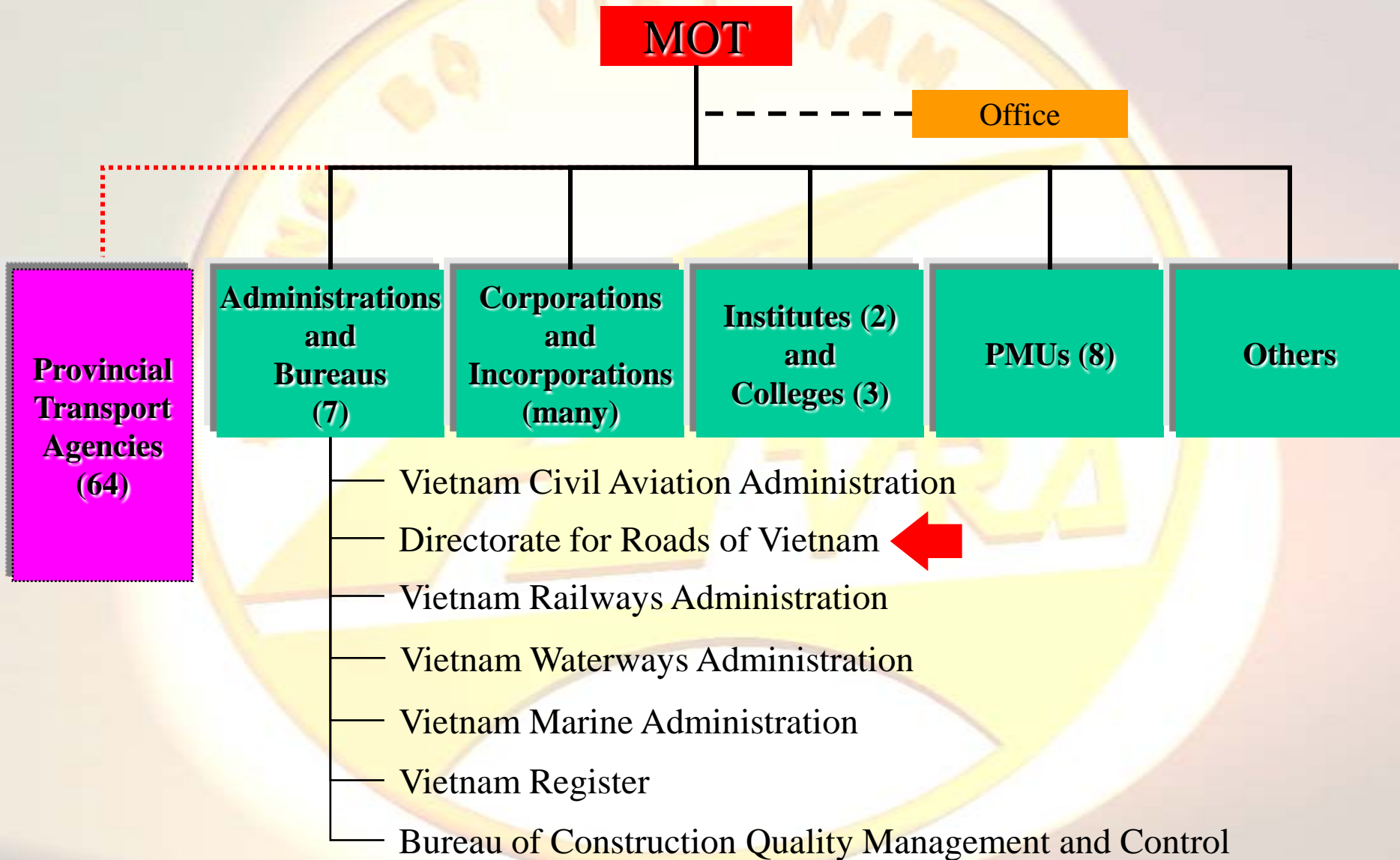
# **general view of the Vietnam Road Network**

DRVN's duty and responsibility are defined according to the decision No 107/2009/QĐ-TTg dated 26 August 2009 of Prime Minister”

