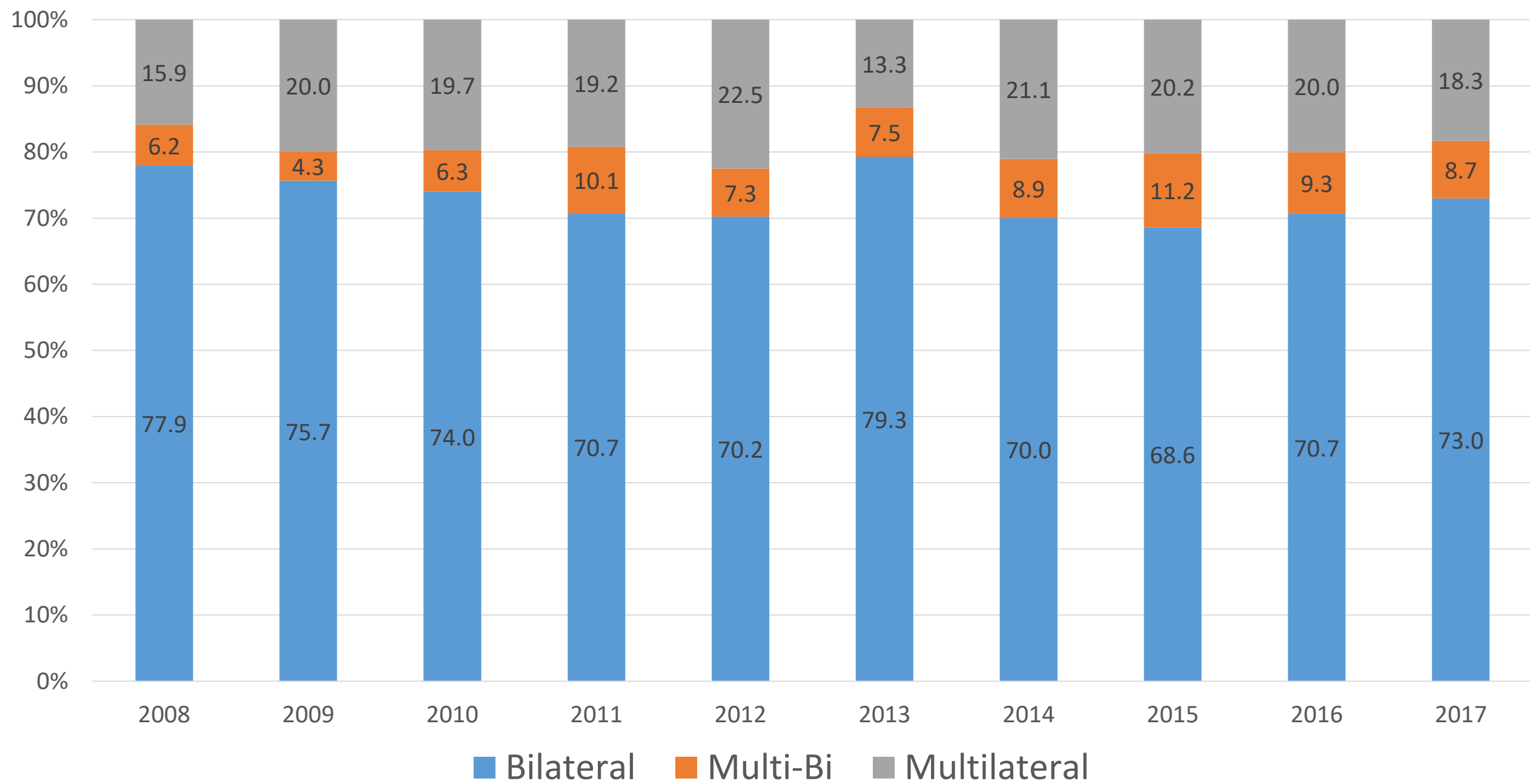

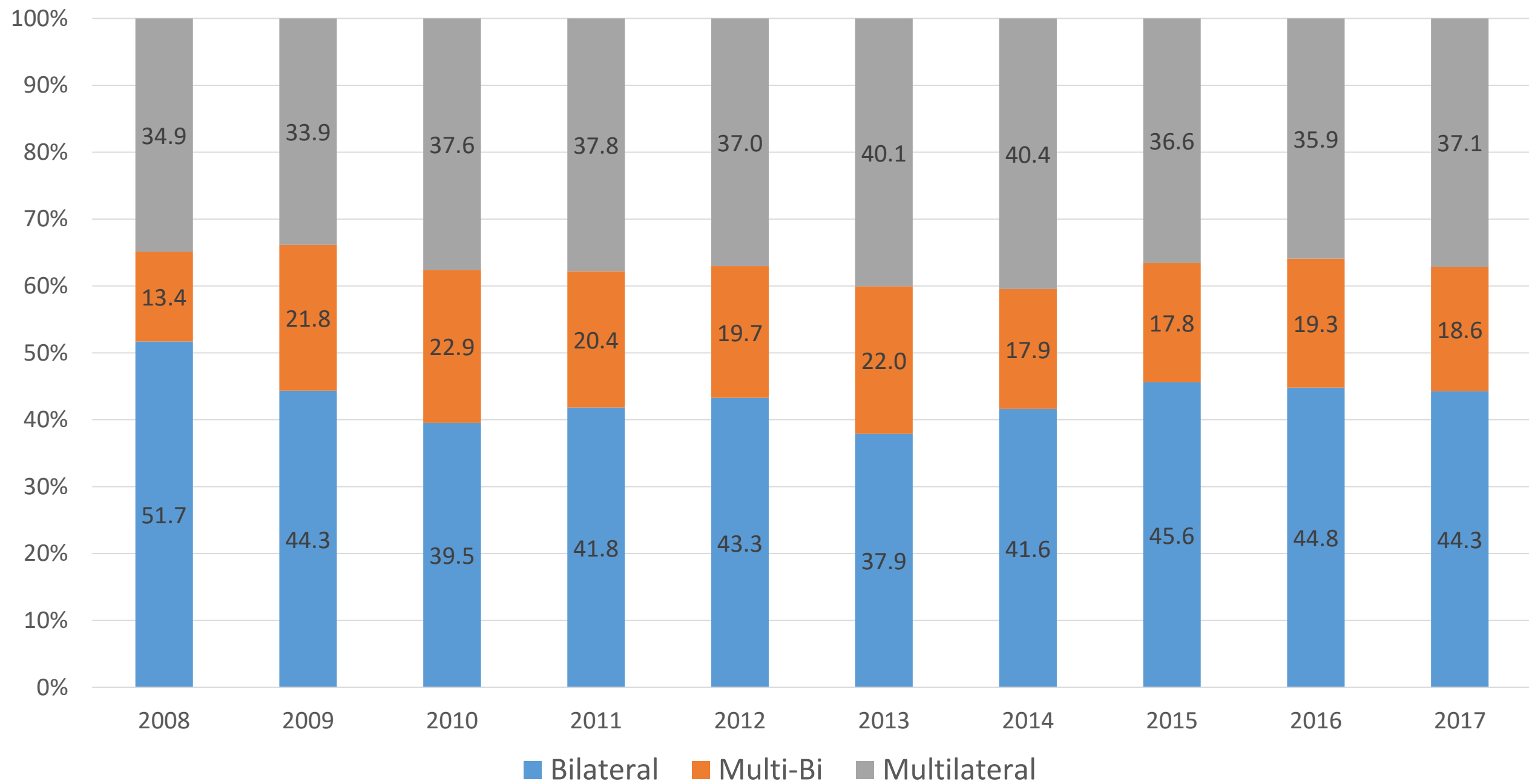

