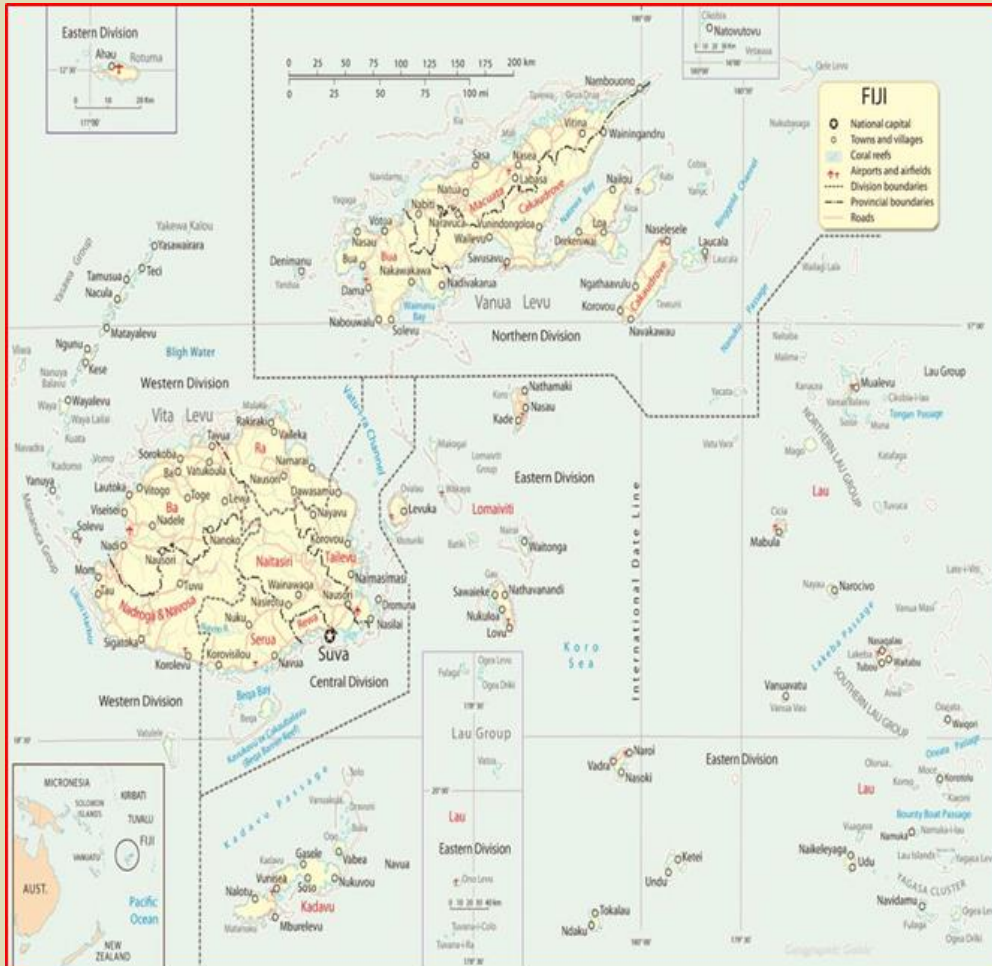

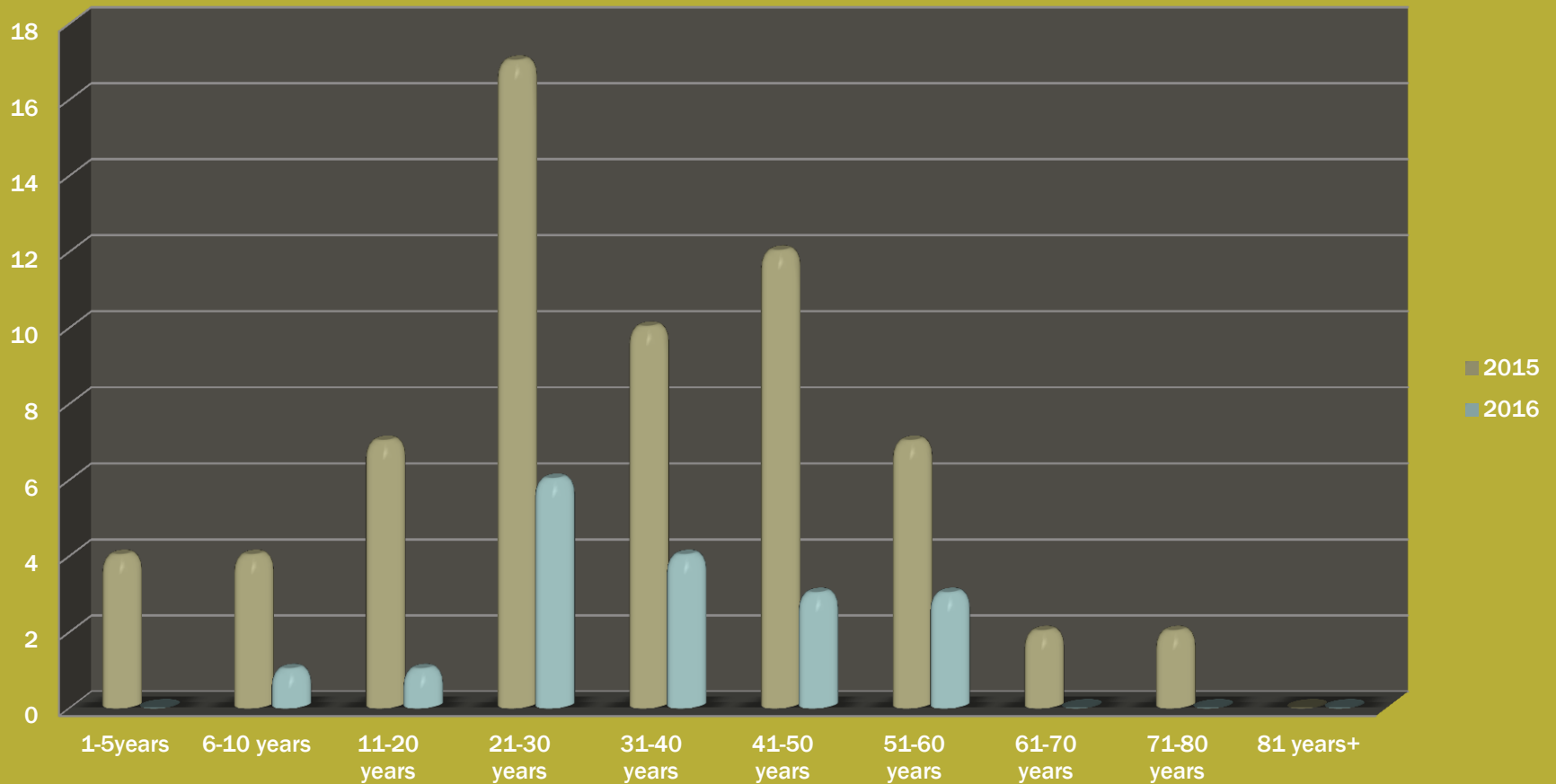