# Position of DRVN

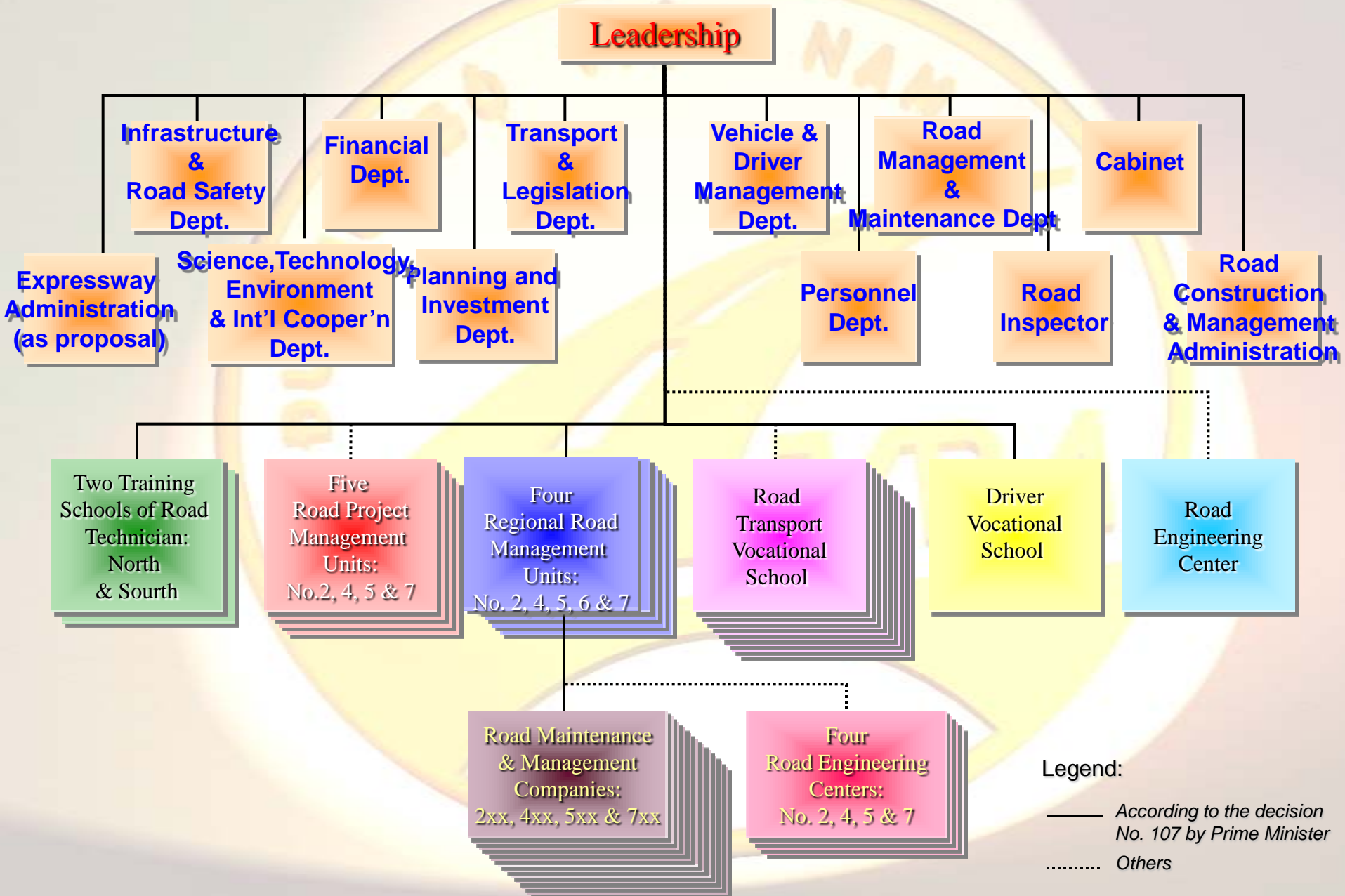


## Main tasks

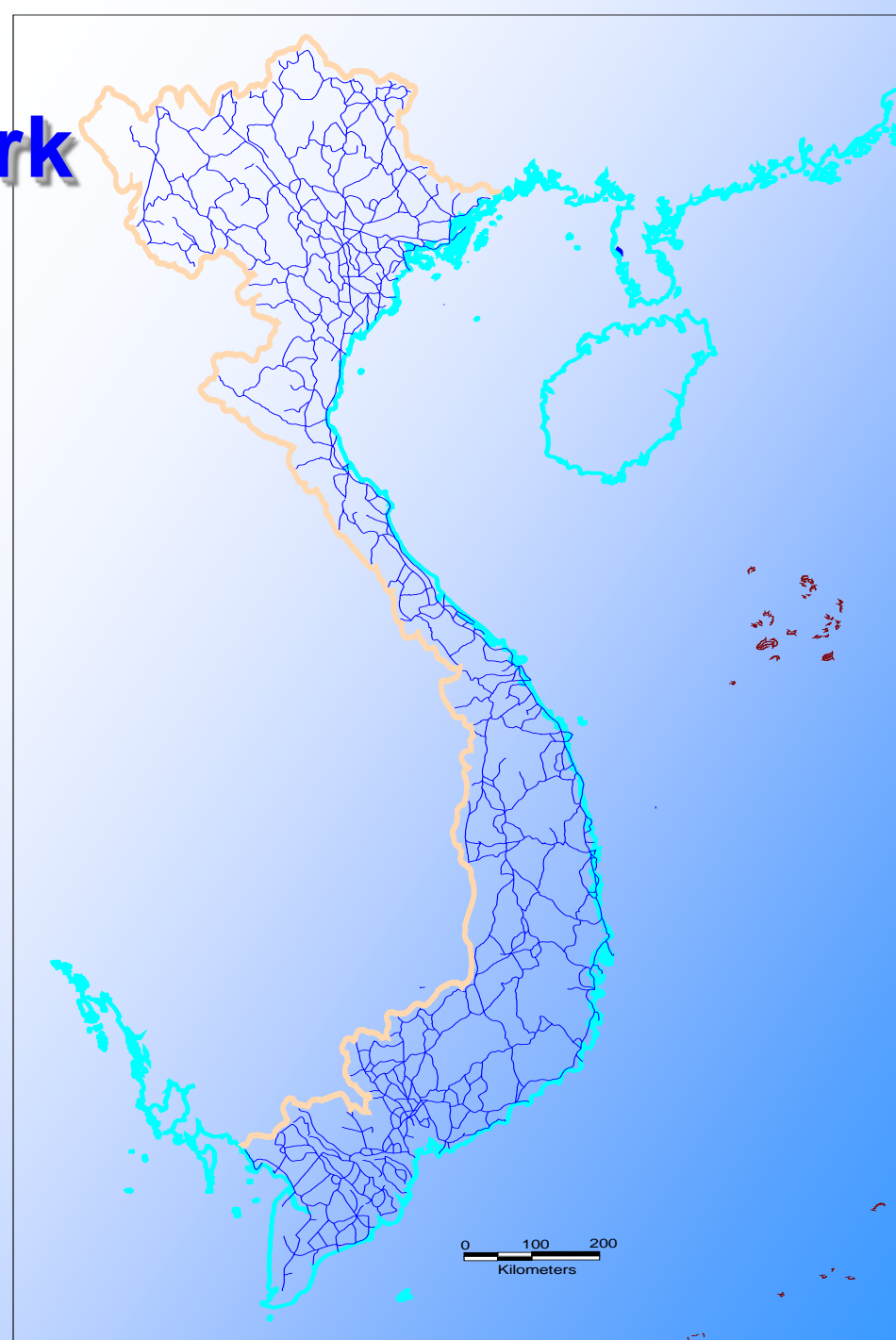

