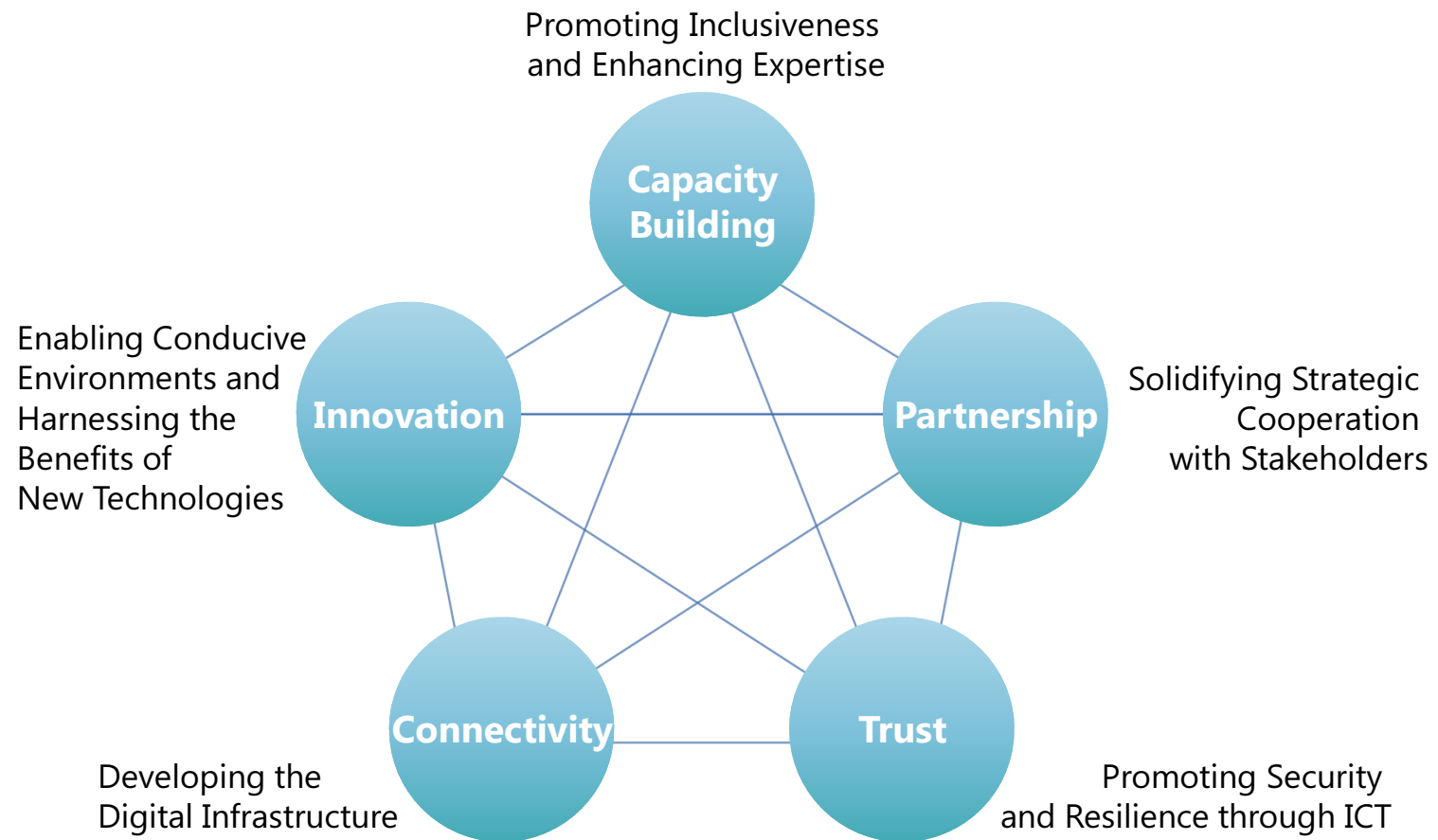
Asia-Pacific Telecommunity

- ✓ To foster the development of telecom. services and information infrastructure throughout the region.