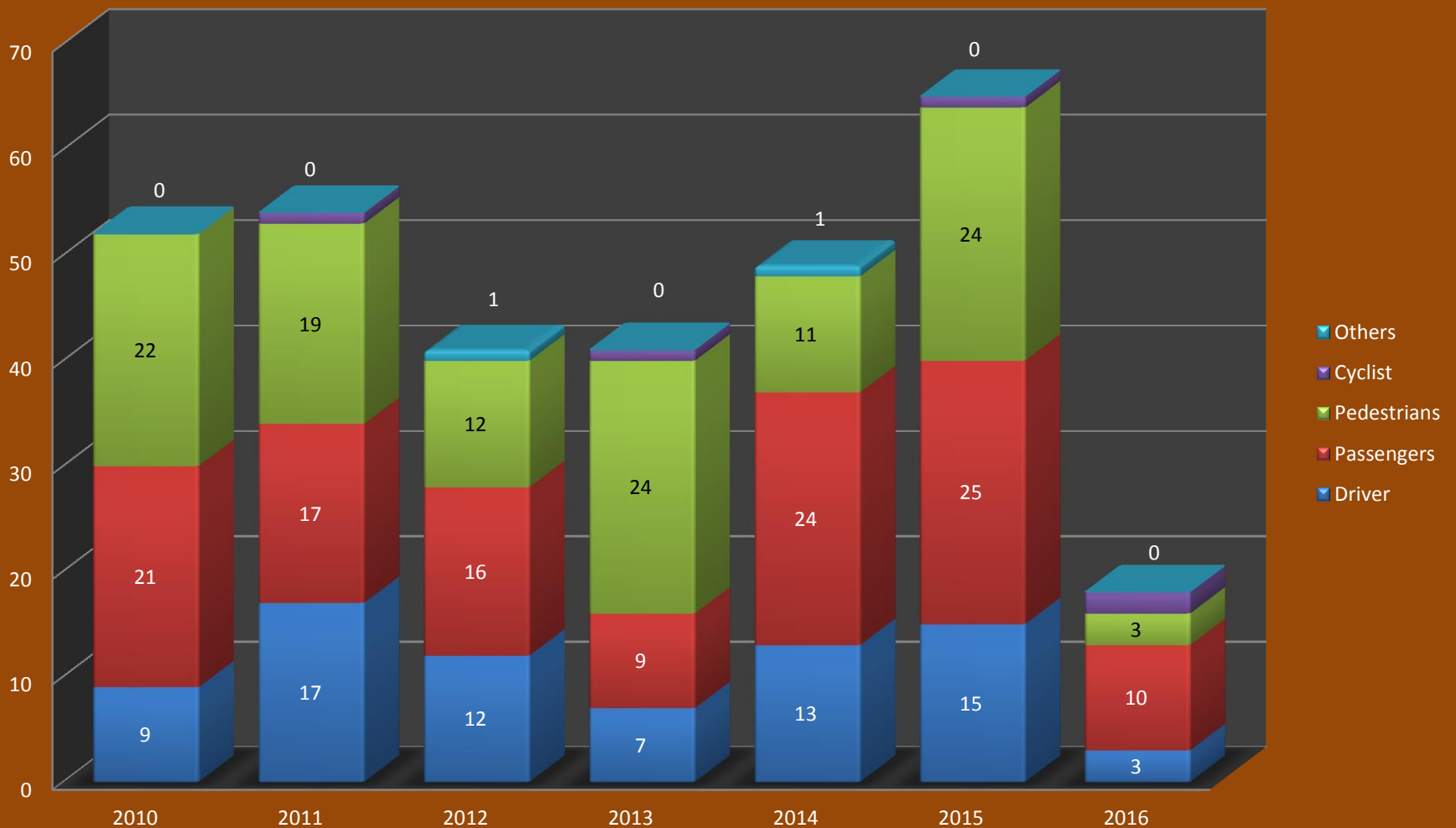

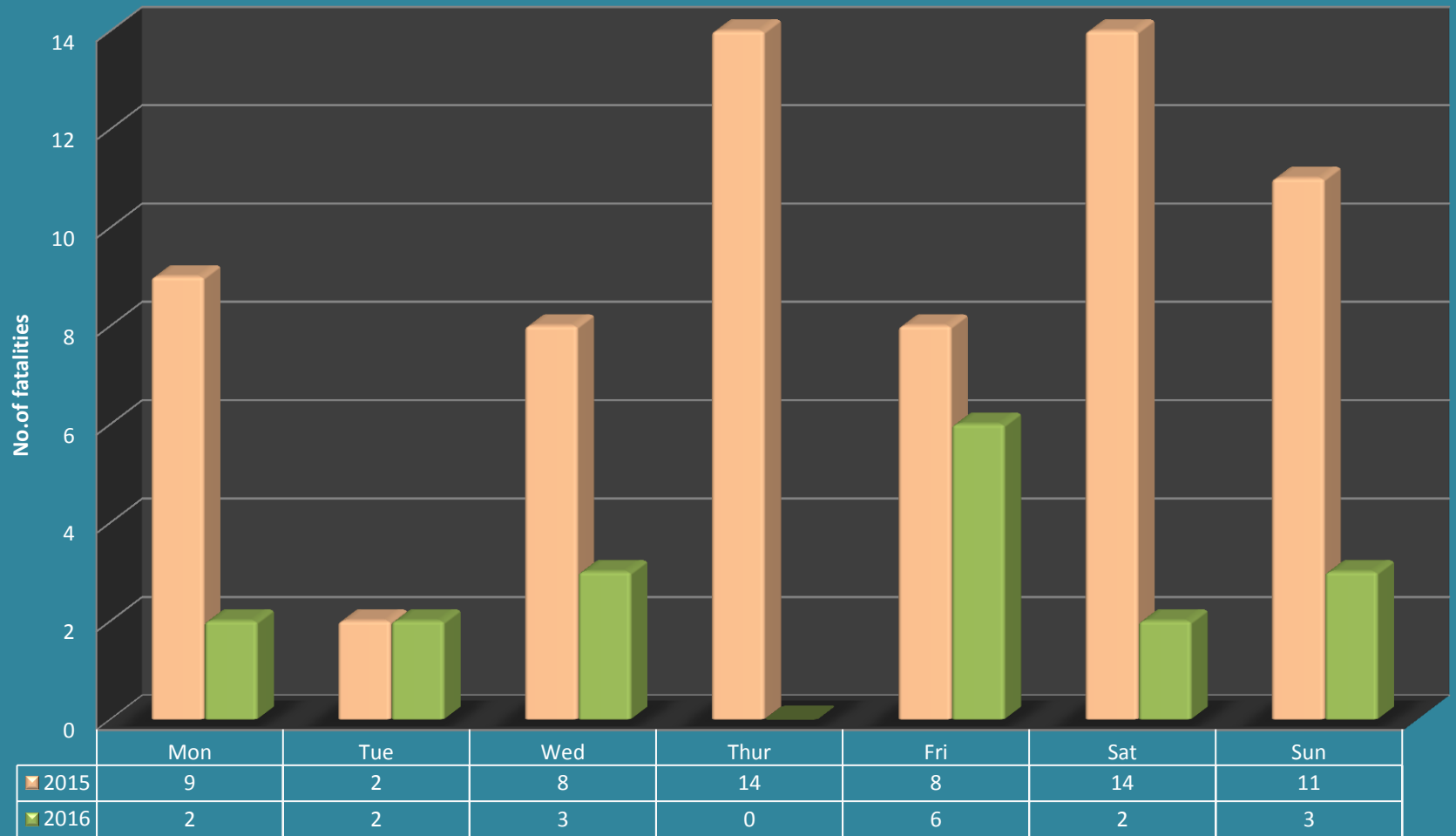