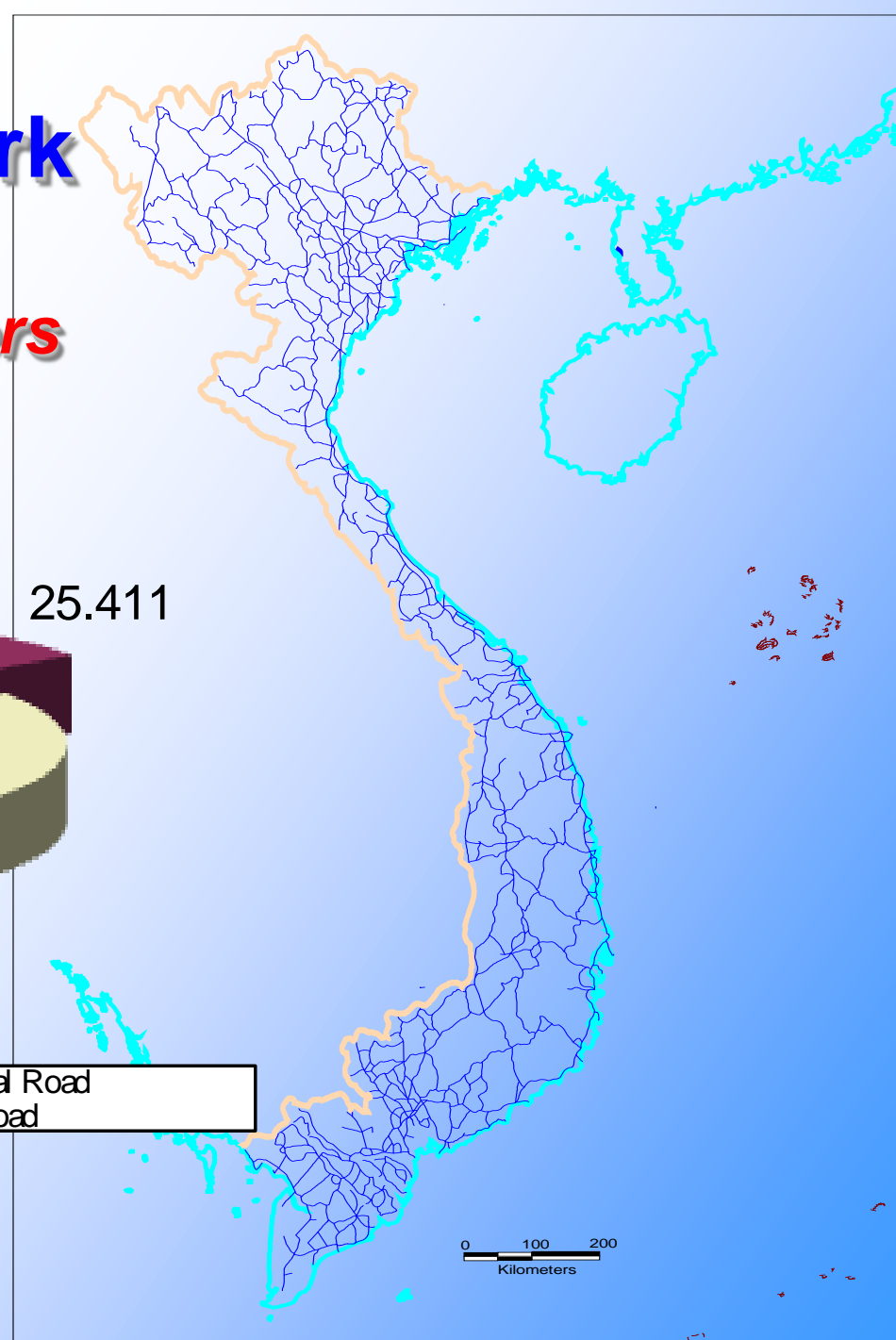
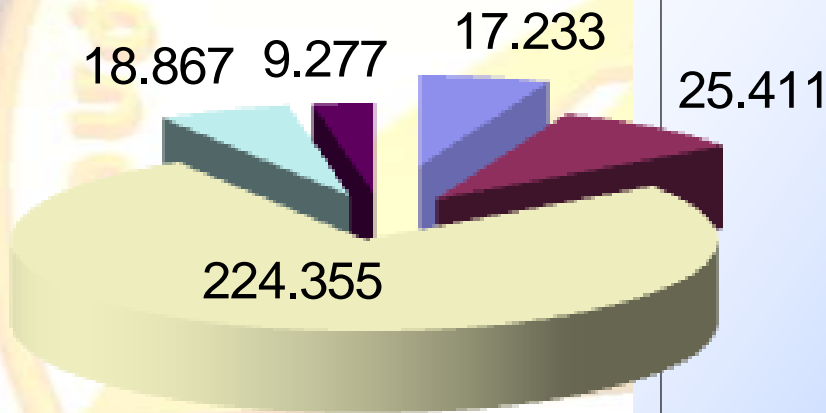

