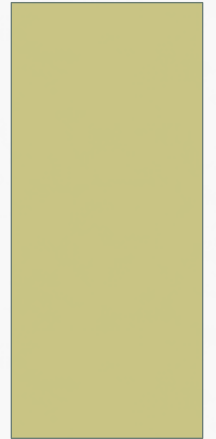
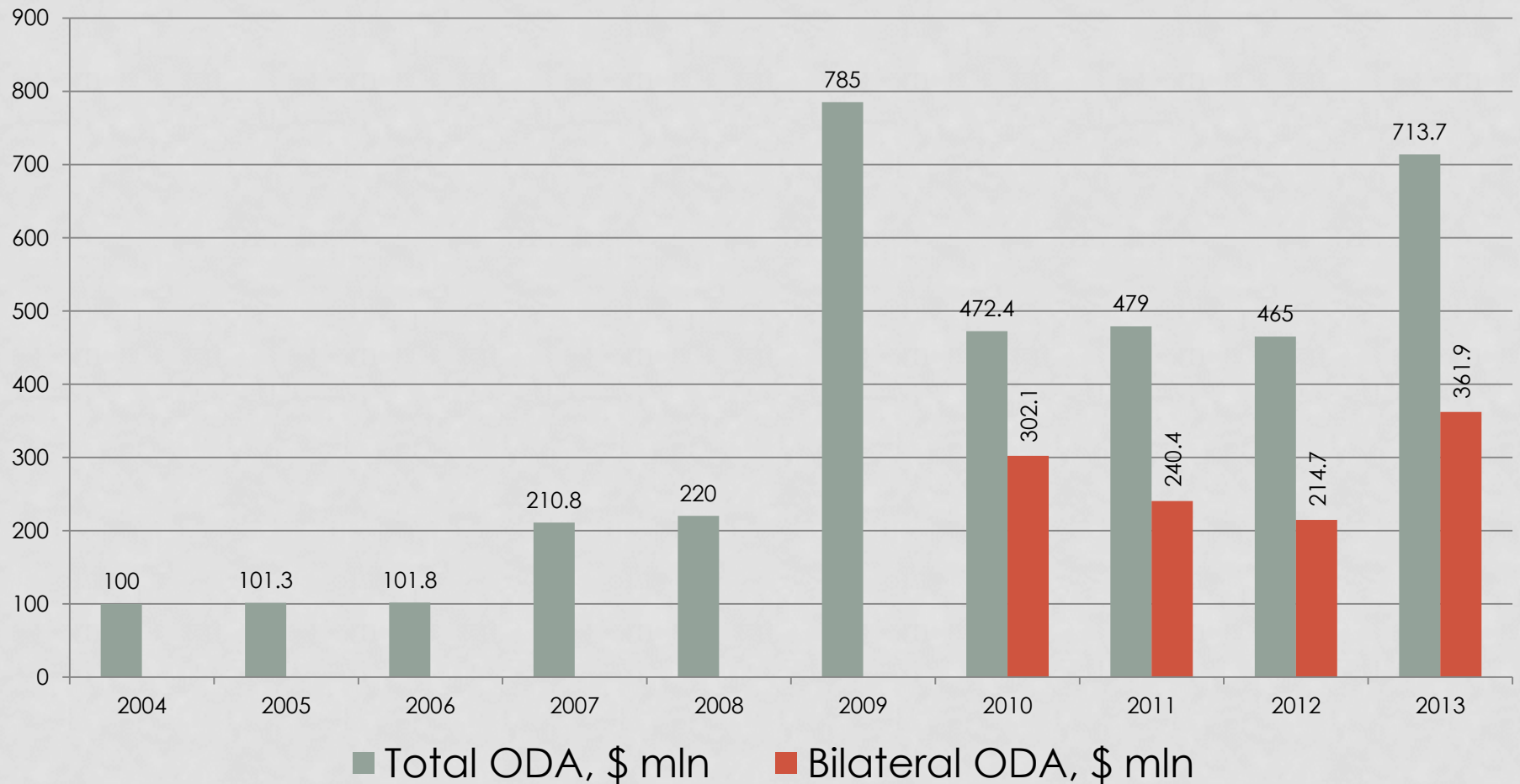

RUSSIAN CENTERS OF SCIENCE AND CULTURE

- Rossotrudnichestvo works in 80 countries
- 68 centers in 60 countries (Russian Cultural Center in Beijing)
- 25 representatives working in Russian embassies and consulates in 23 countries (Seoul, Tokyo)
- Plans to open centers in Seoul and Tokyo in 2016

PLAN OF ACTIONS TO REINVIGORATE INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE AND HUMANITARIAN COOPERATION ON THE BASIS OF RUSSIAN CENTERS OF SCIENCE AND CULTURE IN 2014-16, 9 OCTOBER 2014

- Focus on cooperation with Asia-Pacific Region: attracting investments to Russia, development of Russia's Far East, promotion of regional security
- Sharing information on Russia's development assistance
- Transfer of the property owned by Russian Defense Ministry to foreign countries' authorities
- Presentation of Russia's potential of emergency assistance
- Russian language for labor migrants from Commonwealth of Independent States

CONCEPT OF RUSSIA'S PARTICIPATION IN INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC INSTITUTIONS

- Draft Concept of May 2013
- Russia's donor multilateral and bilateral potential:
- Strengthening economic cooperation with partner-countries, stimulating integration of partner-countries' capital, goods and services Russia's ones.
- Technical cooperation projects to increase Russia's international influence, create favorable conditions for Russian goods access to foreign markets, promote Russian goods and services, create GVCs in the interest of Russian producers, attract FDI to Russia.

CONCEPT OF RUSSIA'S PARTICIPATION IN INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC INSTITUTIONS

- **UNDP**
- Promotion of regional economic integration, good governance, energy, environmental protection, ICT, human capital, food security and poverty reduction in CIS
- Creation of a trust fund to extend development assistance focusing on CIS
- Creating conditions for Russian companies and experts' participation in UNDP projects

CONCEPT OF RUSSIA'S PARTICIPATION IN INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC INSTITUTIONS

- **UNCTAD**

- Promotion of Russia's approaches to international development agenda
- Creating conditions for extending Russia's economic presence in developing countries and transition economies

- **IBRD**

- Increasing Russia's contribution to implement international investment projects focusing on post-Soviet area

CONCEPT OF RUSSIA'S PARTICIPATION IN INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC INSTITUTIONS

- **World Food Program**
- Exploring possibility of in kind contribution to WFP (in addition to financial aid) to extend presence of Russian products at foreign markets
- Russian regions participation in humanitarian aid projects
- **BRICS**
- Coordination of national development strategies
- New Development Bank creation
