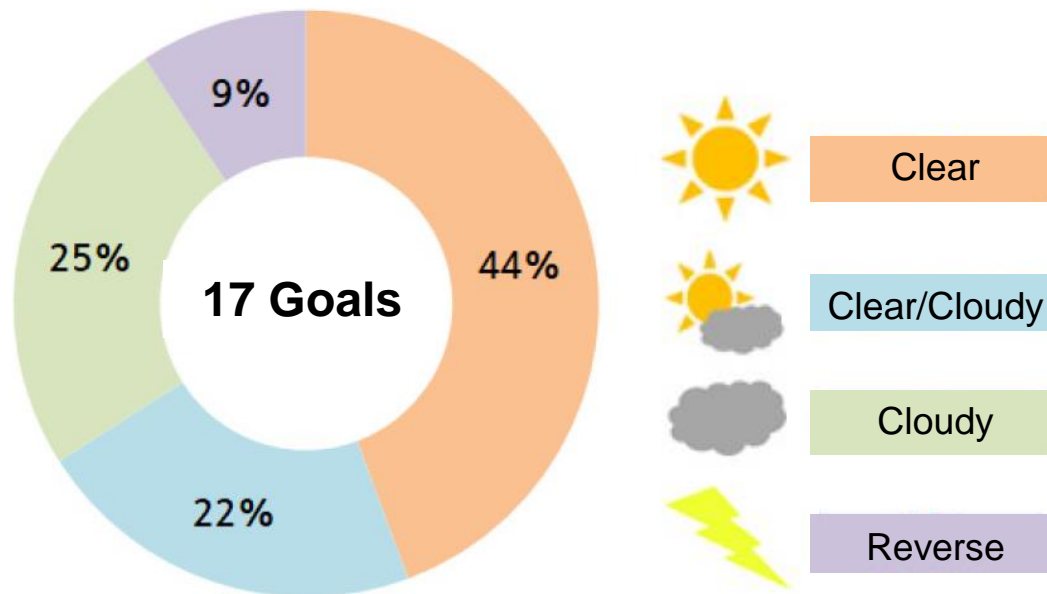

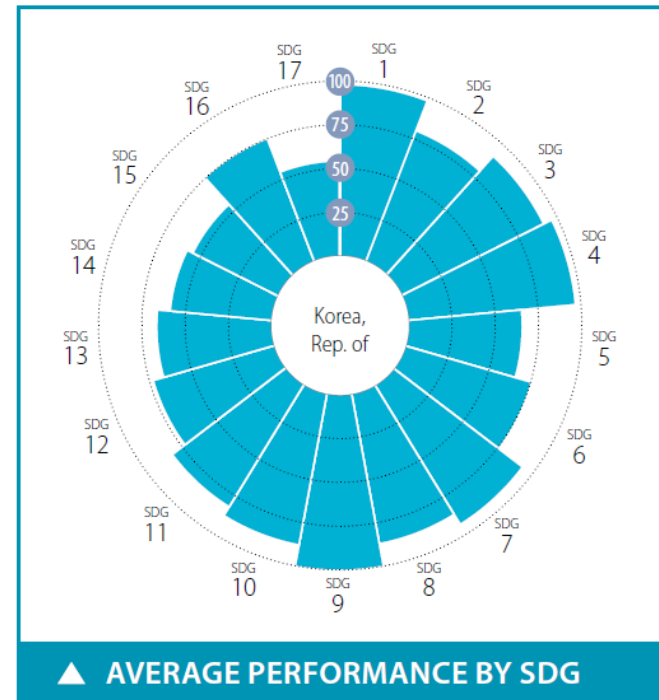

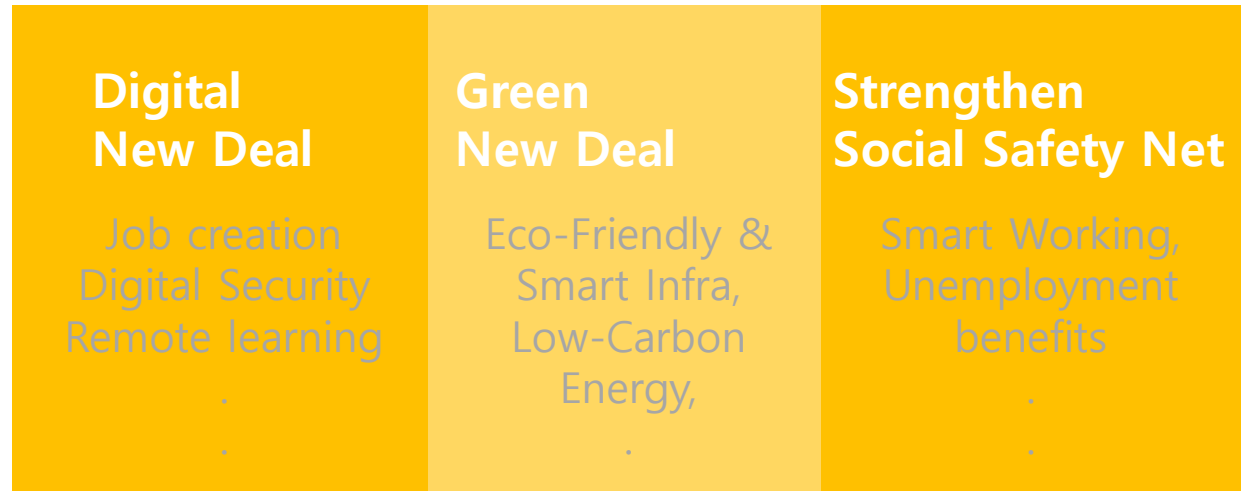

