The main objectives of the Union shall be as follows:

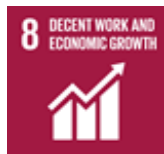
*to create proper conditions for

of the Member States in order to improve the
living standards of their population;
[...].*



- Goals and directions of the EAEU economic development *largely coincide* with the goals and objectives of the Agenda for Sustainable Development
- Regional economic integration *contributes to SDGs achievement* within the Union and becomes an additional tool to support high-quality and sustainable growth in the Member States

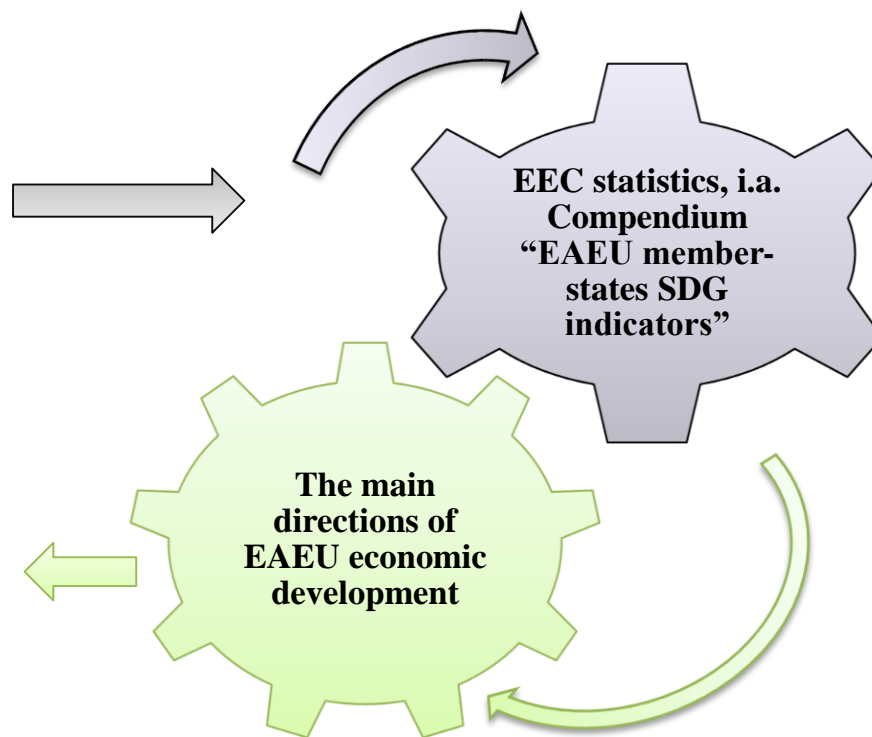

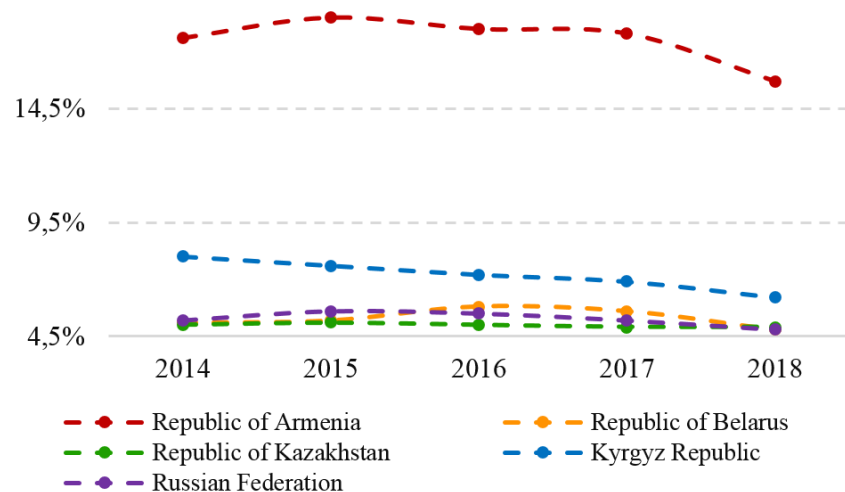

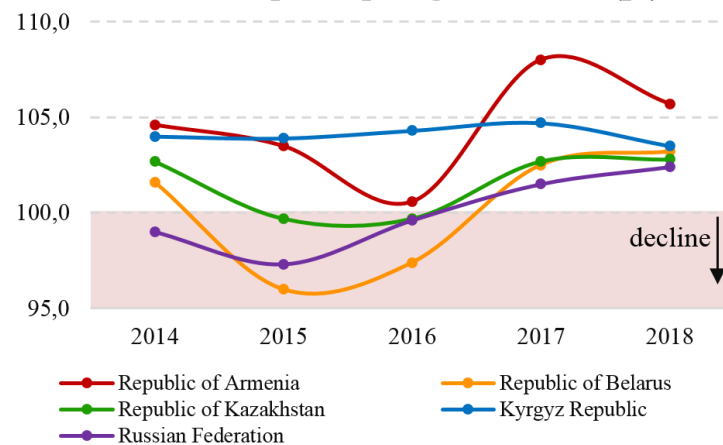

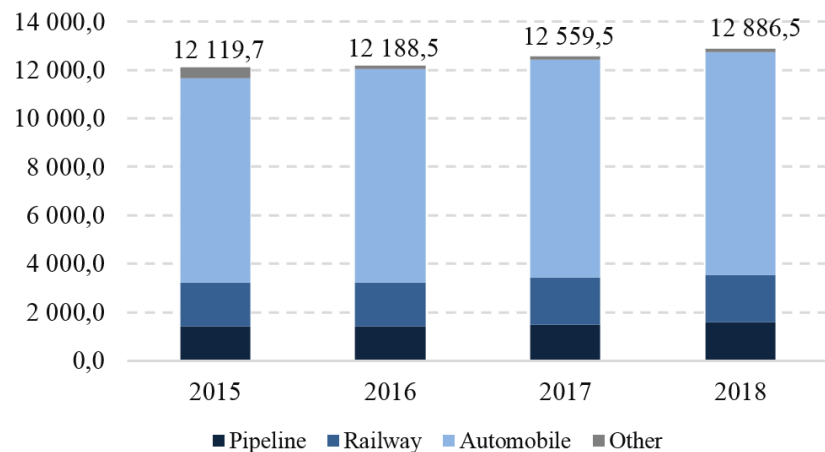
Rate of unemployment (%)



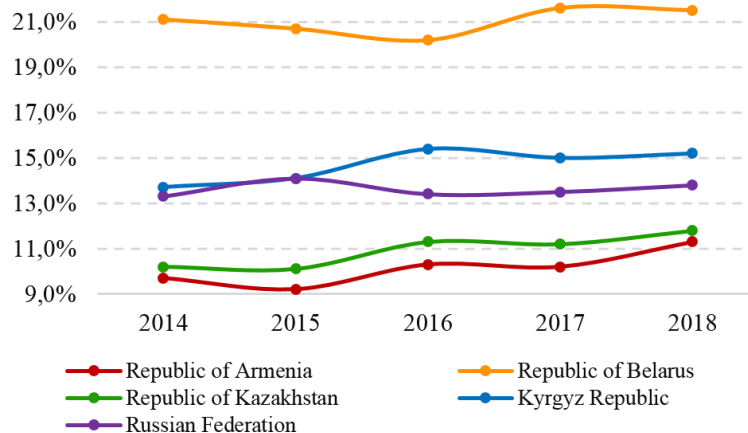
Real GDP per capita growth rate (p.)



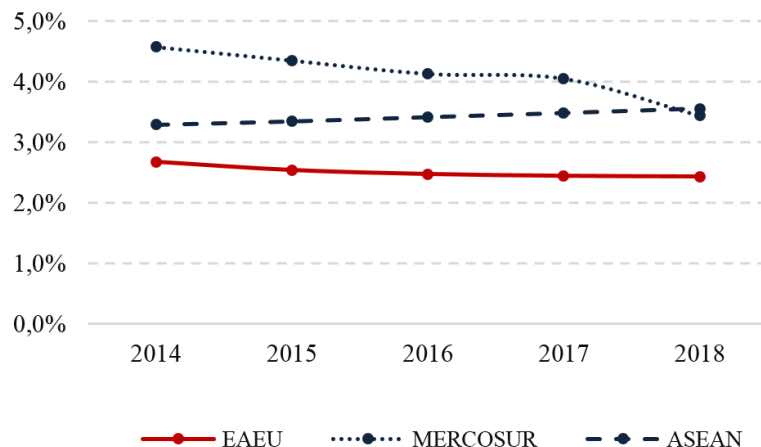
Frigh volumes (mln tones)



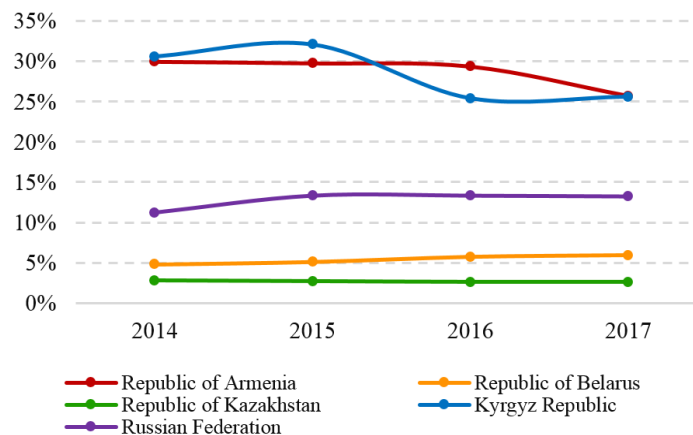
Manufacturing value added (% GDP)



