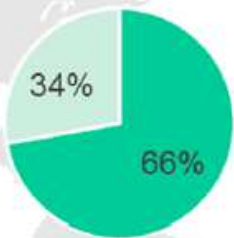

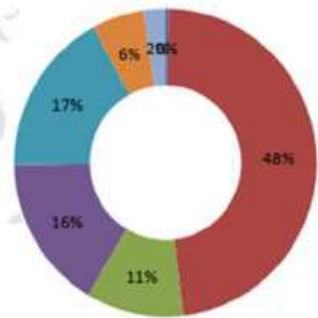
DPKO is UNV's largest client, with about 2,000 UNV assignments annually

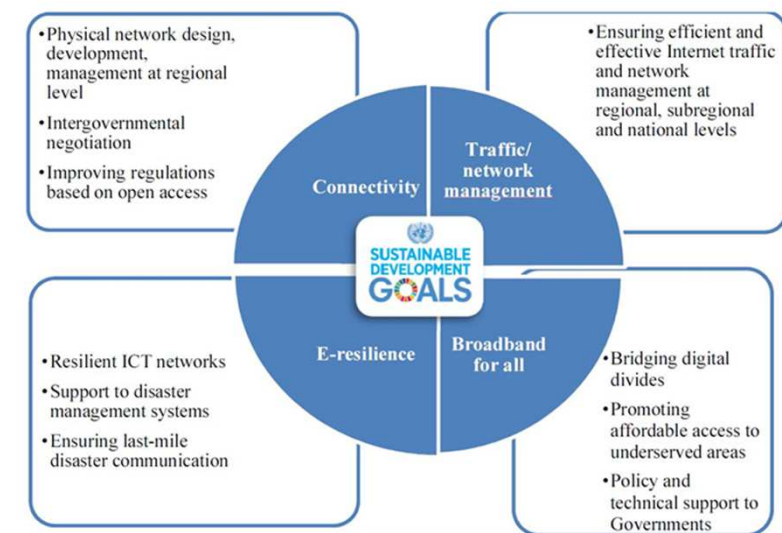

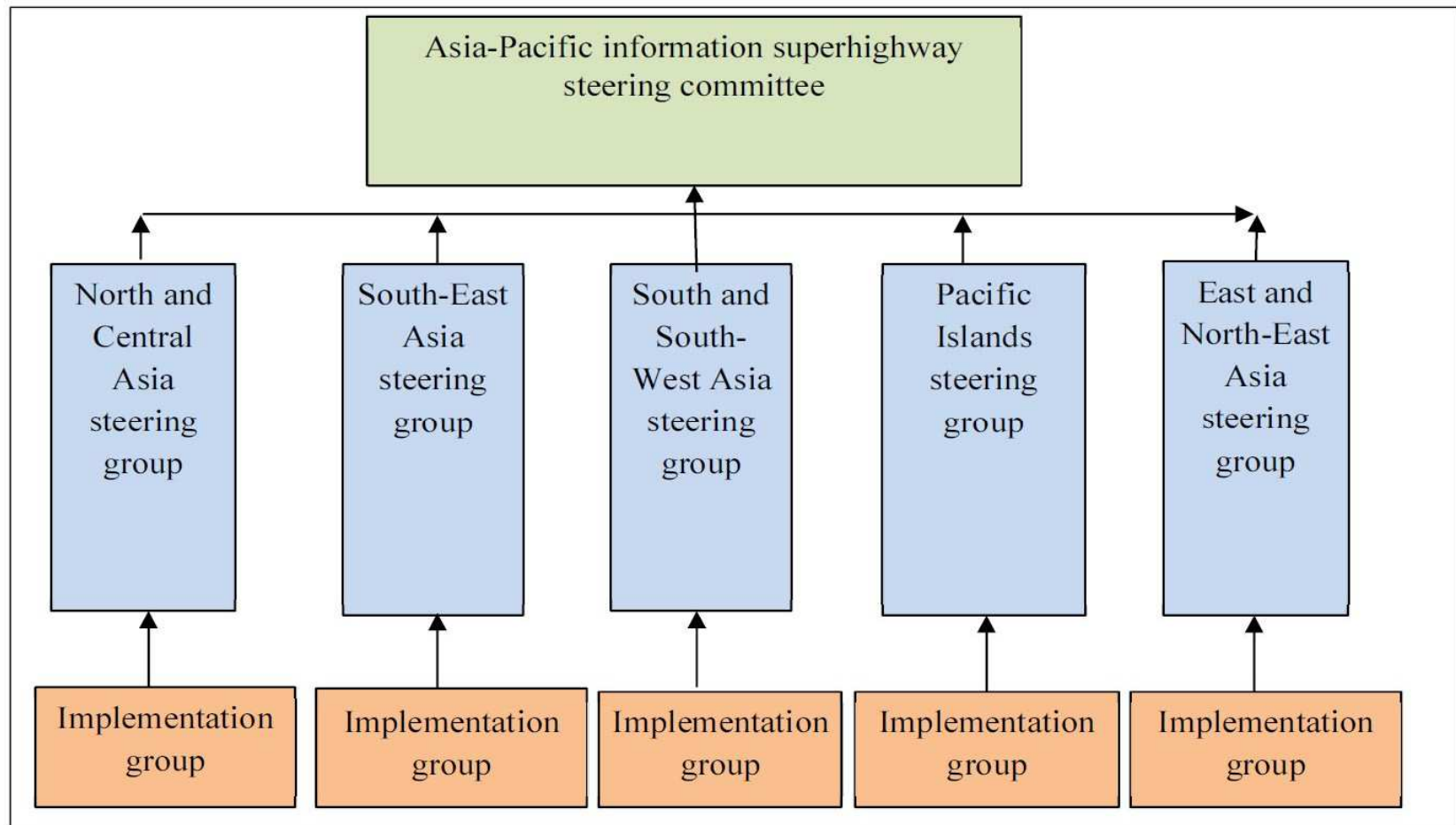


VOLUNTEER SOLUTIONS FOR THE AP-IS

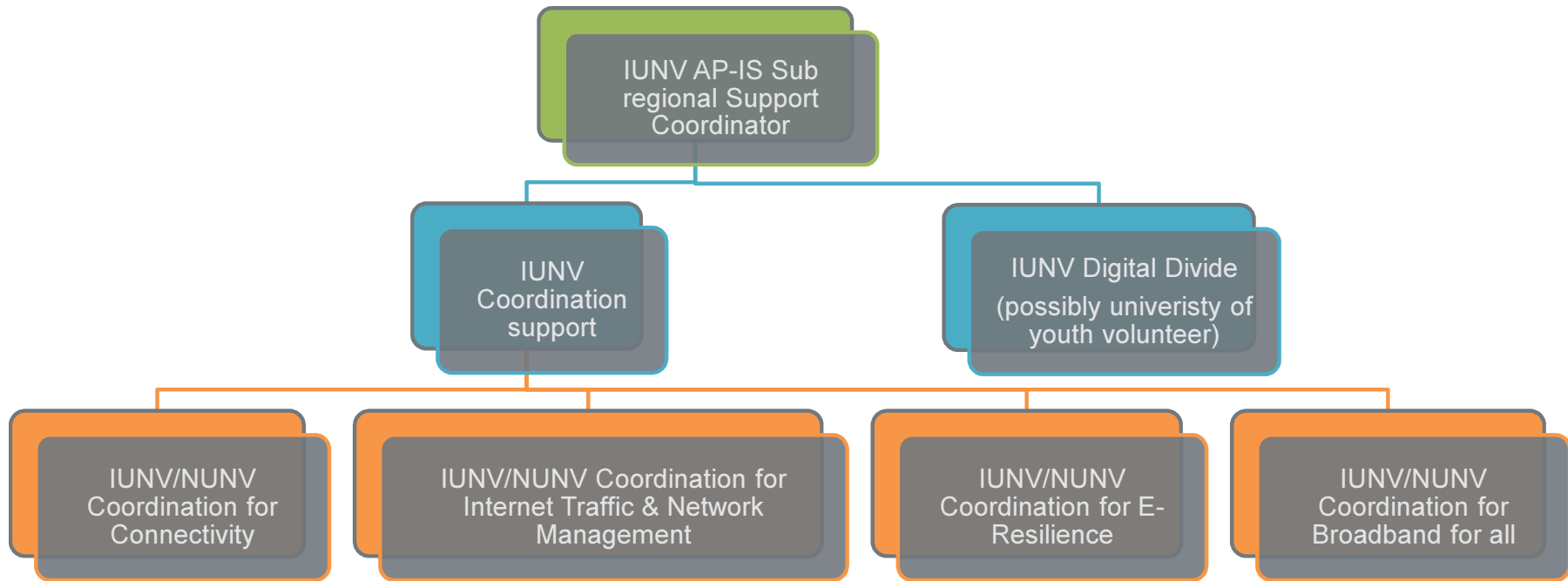
