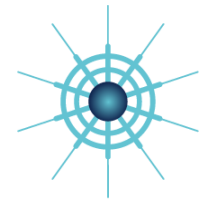

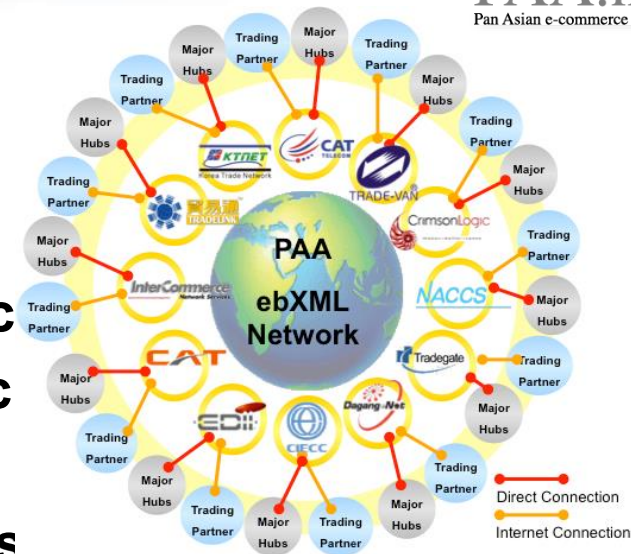

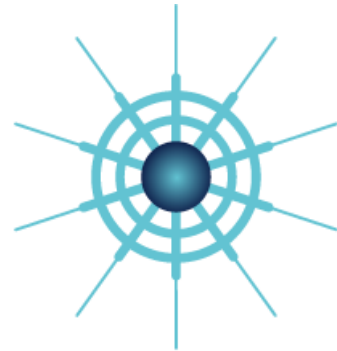

- To create a Pan-Asian portal to enable **global B2B connection** and communication.



