Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures (SPS) and Technical Barriers to Trade (TBT)

SPS/TBT = Regulatory measures to meet domestic non-trade concerns (e.g., health and safety)

RTAs = Provide frameworks for regulatory cooperation among member countries

→ RTAs on SPS/TBT – Huge potential to facilitate trade flows in health emergencies → Time & Cost saving

SPS/TBT measures during **COVID**

COVID-19 Non-Tariff Measures (UNCTAD, February 2021)

- Countries exempted SPS/TBT to facilitate emergency import
- Exempted requirements include certification, quality control, safety or performance control, conformity assessment,
- Measures linked to SPS/TBT, e.g., preshipment inspections, non-automatic import licensing

RTAs for trade in emergencies

Model RTA provisions on SPS/TBT (UNCTAD, March 2021) (Presentation at Policy Hackathon)

- Only few RTAs refer to regu.coop for medical supplies; No RTA with provisions for emergencies
- RTAs can help members prepare for regu.coop (e.g., MR, Equivalence, Harmonization) in emergencies
- E.g., Define situations to be recognized public health emergency; Pre-identify products for regu.coop in emergency • Provide a timeframe for regu.coop

RTAs and RC for Vaccines

Measures to facilitate COVID vaccine flows (WTO, July 2021)

- Trade of COVID vaccine and inputs = subjects to SPS/TBT procedures → RTAs can help simplify procedures
- RC can help facilitate a fast-track distribution of vaccines, e.g., African Medicines Regulatory Harmonisation (AMRH), ASEAN harmonized drug registration