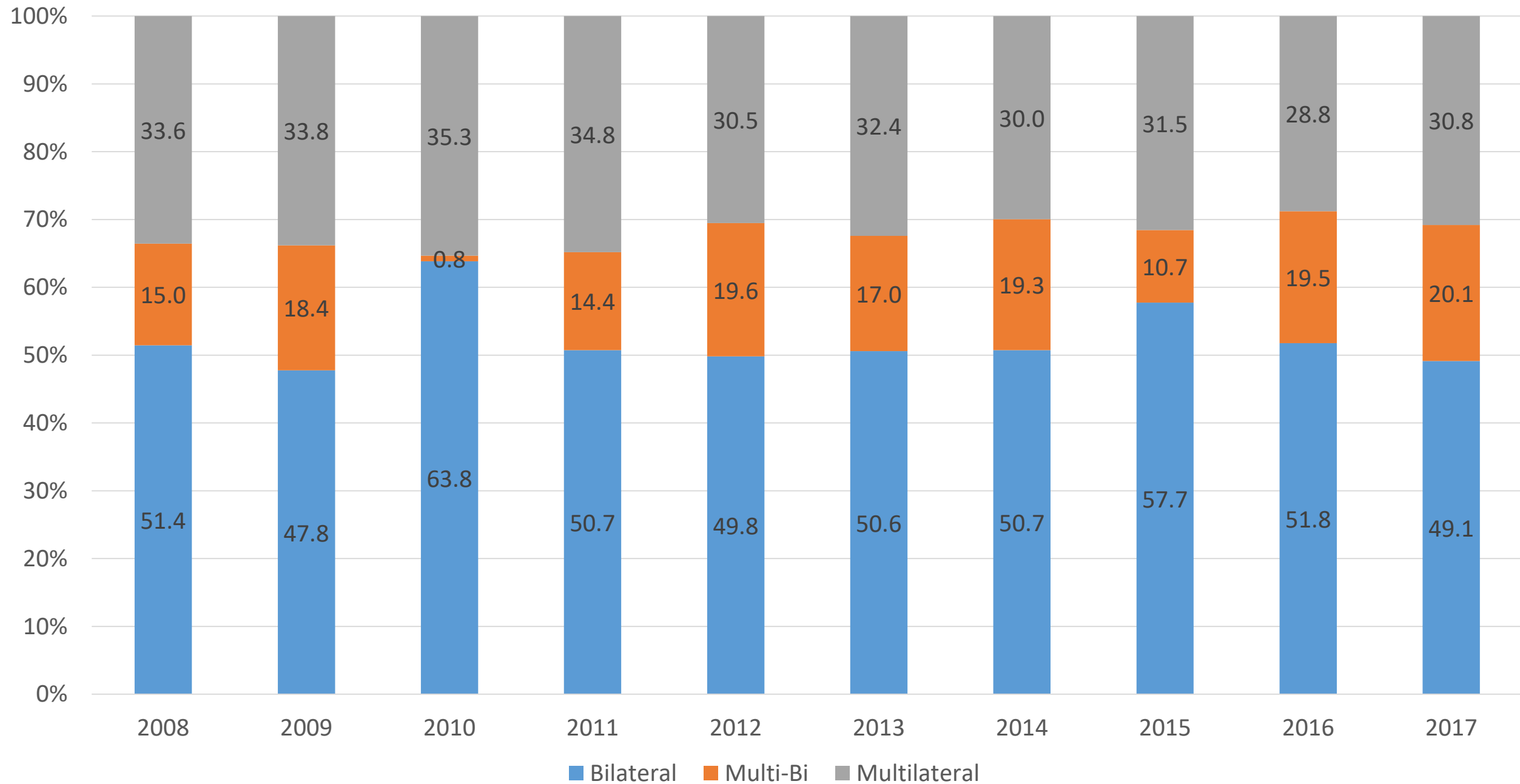

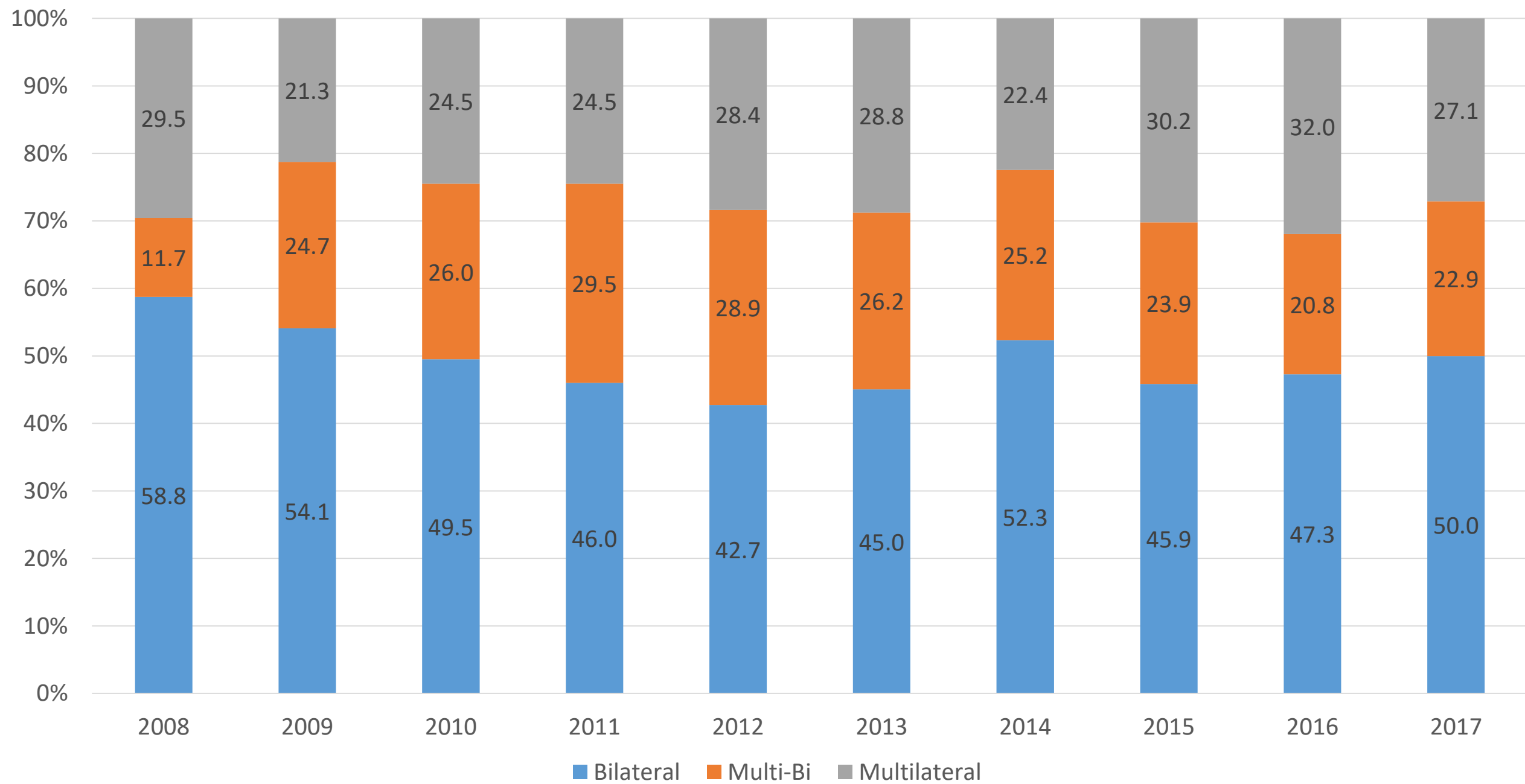