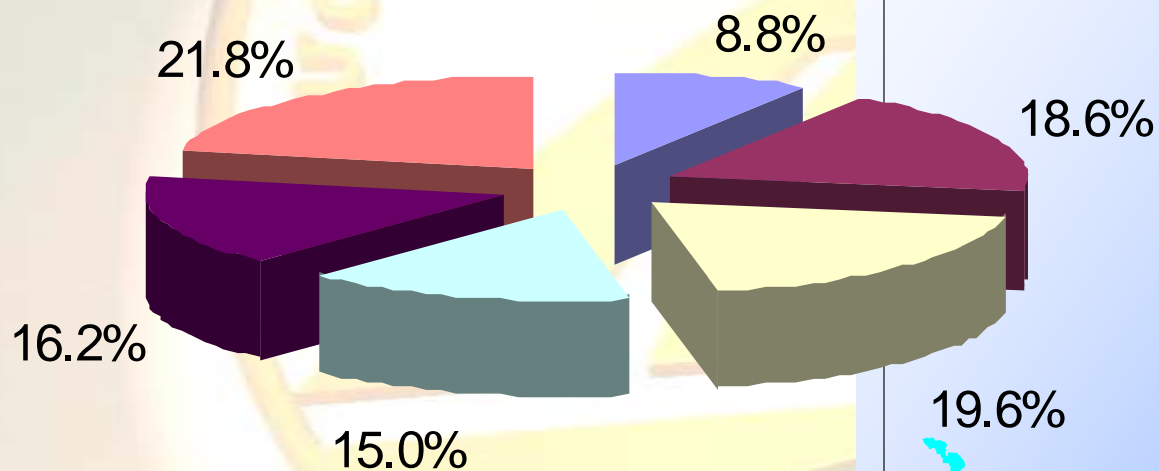

## Composition by Kilometers

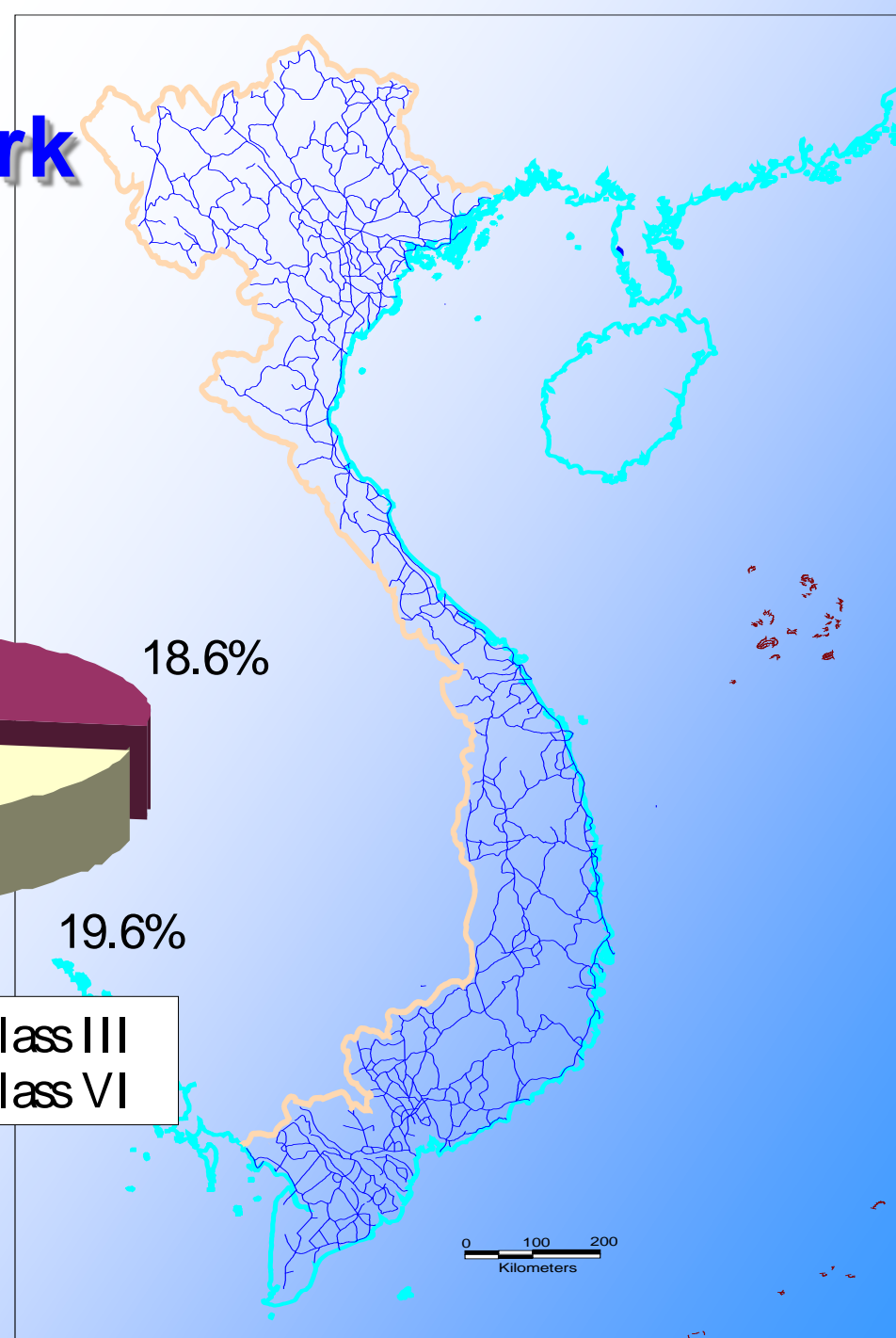

## *Classification by Lengths*

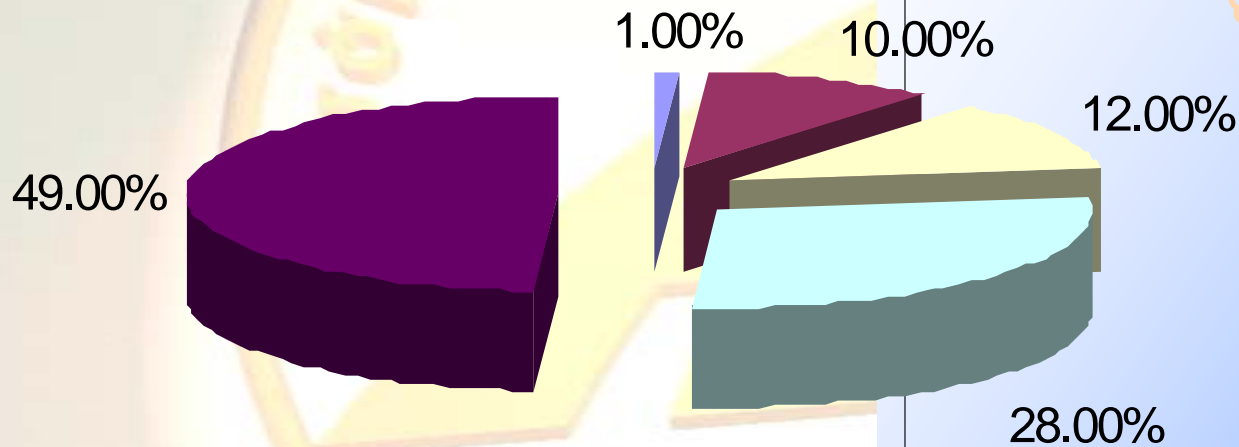


Class I	Class II	Class III

