## **EPiC Project background**

## Reasons:

- Does not have a comprehensive M&E framework
- Some policies had been approved without indicators
- Does not evaluate the policy implementation efficiently
- Lack of SDG implementing mechanism in the policy framework

# **Objectives:**

- Develop indicators set that could be used in long-; mid-; short-term policy planning
- Enhance M&E and planning capacity building
- Align SDGs into the Targeted Development Programs

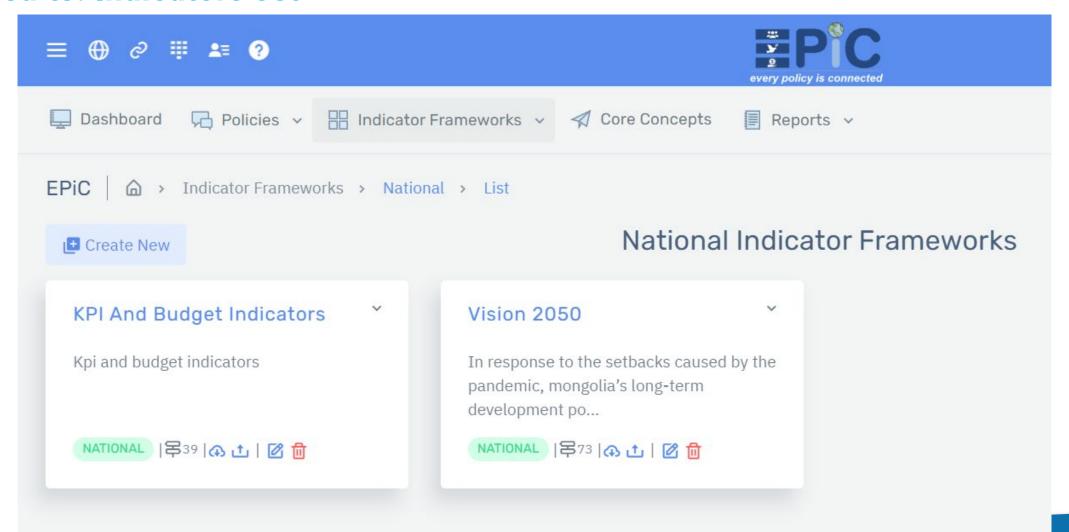

# Results: Draft for the Targeted Program on Social Development

### Strengthen national values

- 1. The national cultural immunity will be increased to 70 percent.
- 2. Increase mutual trust between social groups by 30 percent.

#### Strengthen the health and stability of the family

- 1. The average annual population growth will not be reduced from 1.6 percent.
- 2. Children's rights will be fully ensured.
- 3. Healthy and active seniors will increase by 50 percent.
- 4. The target group will be fully covered by social welfare services that meet their needs.
- 5. Family development will be promoted.

### Create a human-friendly living environment

- 1. Food safety will be improved by 50 percent.
- 2. Crime and violations will be reduced by 20 percent.
- 3. The incidence of human-caused accidents will be reduced by 7 times.
- 4. The number of households living in fully equipped housing will be increased by 40 percent.
- 5. The environment that meets the diverse needs of citizens will be increased by 10 percent.