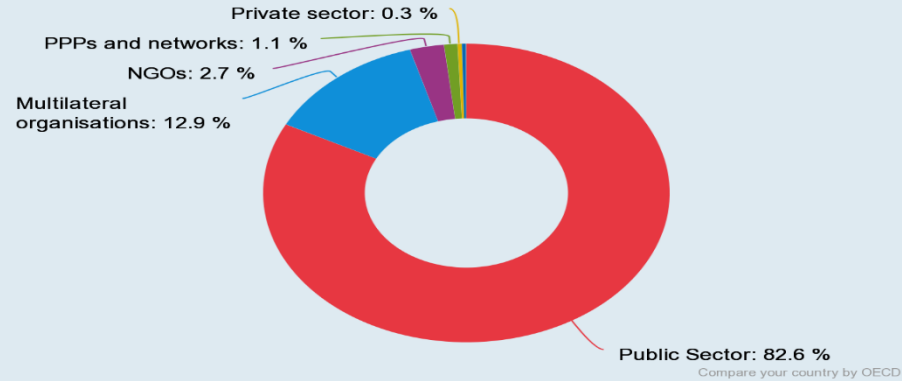

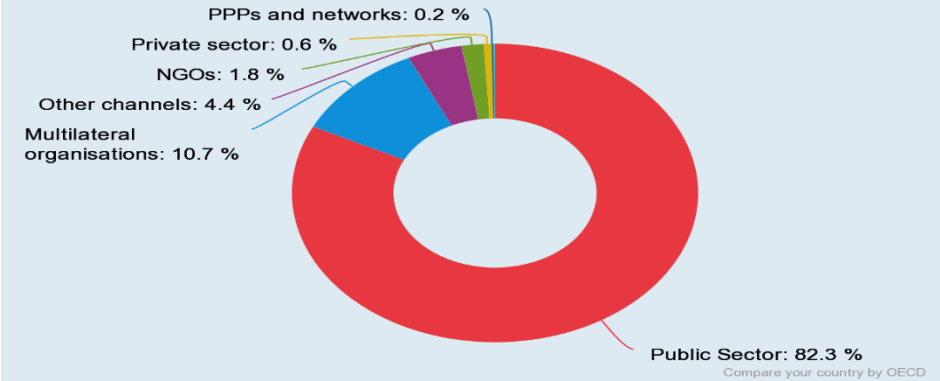
Korea - Bilateral ODA by channel of delivery 2017