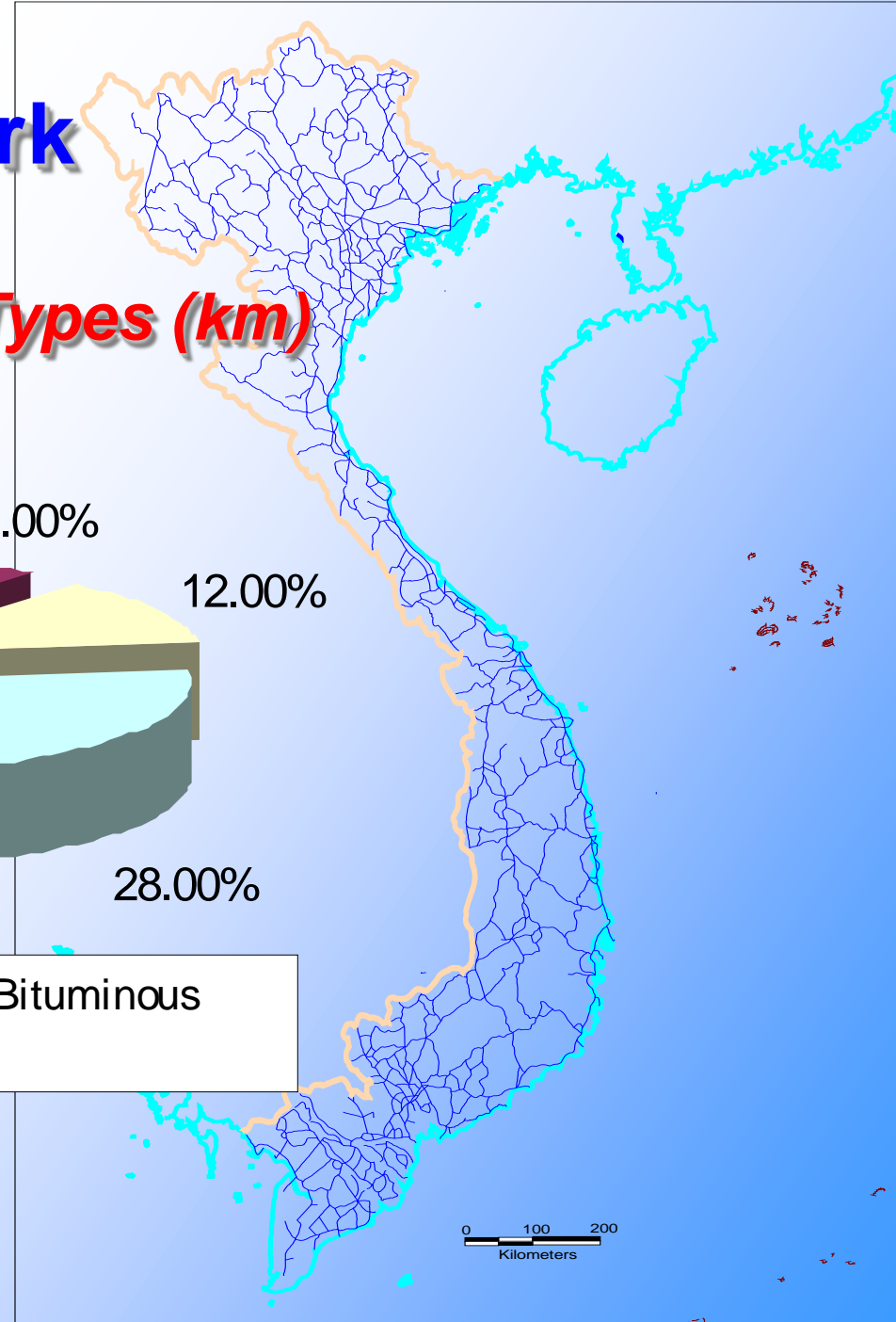


# Vietnam Road Network

## *Classification by Surface Types (km)*



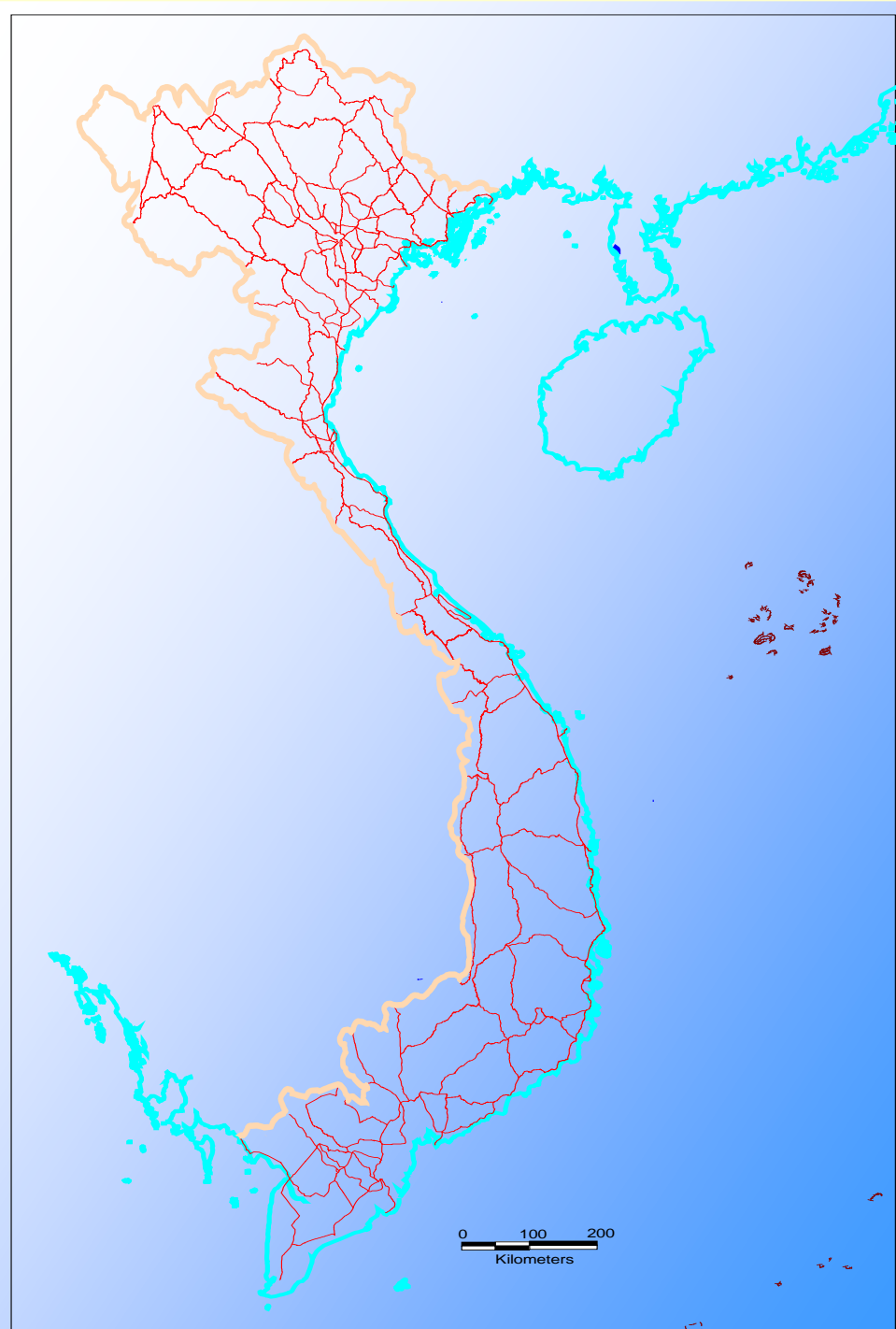
■ Cement Concrete ■ Asphalt Concrete ■ Bituminous  
■ Gravel ■ Earth Road





