About speaker



Nobu Yamashita holds the position of Senior Lecturer in Economics at RMIT (Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology) University in Australia. He also has the visiting position at Keio University in Tokyo, Japan. His main policy-oriented research covers the broad topic of international economics including globalisation of production and multinational firms, the impact of globalisation on the labour market and innovation in Japan, China, India and ASEAN countries. His outreach research activities include research consulting for the ESCAP in Bangkok, the Asian Development Bank in Manila, ADB Institute in Tokyo, and the Economics Research Institute for ASEAN and East Asian countries in Jakarta.

Nobu has obtained several research awards, including the J.G. Crawford Award, ANU in 2008, the Dean's Research Award at La Trobe University in 2012, and the Japan Foundation Fellowship in 2014 for the work "Cases on the Japanese Automotive and Electronics Industries."