ROAD VICTIM BY AGES FOR THE PERIOD 2015 - APR 2016



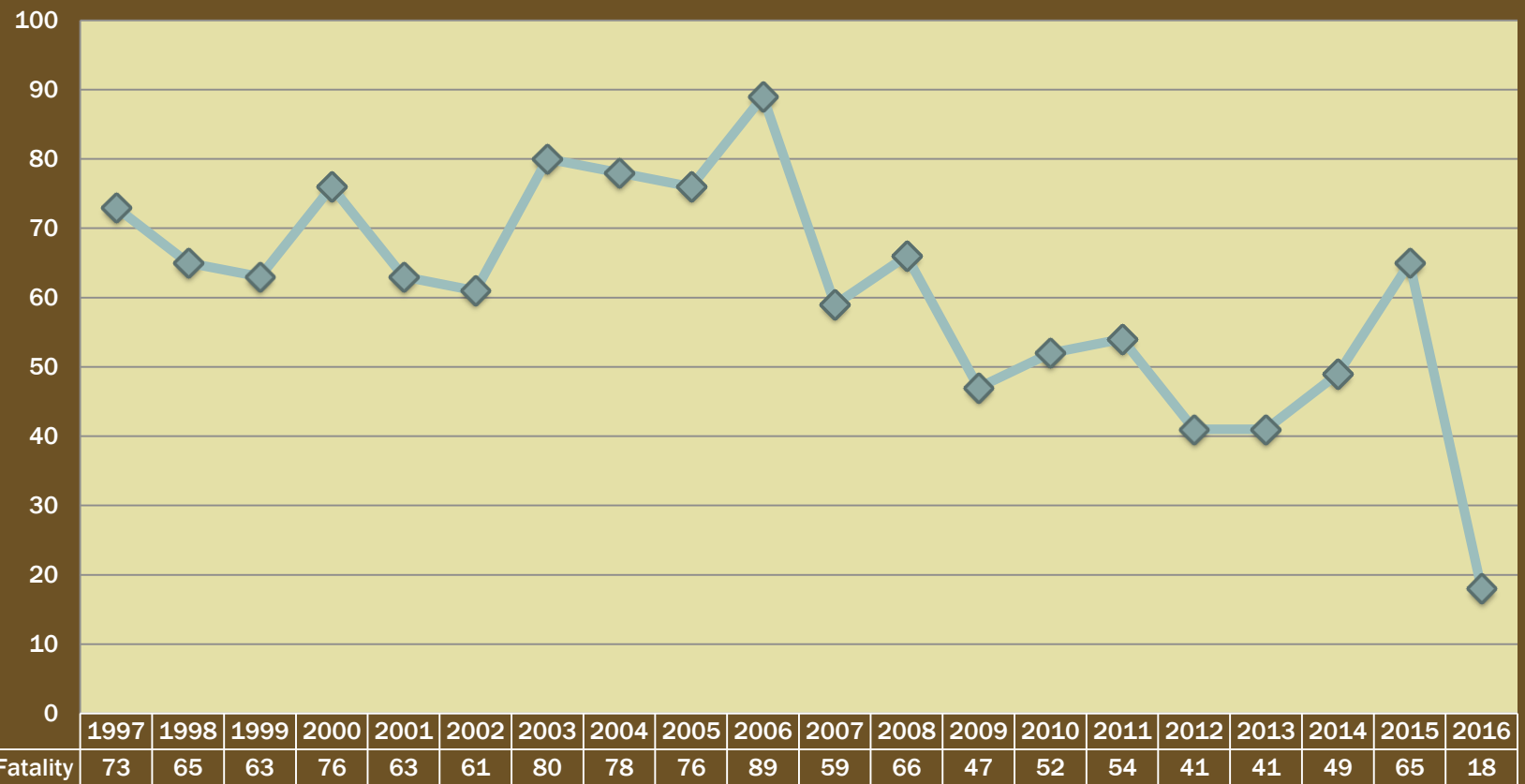
ROAD VICTIMS BY TYPES



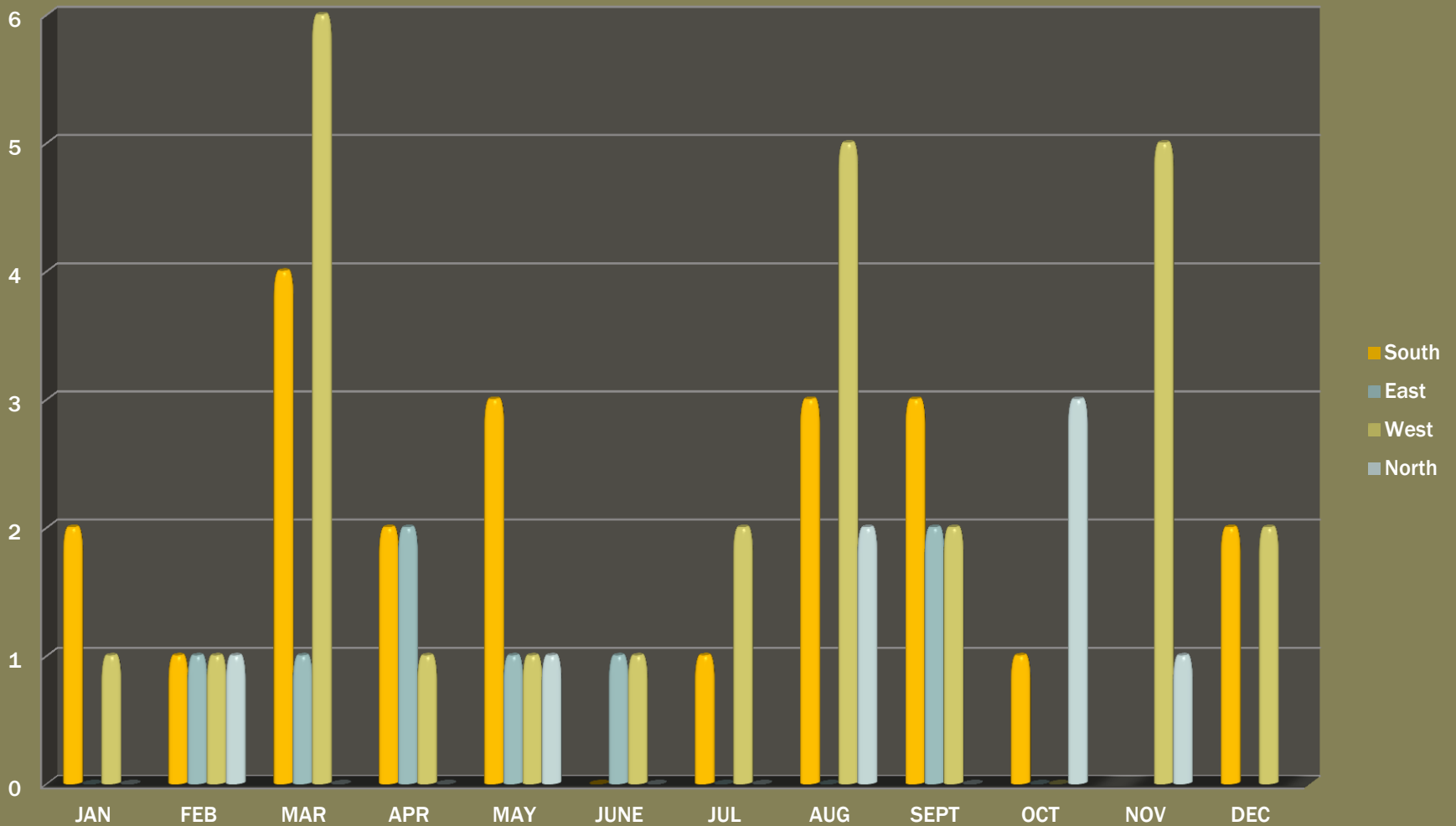