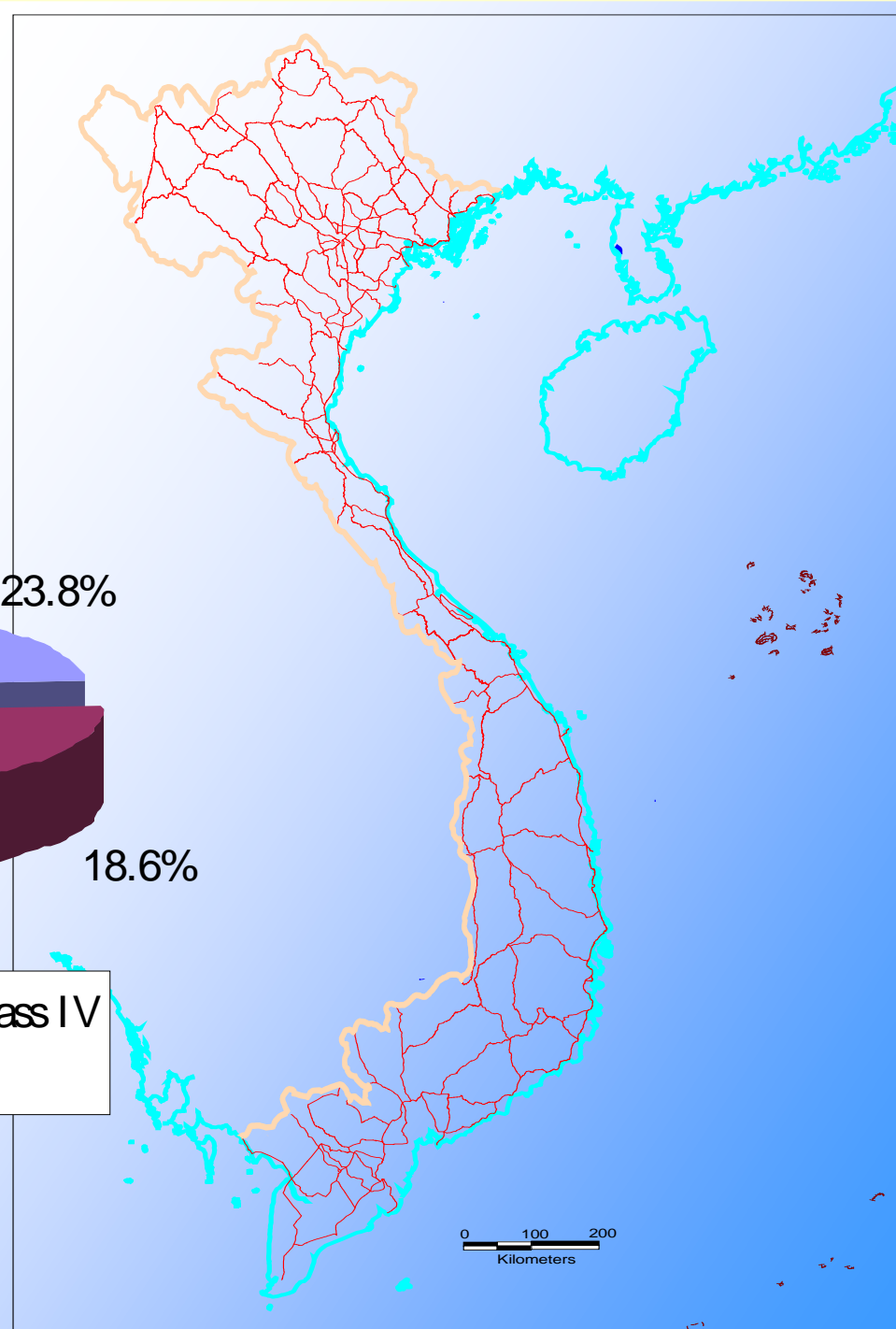
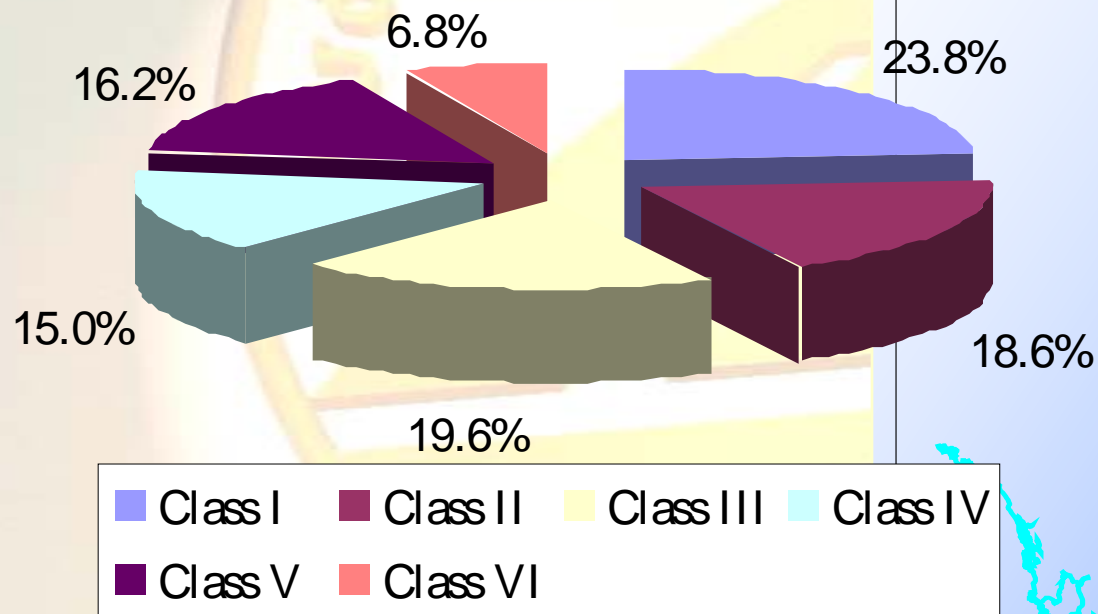

