



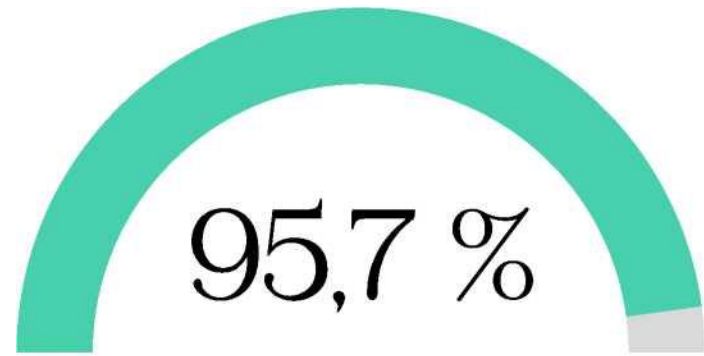

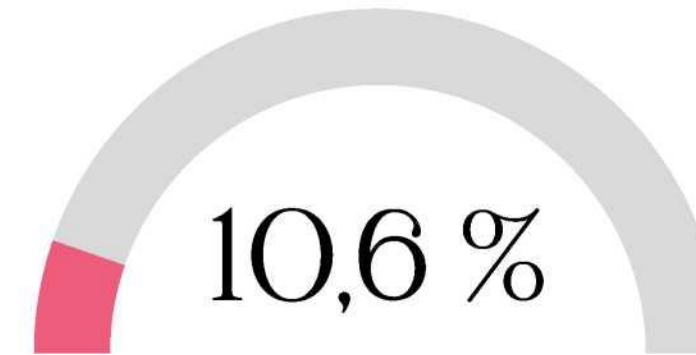

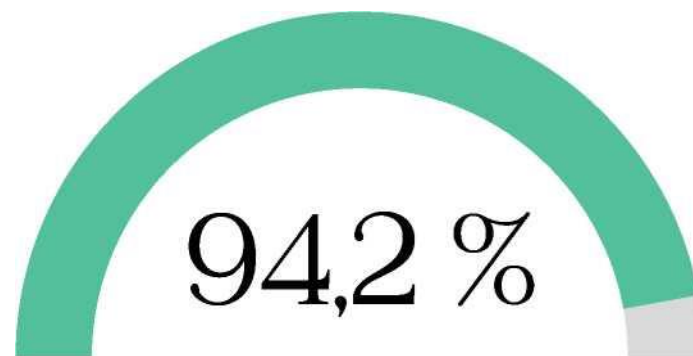
**SHARE OF THE POPULATION THAT

SECURITY**



