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

  - Bilateral combined transport agreements




# 1) DIRECTIVE ON FREIGHT FORWARDERS





#### There are 1812 companies were certified as Freight Forwarder in Turkey





#### **DIRECTIVE ON FREIGHT FORWARDERS**

#### Main aim of the directive

- To secure the safety and security of goods from producer until the final customer.
- Professional competence for the freight forwarder companies.
- Sustain financial capable companies to be certified.


Only the certified companies can work as a freight forwarder in Turkey.





# **Combined Tranport Activity**

- Long-distance with train or maritime
- Max 100 km road transport from railway handling facility
- Max 150 km to port handling facility





#### Combined transport centres would be established and certified





# **Incentives for Combined Transport**


If more than **30%** of the total transpots annually is considered as combined transport than an incentive would be qualified.

a) Extention on certificates (20%-50%)
b) Discount on certificates (20%-50%)
c) Reimbursement from taxes (%2-%4)

#### Main Aim

To establish major logistical centres




## Logistical Centres;

- 1) Turkish Logisical Master Plan
- 2) Max 30 km railway or port connection
  3) Min 500.000 m<sup>2</sup> area,
- 4) Min **50 km** distance with other Logistical Centres
  - Environmental friendly and energy-efficient transport,
  - Infrastructure for sterilized transportation,
  - Enlargement due to Turkish Logistical Master Plan.

# CONCLUSION


#### NEED?

#### PROPOSAL FROM REPUBLIC OF TURKEY

An **Regional Convention/Treaty** on Multimodal Transport to be signed by the countries and reflected to the national legislations is needed.

- Applicable liability rules
- Uniformity in definations
- Covers wide geographical scope
- Contains technical guidelines on how to harmonise the national legislation with the regional legislation.
