UNIDO Approach to promote ISID in the Asia Pacific Region

- **Component 1: Policy:** assist the Government to elaborate sector-specific industrial policies that are financially sustainable and cost-effective and that contribute to national/international environmental targets, sustainable industrial development, and job creation;
- **Component 2: Market:** enhance enterprise competitiveness, market access and export;
- **Component 3: Partnership:** establish networks for knowledge sharing and building partnerships at the regional and international level;
- **Component 4: Environment:** promote an environmentally sustainable industrial development through green industry, waste management, resources management, energy efficiency, systems optimization, and most importantly a behaviour change; and
- **Component 5: Job creation:** create job opportunities.

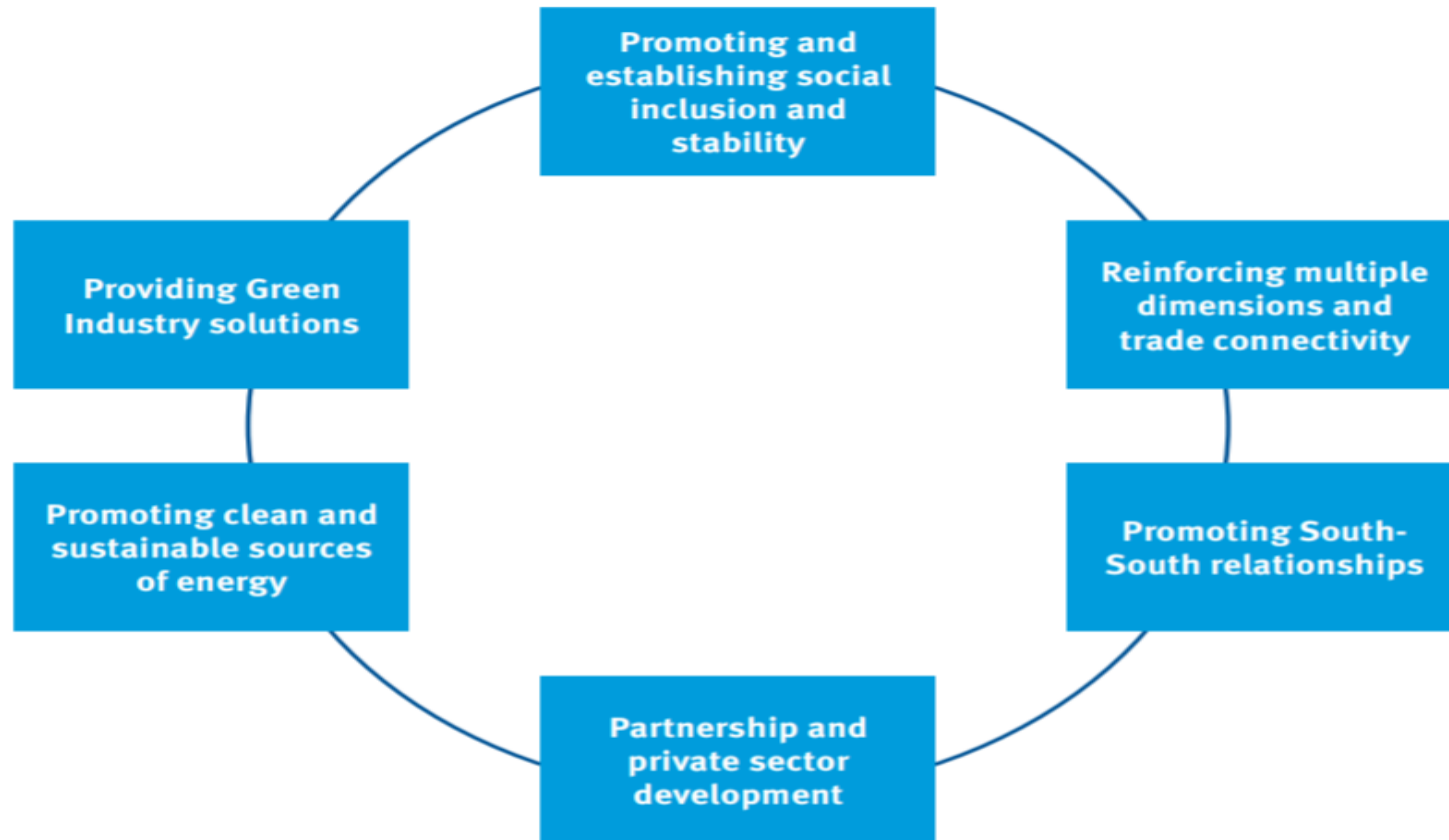