US\$ millions; in 2018 prices

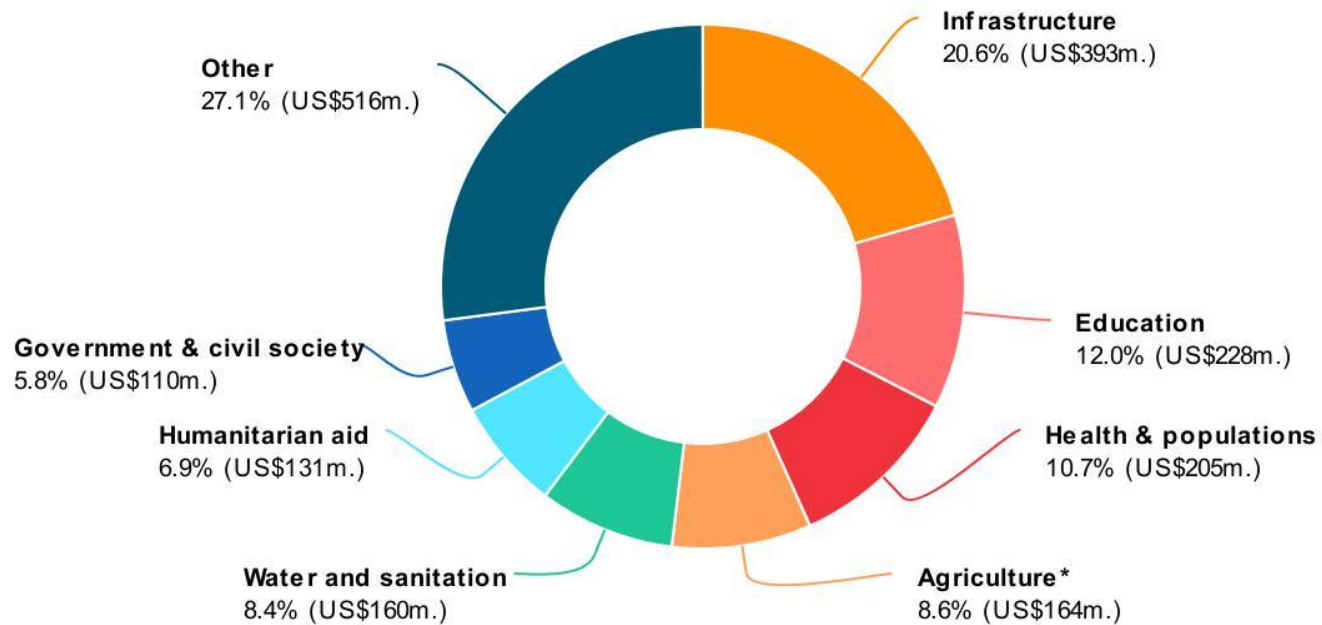


■ Net ODA (cash-flow)*