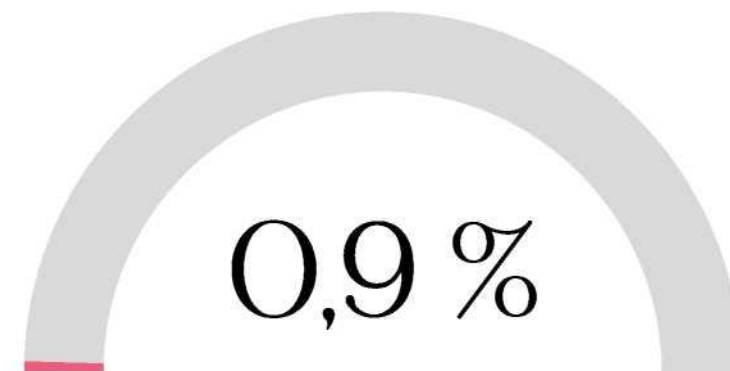
**SHARE OF PEOPLE THAT

MALNUTRITION**



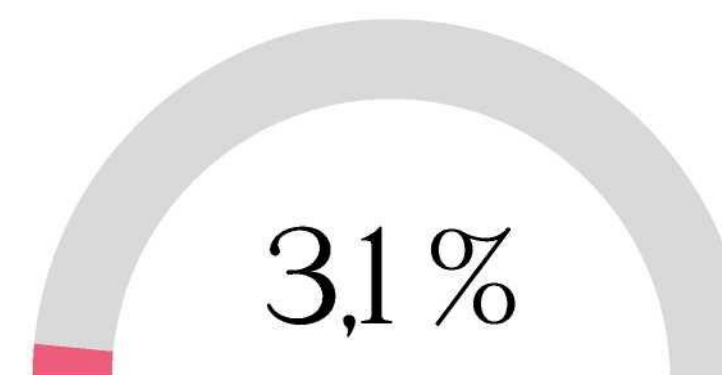
**SHARE OF INFANTS BELOW 5

USED IN AGRICULTURE**

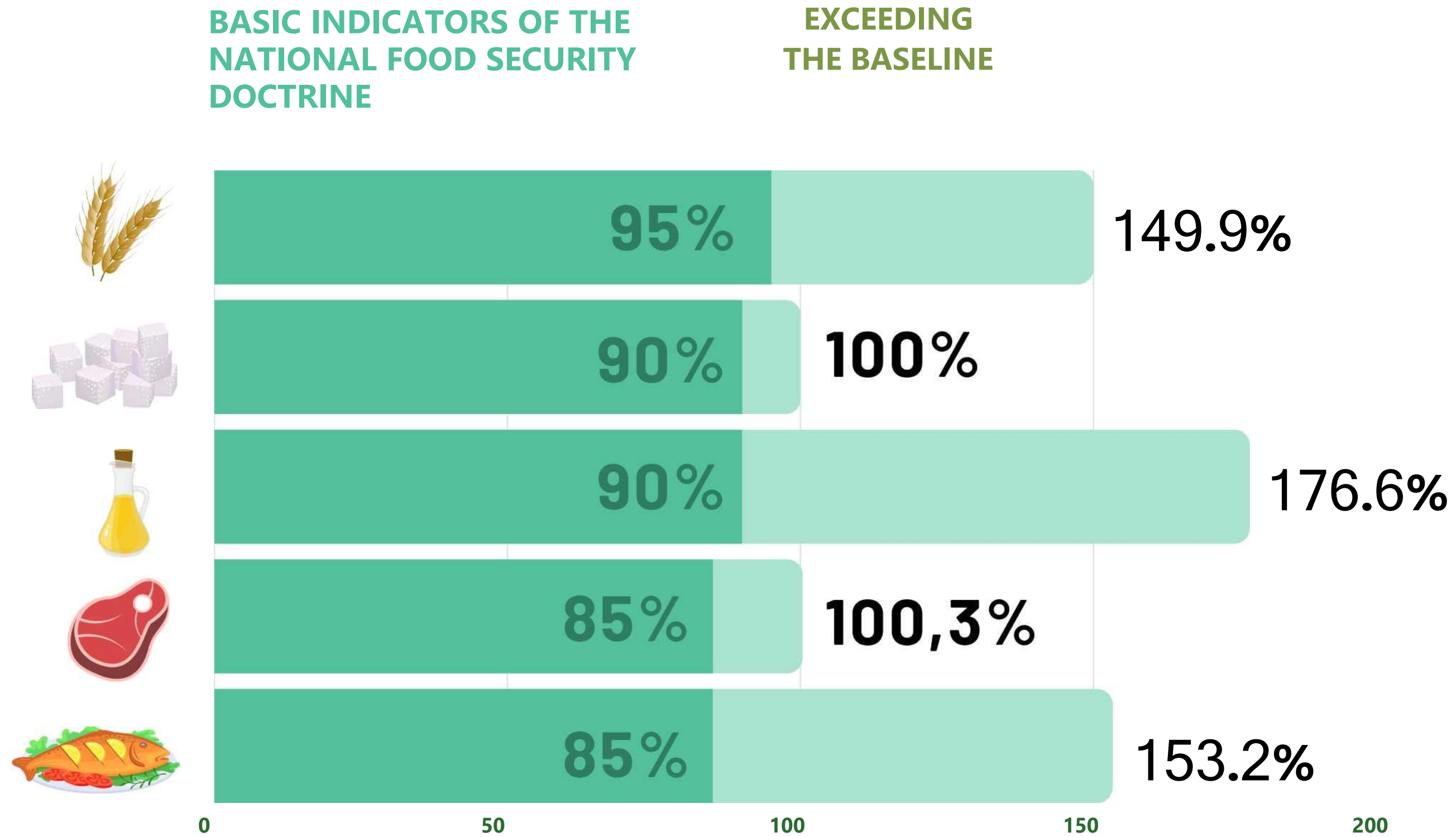