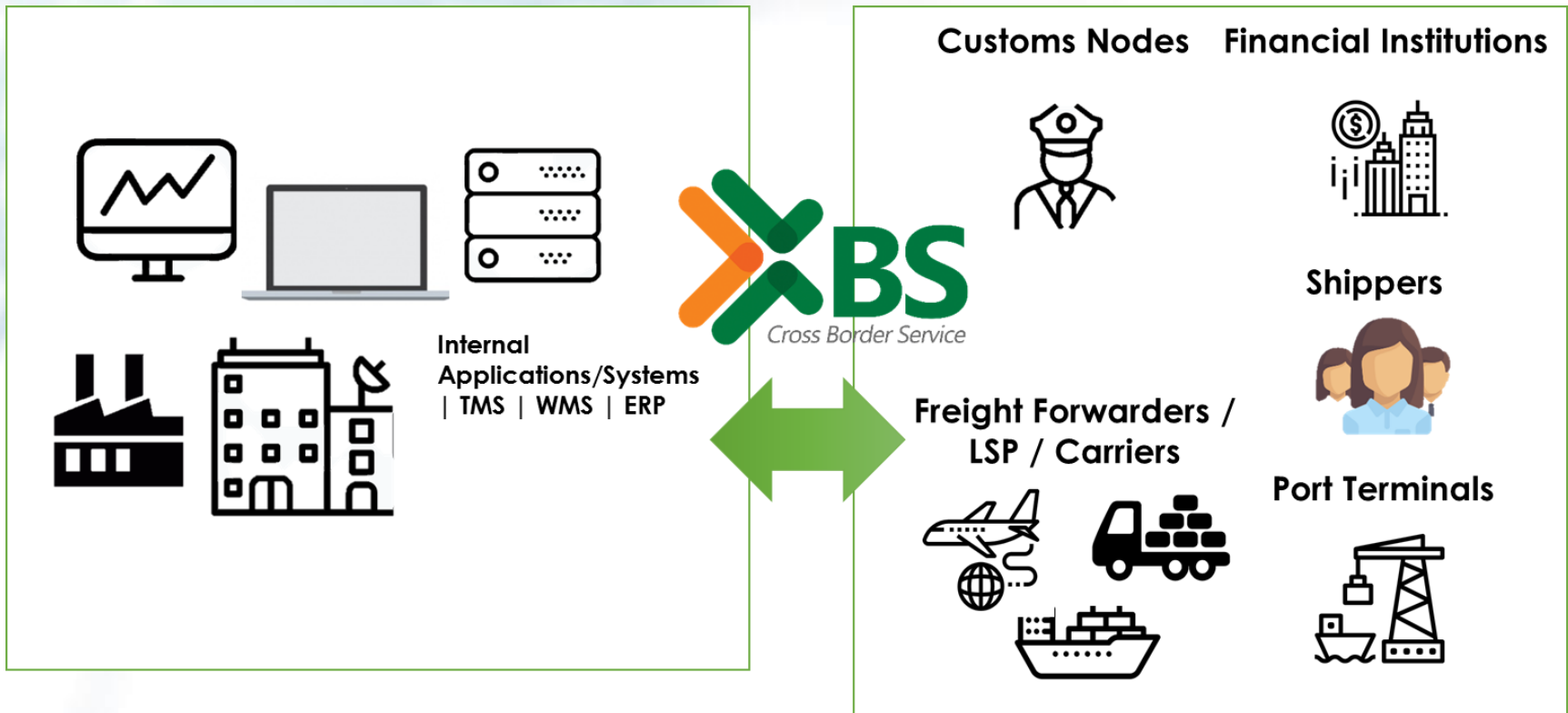

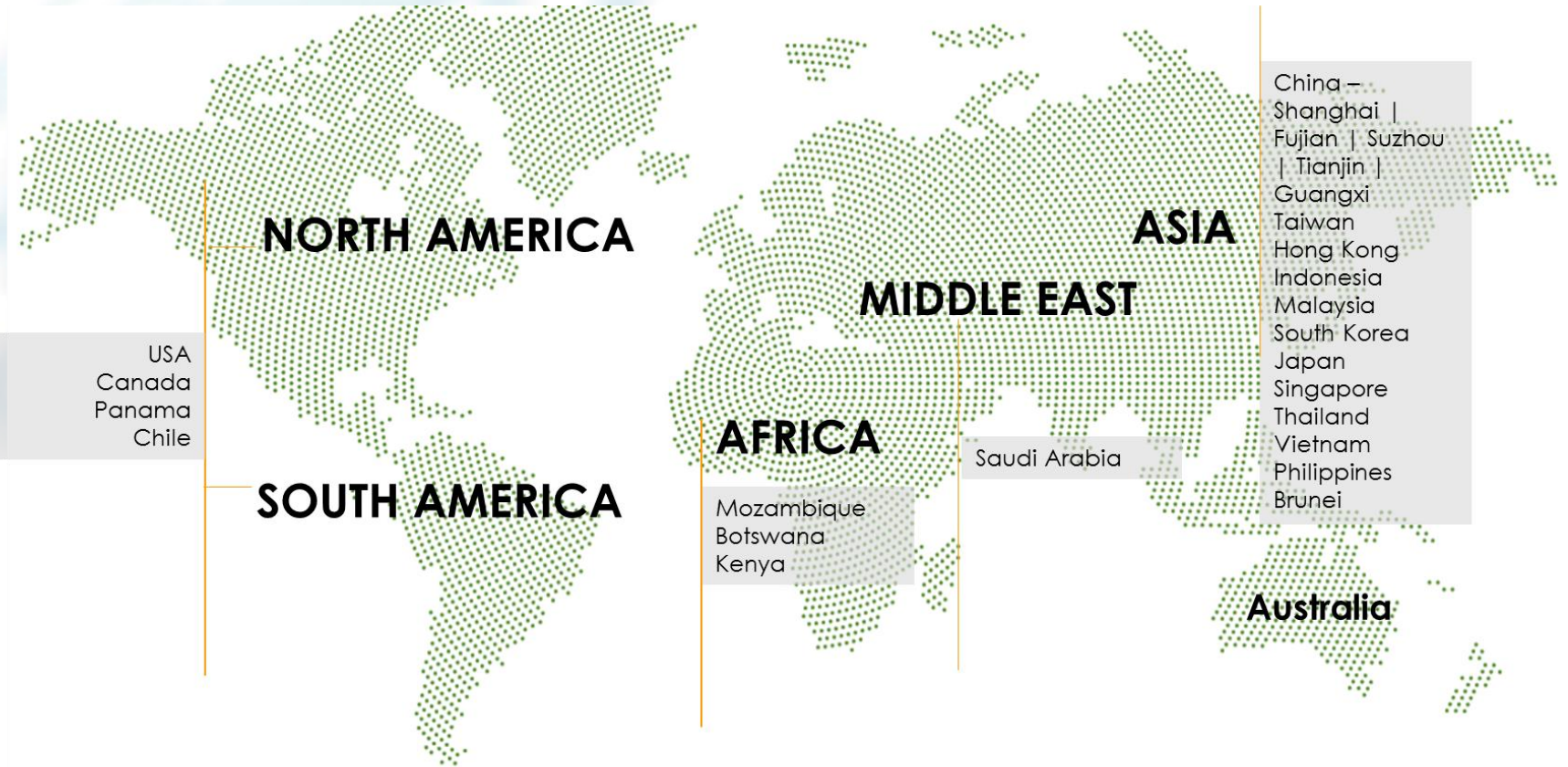

**SEAMLESS B2B COLLABORATION AND TRADE