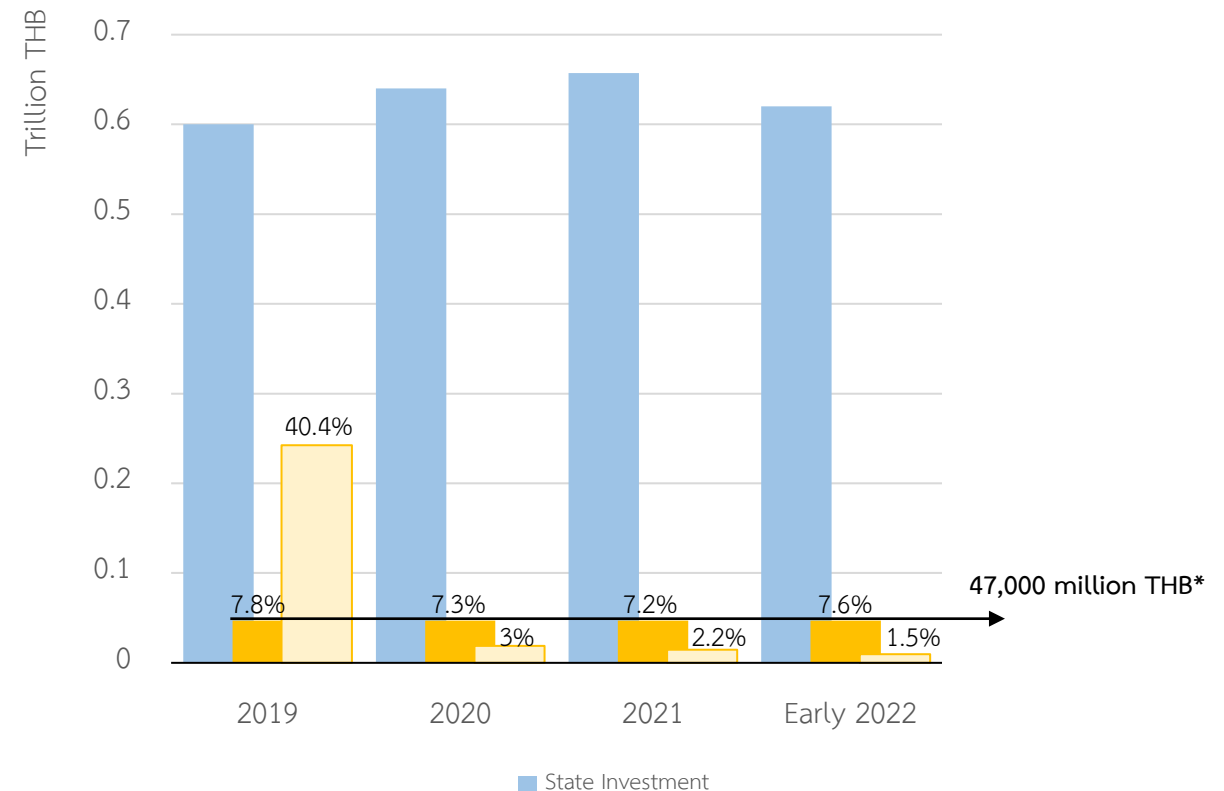

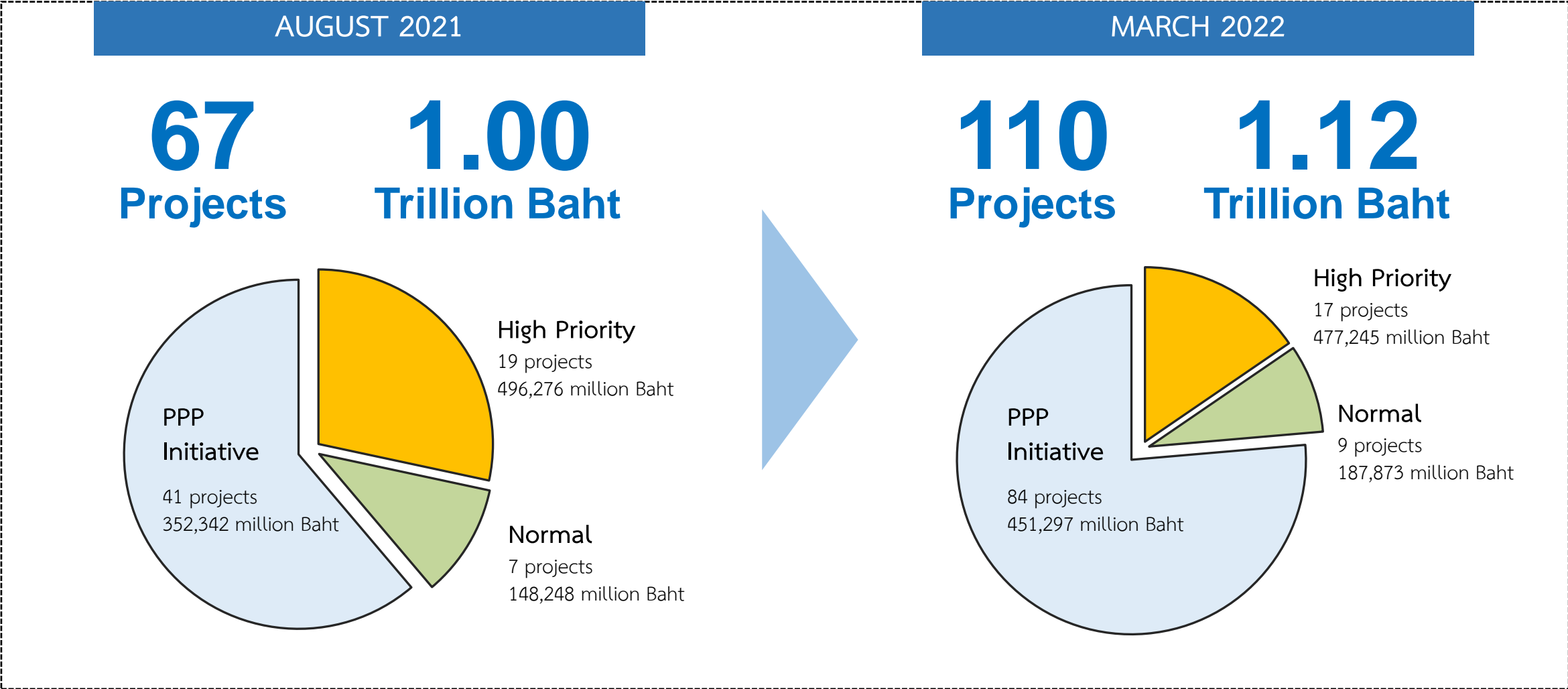

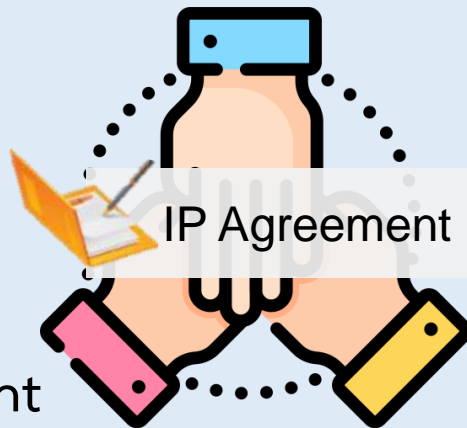
PPP Delivery Plan 2020 - 2027

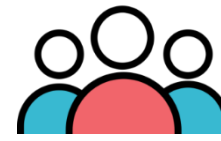
