## New Actors

- **Dual identities:** have experiences both as receiving countries and donors. The historical legacy, philosophical thinking, embedded context and relationship in practices are fundamentally different.





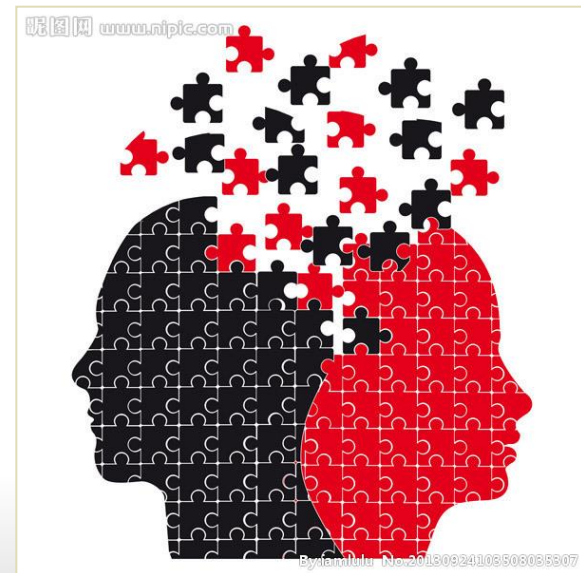
# New Approaches