COMPLIANCE ACROSS COUNTRIES**

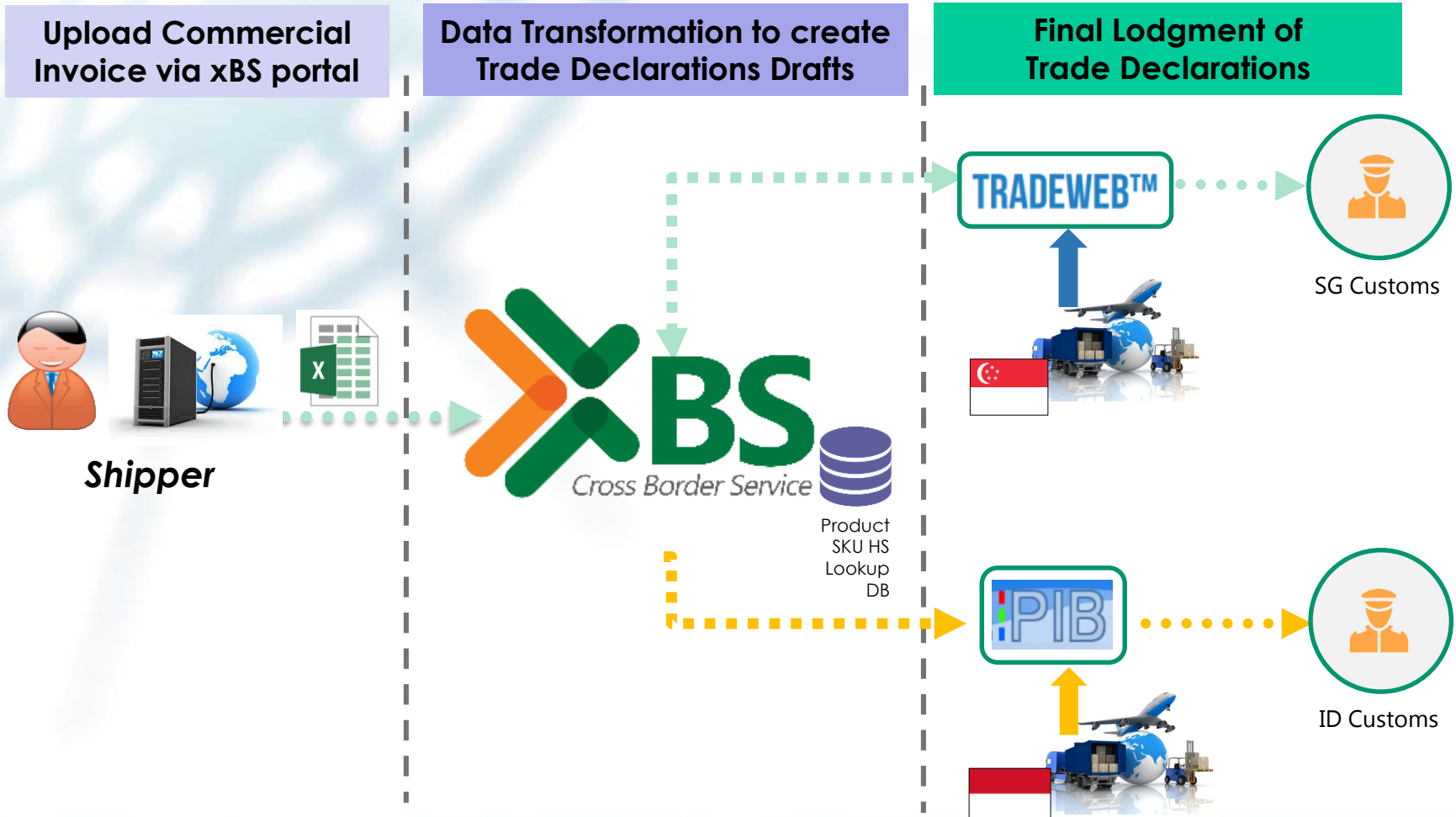


# Customs Nodes

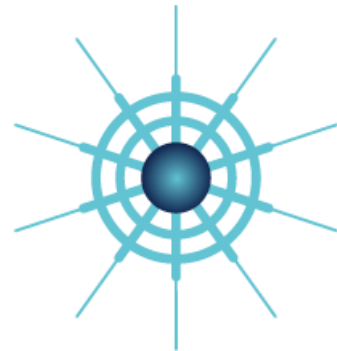