Gross disbursements, per cent



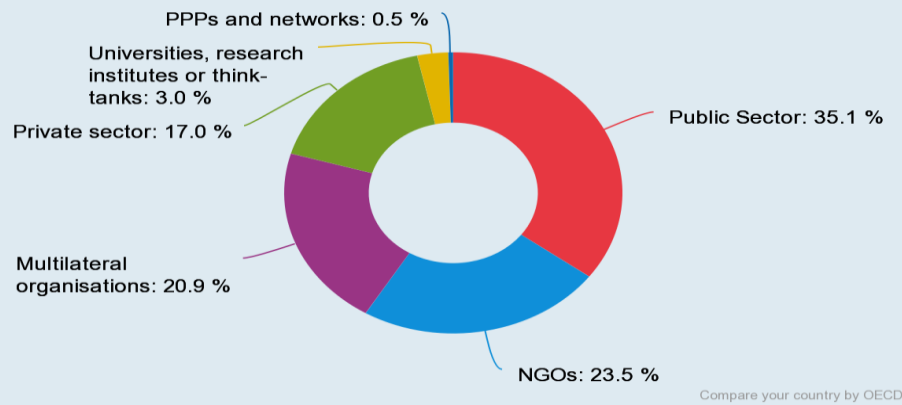
Japan - Bilateral ODA by channel of delivery 2017

Gross disbursements, per cent



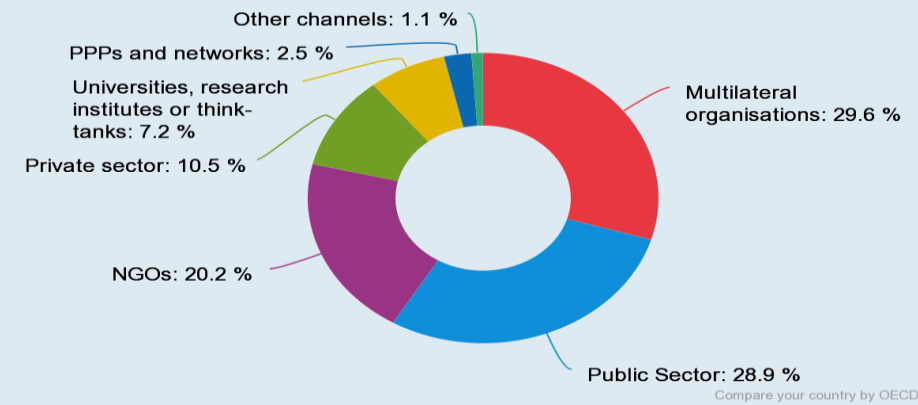
United States - Bilateral ODA by channel of delivery 2017

Gross disbursements, per cent



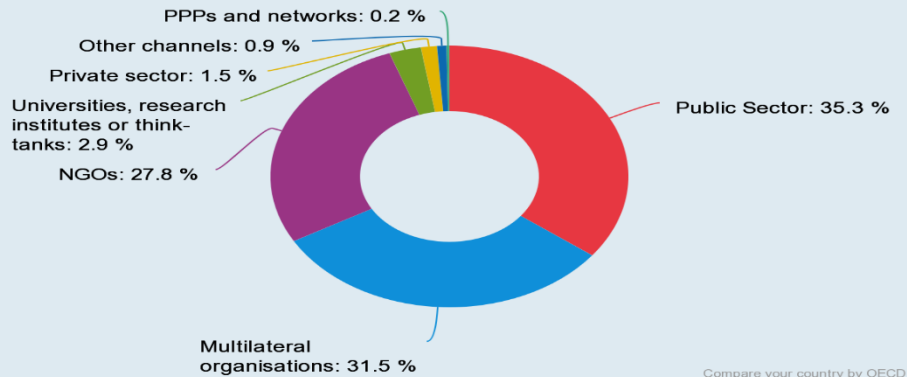
United Kingdom - Bilateral ODA by channel of delivery 2017