Share in world GDP (%, constant USD)

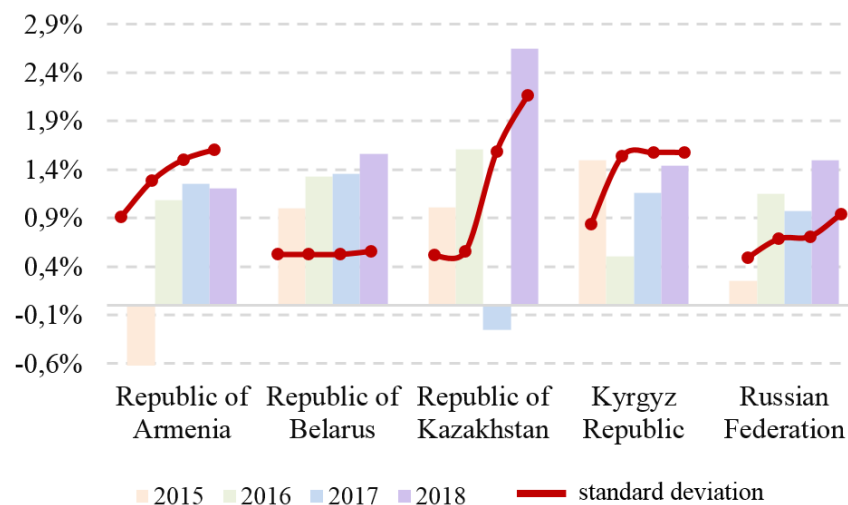


Population below the national poverty line (%)

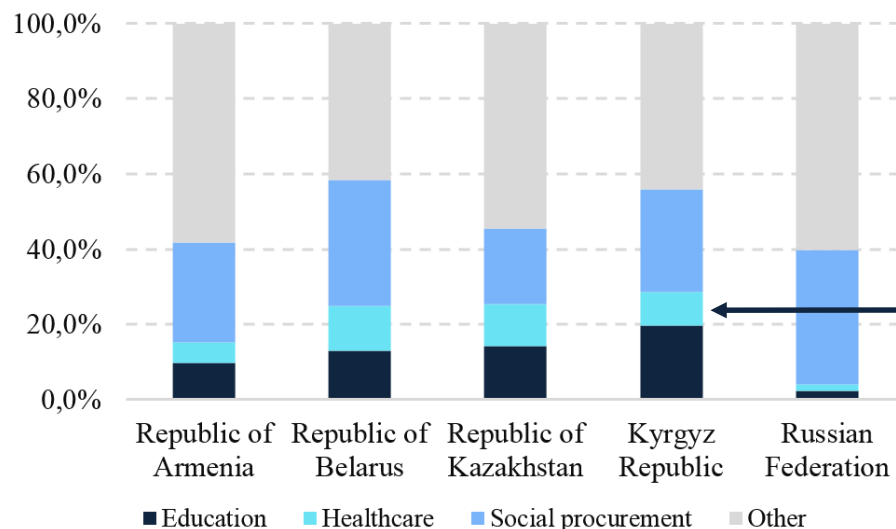

Government spending structure, 2017



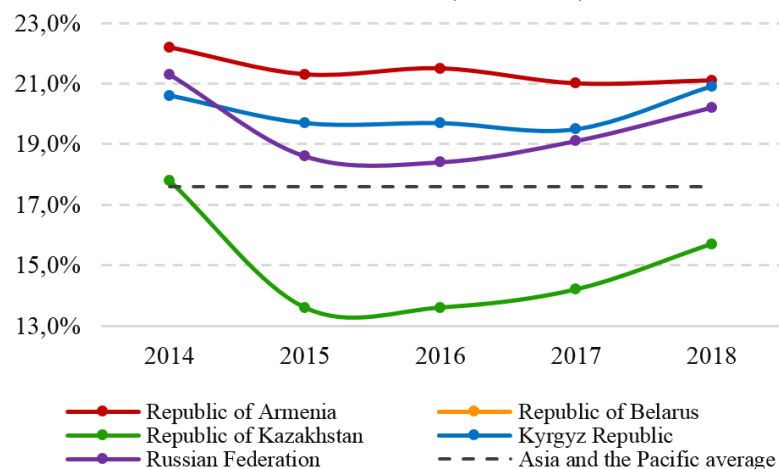
The outcomes of healthcare

Kyrgyz Republic (as of 2018)

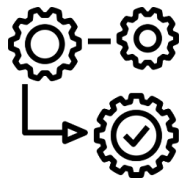
Per 1000 live birth:

Tax revenue (% GDP)





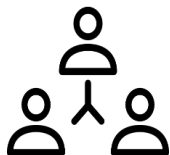
Empowering the Eurasian Economic Commission as SDG achievement coordinating body

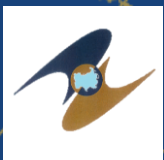