HIGHEST FATALITIES DAYS OF THE WEEK



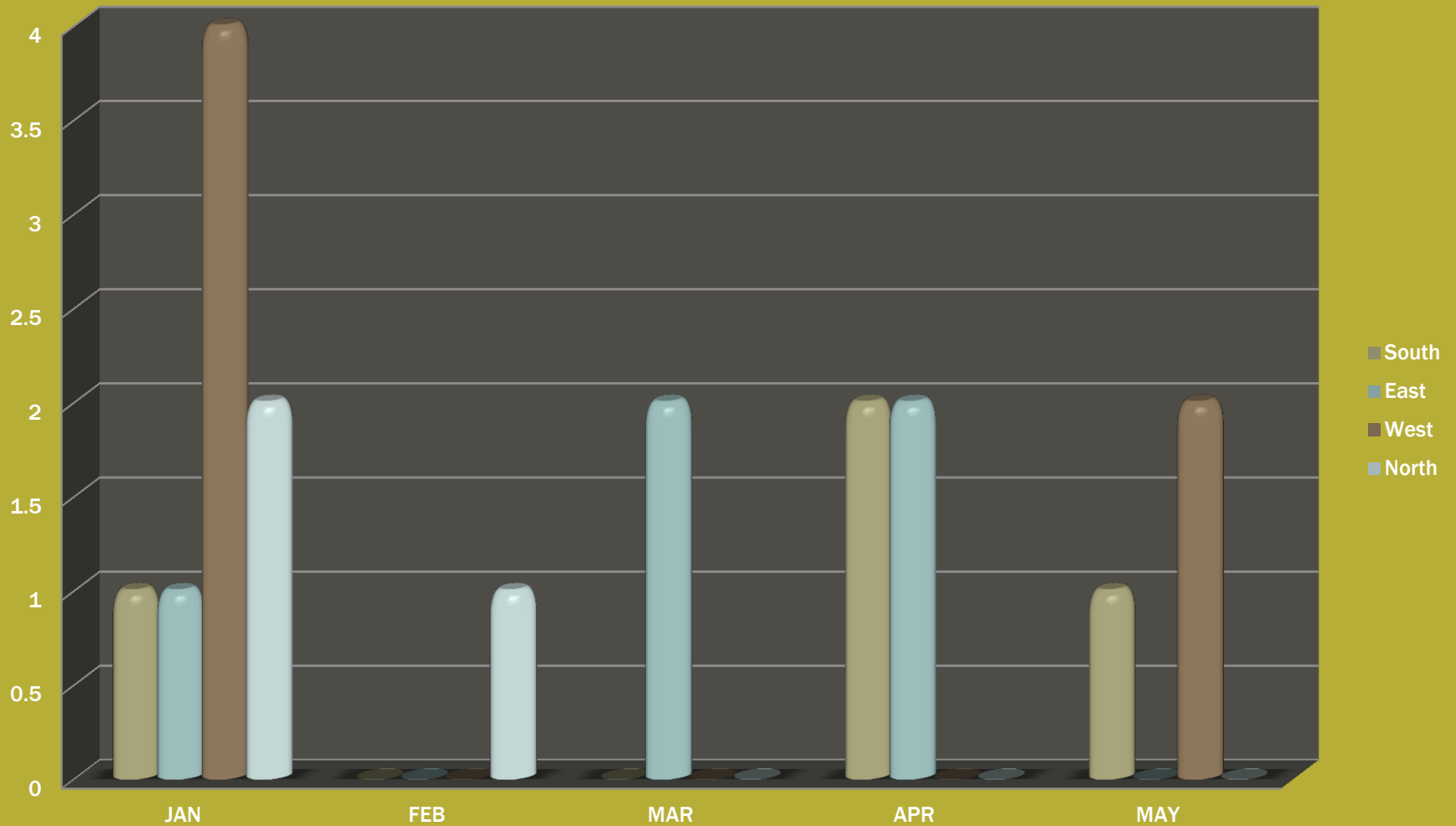
FIJI'S FATALITY TRENDS FOR THE PERIOD 1997-APRIL 2016