## Classification by Lengths



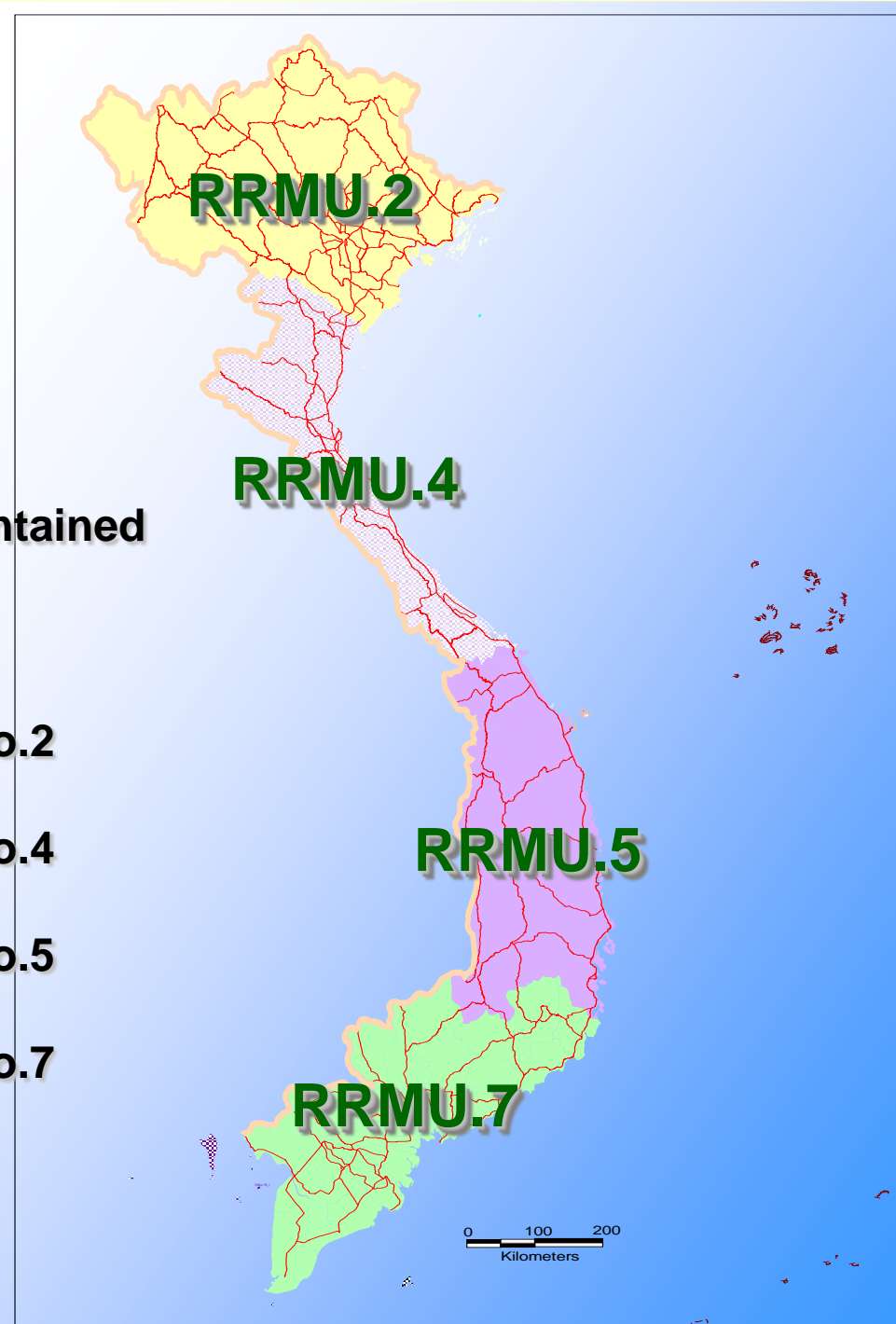
# National Road

## *M&M by Region*

The length of road managed and maintained by RRMUs is 9,403 km (main routes).

There are four RRMUs:

- Regional Road Management Unit No.2 (RRMU.2)
- Regional Road Management Unit No.4 (RRMU.4)
- Regional Road Management Unit No.5 (RRMU.5)
- Regional Road Management Unit No.7 (RRMU.7)



# National Road

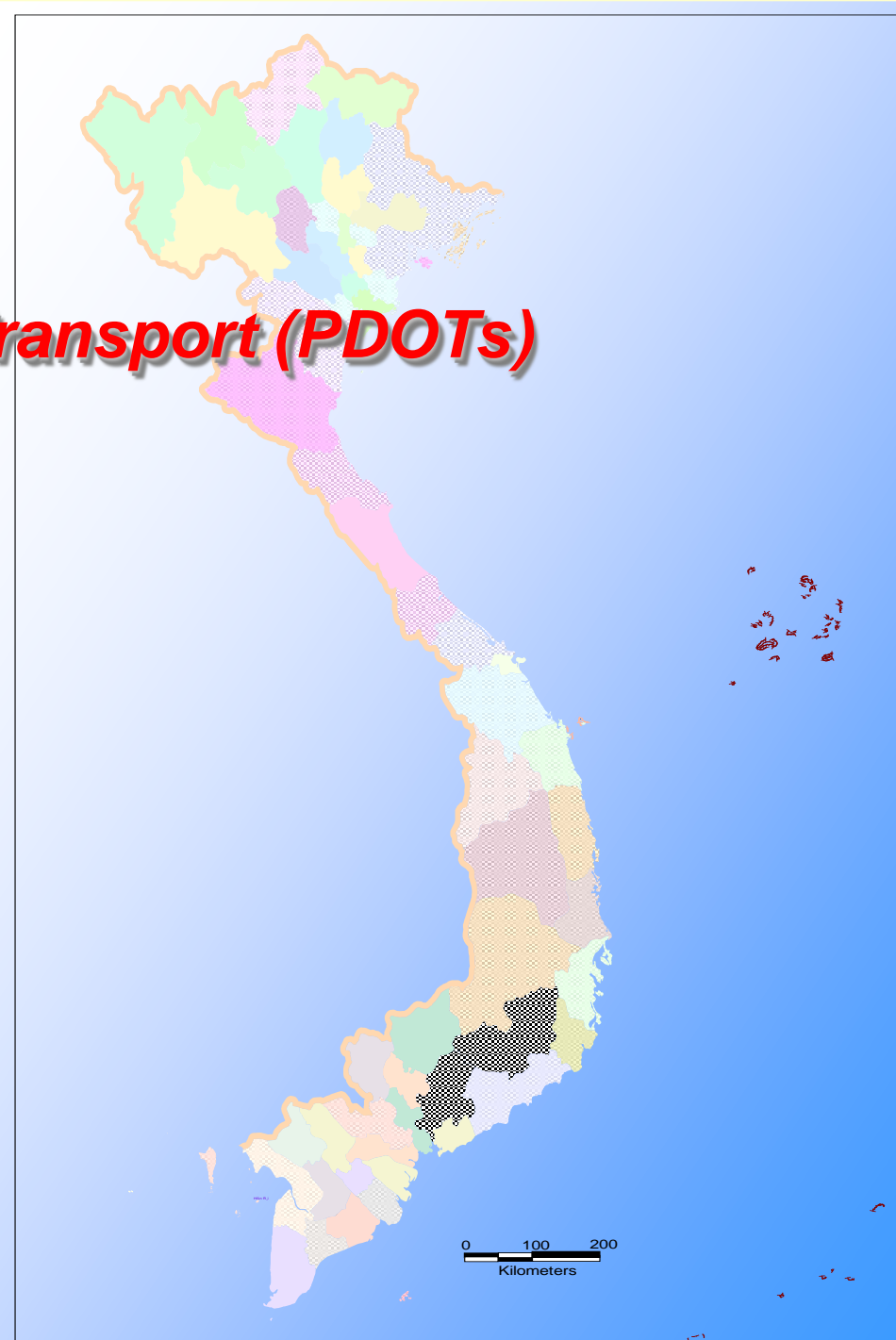
## *M&M by Provincial Department of Transport (PDOTs)*

MOT authorises the management and maintenance (M&M) of 7,830 km of National Roads to Provincial People Committees (PPC).

PPC assigns PDOT doing the M&M.

There are 48/63 provinces to be authorised.

