MR in FA

- Three components of MR mechanism under FA Article 8
 - Mandatory MR
 - Criteria for MR developed through institutional arrangement
 - Substantially equivalent level of reliability
 - Operational arrangement
 - E.g. Member States bilateral or multilateral agreements

Development of MR Criteria

- Objective: agreement on MR criteria
 - A substantially equivalent level of reliability
- Methodology: taking into account of international legal instruments and standards
- By whom: Member States
- Where: PC and SC
- How: adopting protocols or other instruments
- On what: contents, scope of application, implementation

MR Criteria

- A substantially equivalent level of reliability
 - Principles
 - Functional equivalence non-discrimination, tech neutrality; interoperability; improving compliance; PPP and trust
 - International standards
 - WCO, UNCEFACT
 - Elements for consideration
 - Efficiency, certainty, fairness, costs, security and stability, right protection, representation and accountability
 - Periodical review and updates

MR Operation

- Operational issues
 - Cross-border communications of trade-related data and documents in electronic form
 - Technical settings and specifications
 - Operators
- Operational models
 - Centralized
 - Consensus-based, system, compliance and dispute resolution
 - Distributive model

Distributive Operation

- MSes operational arrangements
 - Options: bilateral or multilateral
- Institutional roles
 - Whether to have institutional review?
 - Substance
 - Not to intervene daily operation
 - Formality
 - How to keep operational consistency?
 - Principles
 - Criteria
 - Harmonization

Distributive Operation

- institutional roles
 - Capacity building,
 - Building enabling domestic environment,
 - Template for operational arrangements,
 - Sharing best-practice,
 - General policy recommendations