Gross disbursements, per cent



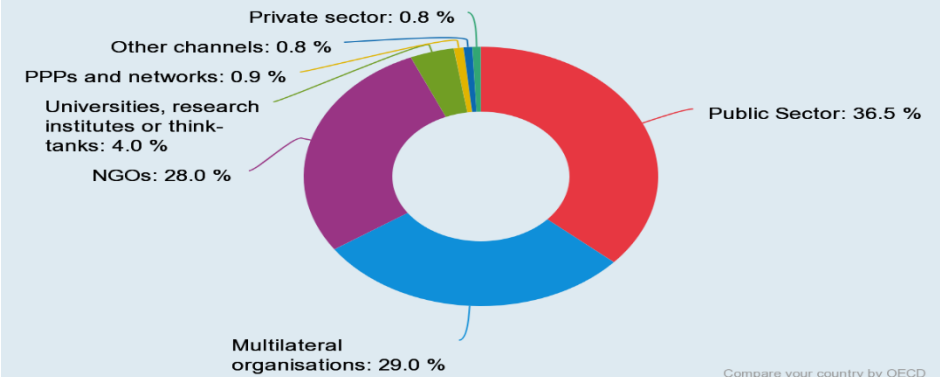
Canada - Bilateral ODA by channel of delivery 2017

Gross disbursements, per cent



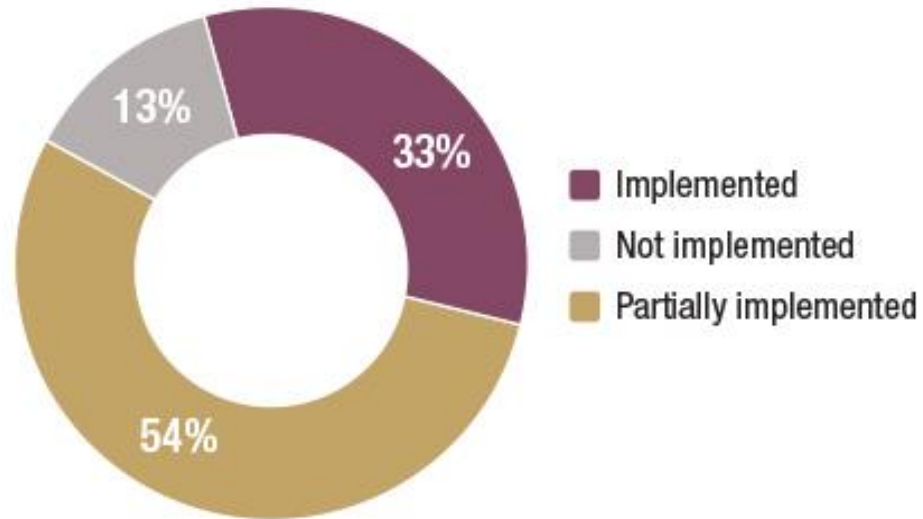
Sweden - Bilateral ODA by channel of delivery 2017

Gross disbursements, per cent

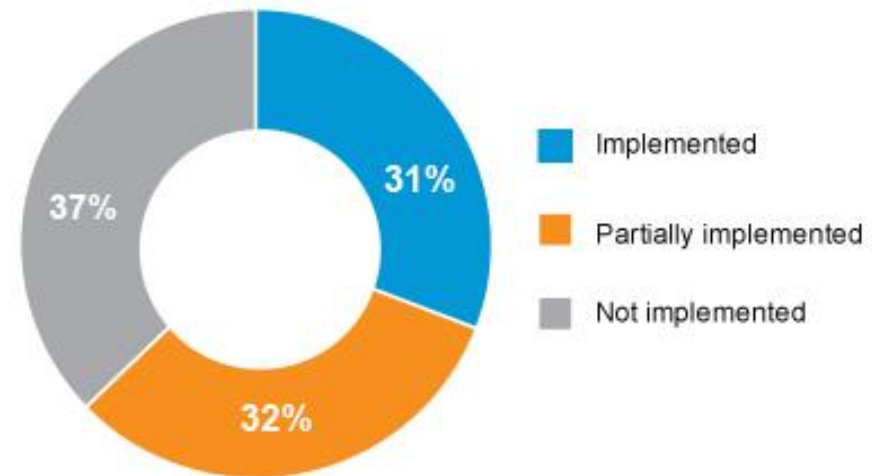
