THE DISCIPLINES ON SERVICES DOMESTIC REGULATION - What's in it? *

Modalities and timeframes for submission of applications

- Applicants to approach no more than one competent authority to obtain authorization
- Applications possible at any time throughout the year, or at least, reasonable time periods for submission are guaranteed
- Applications in electronic format are accepted
- Authenticated copies of documents are accepted in place of original documents
- Examinations for professionals are scheduled at frequent intervals and reasonable time periods are guaranteed to submit requests to take the examination

Procedural benchmarks for processing applications

- Indicative timeframes for processing applications are established
- Applicants can request information on the status of application
- Applicants are informed of the final decision concerning their application within a reasonable period of time after submission
- Applicants are informed if their application is incomplete and they are given an
 opportunity to provide the additional information required to complete the application
- Applicants are informed of the reasons for rejection of their application and they are provided with an opportunity for resubmission
- Authorizations granted enter into effect without undue delay
- Authorization fees are reasonable and transparent
- Decisions on requests for authorization are reached and administered by competent authorities in an independent manner

Publication of information and stakeholder engagement

- Information necessary for service suppliers to comply with requirements and procedures for obtaining authorization is promptly published, including electronically
- Service suppliers are granted a reasonable time period before their compliance with a new measure is required
- Proposed laws and regulations are published in advance before their adoption, with an explanation of their purpose and rationale
- Interested persons are granted an opportunity to comment on proposed laws and regulations, and their comments are to be taken into account as much as possible
- Appropriate mechanisms are established to address enquiries from service suppliers or persons seeking to supply services

Transparency, objectivity, impartiality, and non-discrimination of authorization

- Authorization measures are based on transparent and objective criteria
- Authorization procedures are impartial and adequate for applicants to demonstrate whether they meet the requirements
- Authorization measures do not discriminate between men and women