DRVN allocates the budget to PDOTs doing M&M





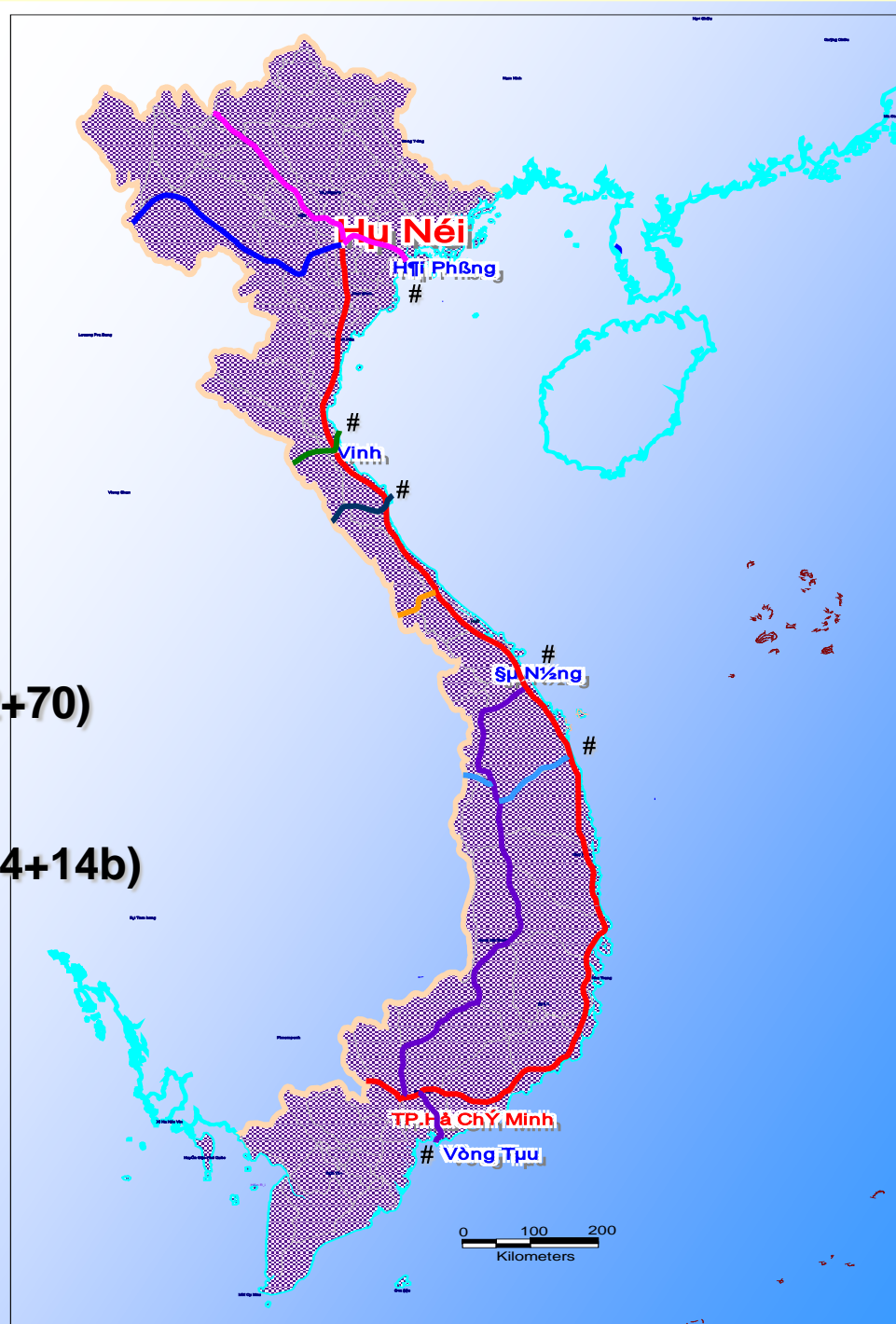

Total length: 4237 km

There are eight routes:

-  AH-13 : 504 km (QL:6+279)
-  AH-14 : 428 km (QL:5+1+3+2+70)
-  AH-15 : 82 km (QL:8)
-  AH-16 : 82 km (QL:9)
-  AH-17 : 1018 km (QL:51+13+14+14b)
-  AH-131 : 147 km (QL:12A)
-  AH-132 : 190 km (QL:24+40)








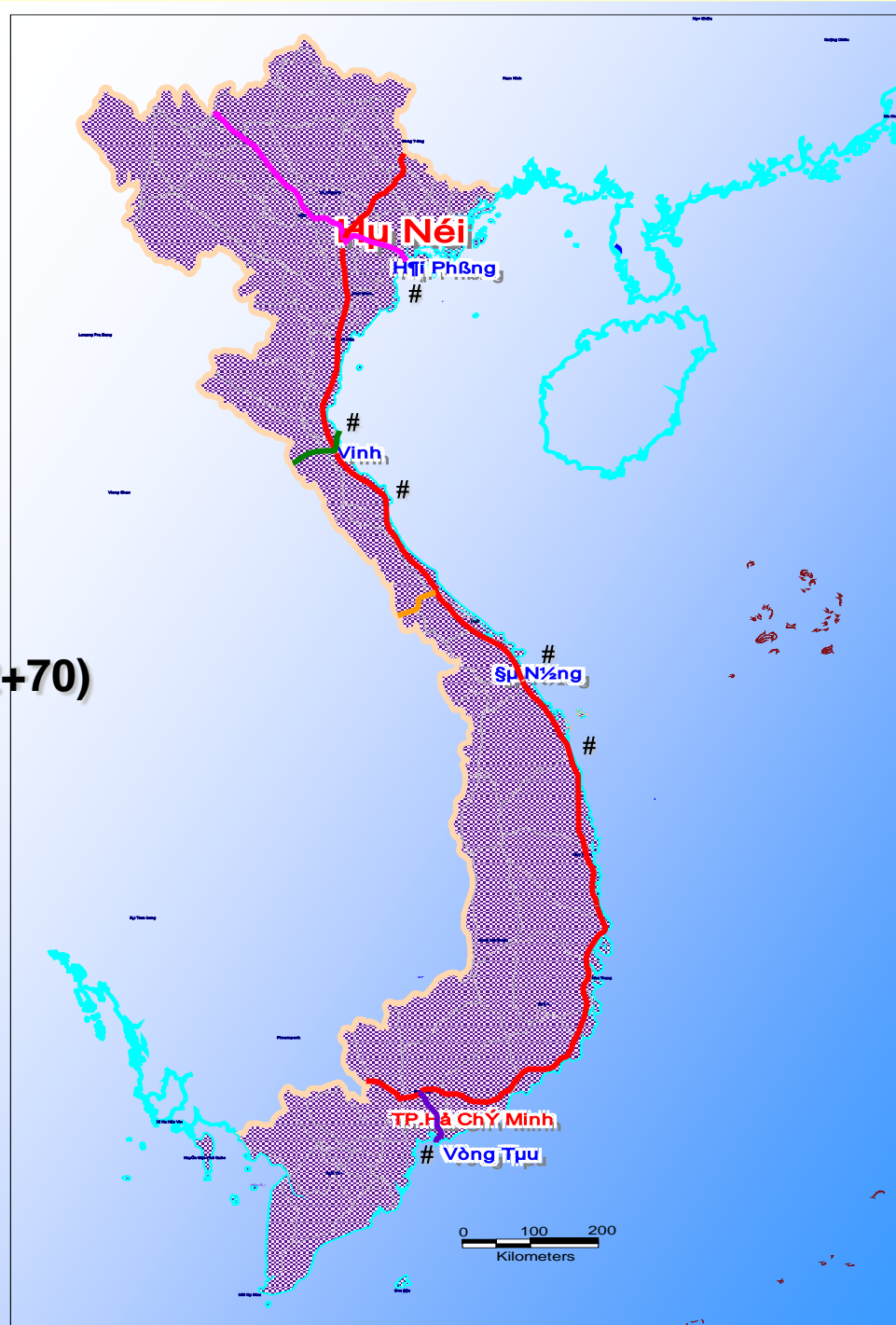
# International Roads in Vietnam

Total length: 2570 km
