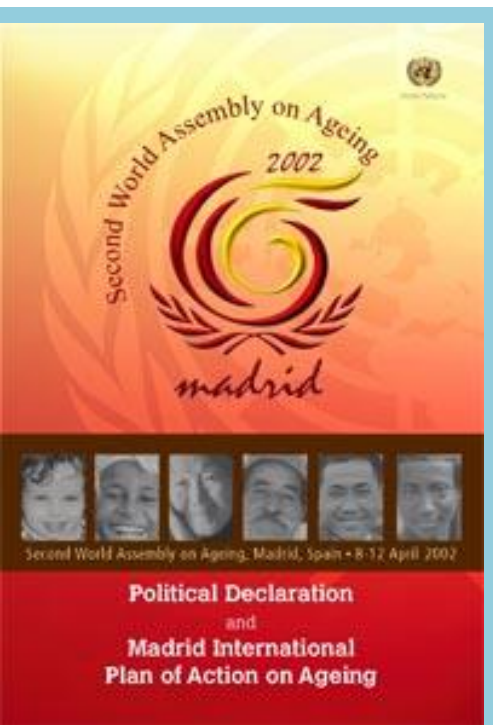

Madrid International Plan of Action on Ageing (MIPAA)

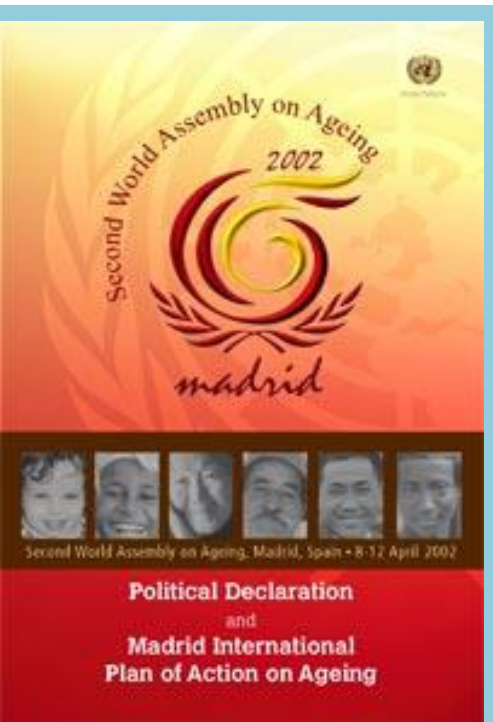


§116 ... The aim of the International Plan of Action is to ensure that persons everywhere are able to age with **security** and **dignity** and to continue to participate in their societies as citizens with **full rights**.

Priority direction:

- A. **Older persons** and **development**
- B. Advancing **health** and **well-being** into old age
- C. Ensuring **enabling** and **supportive environments**

Madrid International Plan of Action on Ageing (MIPAA)



§116 **Governments** have the **primary responsibility** for implementing the broad recommendations of the MIPAA.

§117 The role of **non-governmental** organizations is important in supporting Governments in their implementation, assessment and follow-up of the International Plan of Action, 2002

§131 Systematic **review of implementation** of MIPAA by Member States is essential for its success in improving the quality of life of older persons.

High-level political declarations and agreements with reference to older persons

Disaggregation by age and sex, race or ethnicity, migratory status, disability, income and geographical location

SDG 16 – Promote **peaceful** and **inclusive societies** and provide access to **justice for all**

Regional Mandate – ESCAP

Asia-Pacific Third Review and Appraisal (2017) – (paraphrased) (ESCAP Dec. 74/26)

Support countries in implementing MIPAA, including through the **periodic midterm review** of members' progress



Build capacities to develop comprehensive social protection systems

Support countries in creating **forward-looking policies and monitoring frameworks**

Encourage **sharing of experiences** in the implementation of MIPAA

Follow-up to the Second World Assembly on Ageing (MIPAA)

GA resolution 75/152 (16 Dec. 2020)

OP39 – **regional cooperation** to implement MIPAA

OP44 – recognition of role of regional commissions with **training, capacity-building, policy design** and **monitoring** at national and regional levels

OP46 – **enhanced collaboration** of ageing focal points and increased technical cooperation

Modalities for the fourth review and appraisal of the MIPAA

ECOSOC resolution 2020/8 (18 June 2020)

OP1 – **timeline**: 2023-global review – 2022-regional reviews

OP2-OP6 – additional suggestions

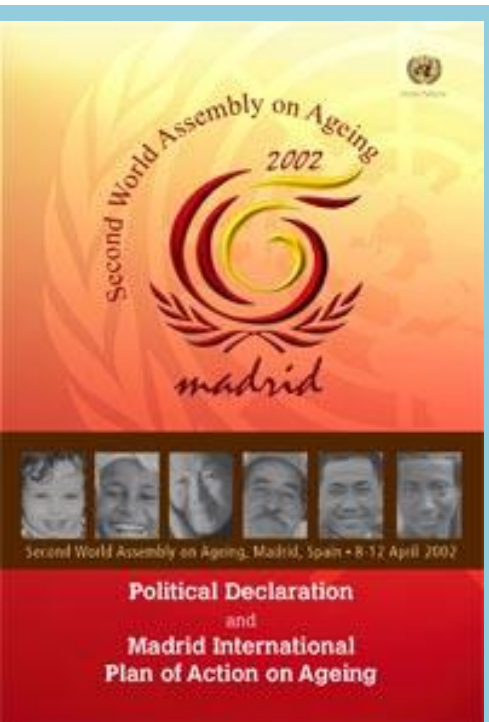
OP7 – **reviews & appraisals**: regional commissions to facilitate, organize and assist member States with national reviews
