In 2018 Armenia presented its first VNR



ACHIEVED SDG TARGETS

- health protection in terms of child and maternal health
- access to safe and reliable water supply in urban and rural areas
- improved sanitation in urban areas
- universal access to reliable energy
- promotion of renewable energy
- environmental protection, in terms of enlargement of protected areas and biodiversity
- ending extreme poverty

AREAS WITH SLOW OR MIXED PROGRESS

- education, due to high dropout rate from high school
- about 30 percent of population still lives under national poverty line
- gender equality
- inefficient use of water
- environment, due to deforestation risks, land degradation
- low access to sanitation in rural areas
- lack of sustainable consumption and production (SCP) practices

THE POLICY EFFORT

Review of strategies, laws and regulations which set out economic, social and environmental targets and indicators.

DATA EFFORT

Compiling and analyzing accurate data from various sources like National Statistical Committee, sector specific data provided from the line Ministries and other stakeholders.

INSTITUTIONAL EFFORT

Establishing and enhancing institutions and mechanisms necessary for effective coordination, data collection and analyses effort, dialogue among major stakeholders and identification of possible solutions and reforms.
