E-resilience for Pandemic Recovery:
Intercountry Consultations in Preparation for CICTSTI (webinar)

3 July 2020

WEBINAR EVALUATION

- Evaluation questionnaire is comprised of 9 questions with multiple choice answer options scoring ranging from 0 (minimum) to 5 (maximum). These questions are aimed to receive the feedback from participants on the clarity and applicability of webinar topics, the effectiveness of the webinar structure and the clarity of guidelines on KUDO platform usage, and on quality of the simultaneous interpretation.
- 11 evaluation responses were received anonymously out of invited total 41 participants (150 participants of RECI project network were invited) from the three target countries, attending the webinar in real-time. Subtotal of 26 participants were connected to the KUDO platform, including 9 speakers from three countries and the intergovernmental bodies. Subtotal of 15 participants from the network watched the webinar in YouTube real-time streaming. See the list of participants in the [Annex 1](#) of the webinar report.
- 80 percent of participants responded (rated 4 and higher) that activities delivered during the webinar were efficient and enhanced their knowledge and capacity and noted that time available for interventions during the e-meeting was adequate.
- More than 90 percent of respondents highly assessed the keynote session delivered by ESCAP consultant. The sessions on country perspectives and feedbacks, opening and closing session were also among highly assessed.
- Meanwhile, about 20 percent of the respondents noted that they (rated 3 and below) lack the good technical guide on usage of a KUDO platform and that they experienced problems in assessing and switching to the different channels of interpretation, which required the “reboot” of their computers and smartphones to get back into the meeting.