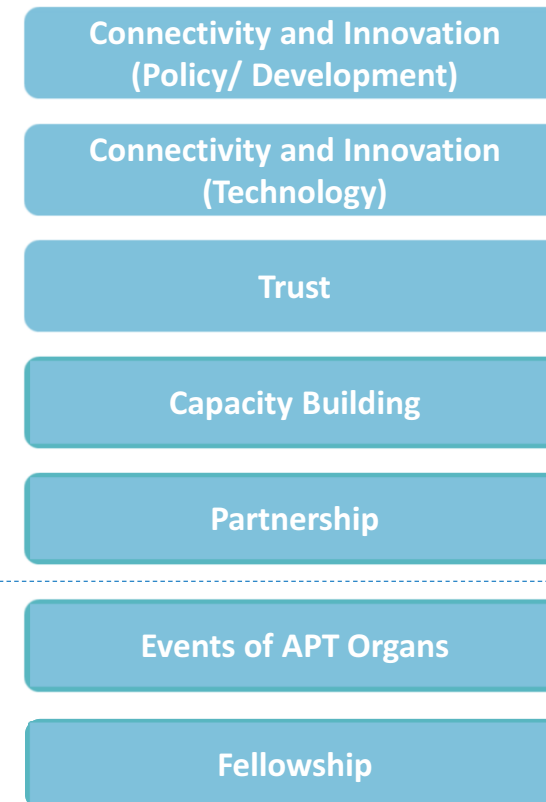
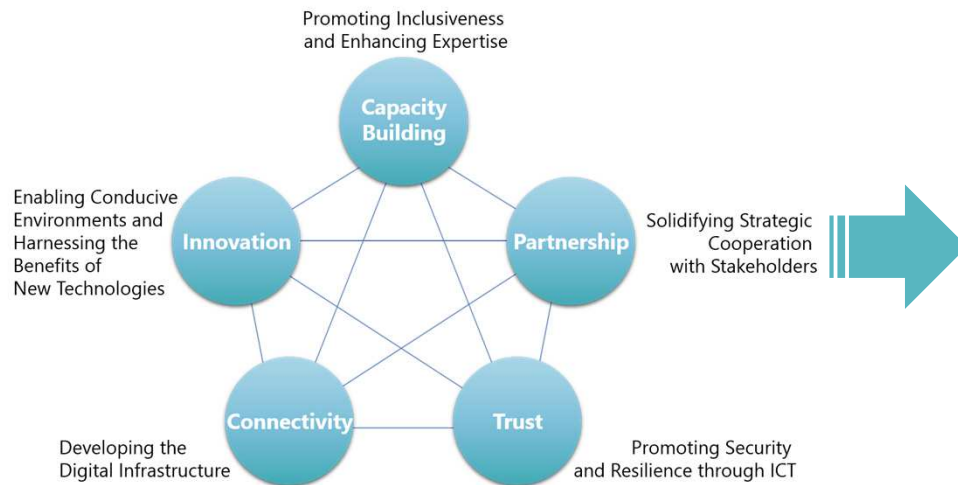
Objectives of APT

- ✔ Facilitate coordination within the region with regard to major issues pertaining to telecomm. services and information infra.

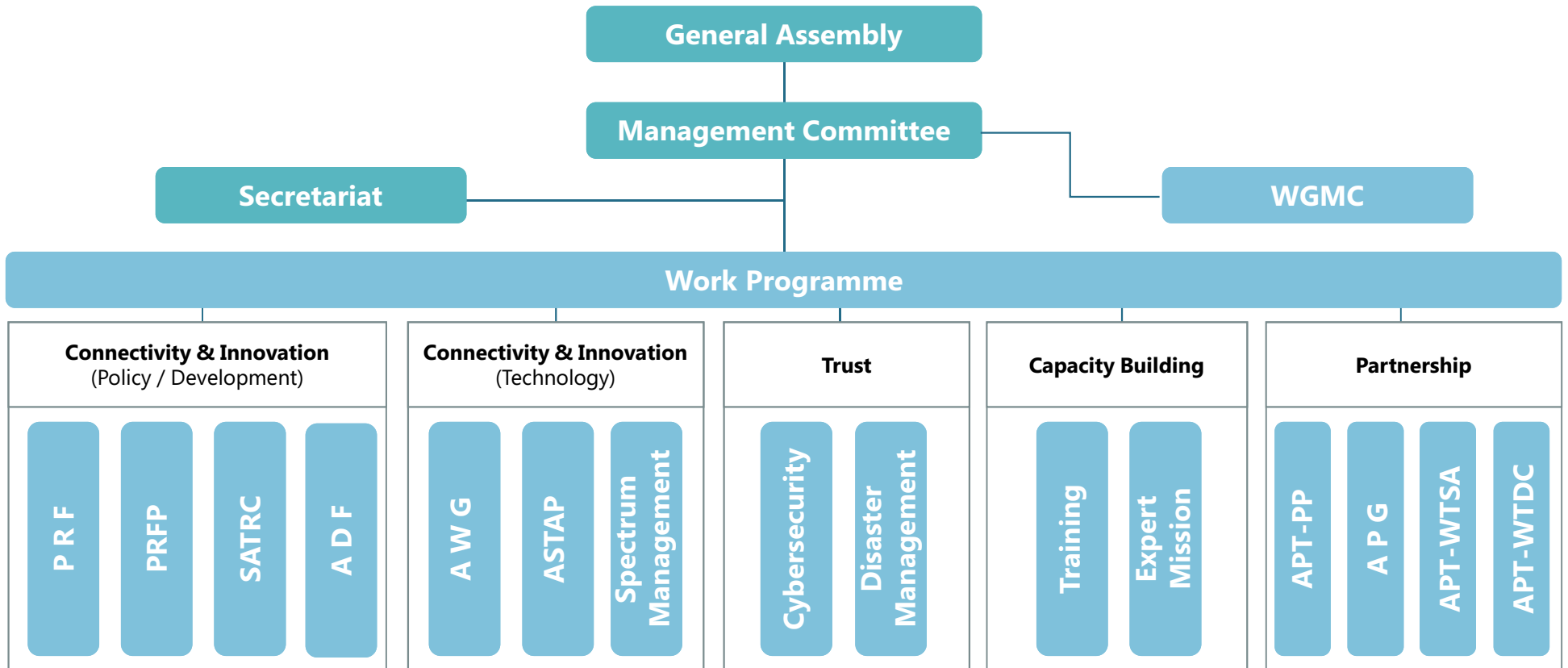
Strategic Plan for 2018-2020
