Who is Responsible for What?

Institutional Arrangements

- Who provides approvals (inter-ministerial committee vs. cabinet)? When? Timeframe for approvals?
- Who's providing recommendations to the approval body?
- Which entity proposes to use PPP for infra projects?
- Who's deciding how much of the infra master plan will be done by public sector and which portion private sector?

Three-tier structure

Institutional Arrangements

PPP projects requires **specialized expertise** and clarity with regard to the **responsibilities** within the Government and the **decision making** process.

Typically three-tier structure:

- Inter-governmental committee (PPP Committee)
- Technical Unit (PPP Unit)
- Implementing agencies (Government Contracting Agencies)



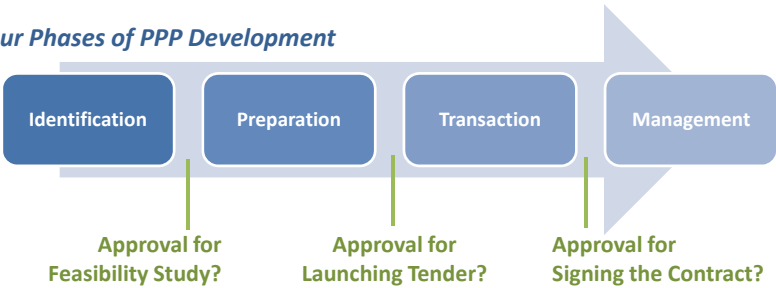
PPP Committee

Institutional Arrangements

Responsibilities:

- Adopting PPP regulations & standard documents to be used by GCA;
- Approving PPP projects at different stages:

Four Phases of PPP Development

PPP Unit

Responsibilities of the Unit

SUPERVISION

✓ Coordinating appraisal of PPP projects and providing recommendations to the PPP committee before approvals ;


✓ Monitoring progress on PPP projects implementation and reporting to the PPP committee (e.g. managing a PPP project database);

FACILITATION

✓ Administrating a Project Preparation Facility

✓ Providing technical support to GCAs throughout the preparation, tendering and contracting process of a PPP project ;

✓ Developing guiding materials for GCAs;



PPP Unit (continued)

Responsibilities of the Unit

PROMOTION


✓ Supporting capacity building activities for GCAs;


✓ Promoting the PPP programme (for example by helping GCAs to identify projects that could be implemented as PPPs);

▪ Where to locate this PPP Unit?

✓ Ministry National Planning and Economic Development?, Ministry of Finance? President’s Office?

▪ Funding the PPP Unit





Government Contracting Agencies

Institutional Arrangements

- GCAs, such as line ministries and sub-sovereign entities, should remain responsible for:
 - ✓ *Identifying,*
 - ✓ *Developing,*
 - ✓ *Preparing,*
 - ✓ *Tendering, and*
 - ✓ *Monitoring PPP projects within their areas of jurisdiction.*
- GCAs usually establish PPP teams/PPP Nodes in their respective agencies.
