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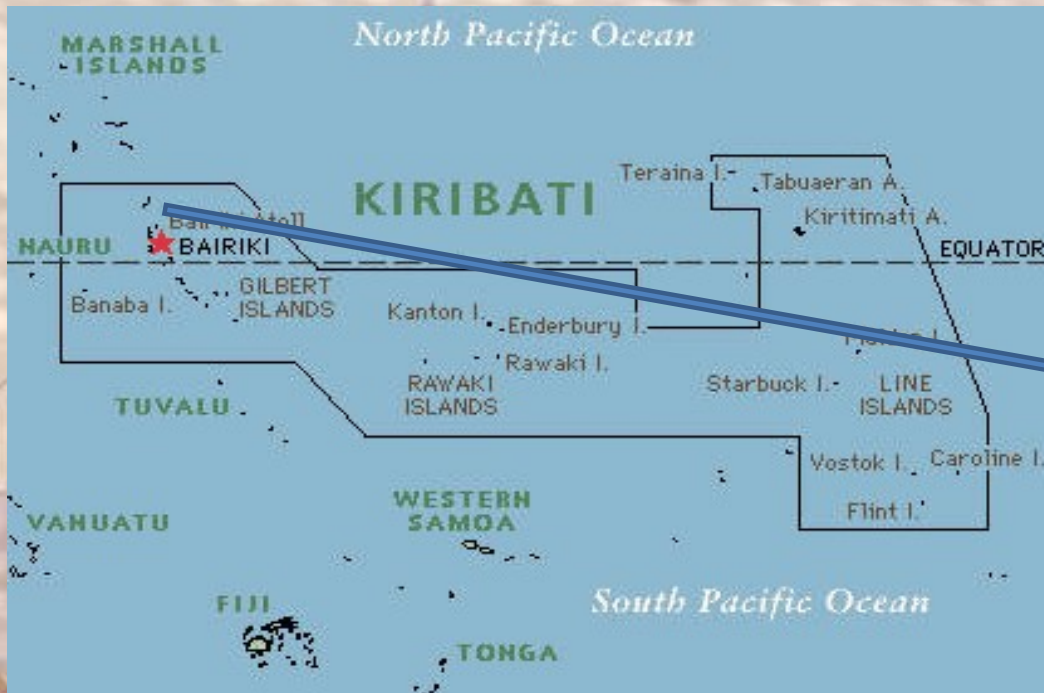

KIR Population: 110,136 (2015 census report)



Tarawa population: 56,388



# Kiribati 20-Year Vision - National ICT indicators

Outcome 8		Improved Connectivity and Accessibility for economic infrastructure

To develop and improve ICT infrastructure	% of mobile subscribers	49%	60%	70%	80%

# Data Collection & Practices

- National Statistics Office
  - Census report every five years
- Communication Commission of Kiribati
  - Bi-annual report
- Ministry of Information, Communication, Transport and Tourism Development
  - Focal point of contact for ICT Statistics
  - Government ICT stock take statistics



# Methods of Data Collection

- Paper-based questionnaire
- Email correspondence
- Online questionnaire



# Challenges:

- Current National Census model questions do not specifically include ICT indicators
- Numerators have different understanding on ICT questions
- Data not available on a timely basis
- Lack of consultation with key stakeholders
- IDI Indicator's questionnaire provided by ITU – lengthy and technical lead to incomplete entry to ITU Database.



## Challenge example:

Table 6: Proportion of households with access to mass media (radio and/or Internet) by sex of household head, Census 2015

Access to mass media	Male	Female	Total
Has internet connection	836	417	1,253
Has radio	6,192	1,847	8,039
Total with radio and/or internet	6,464	1,977	8,441
Total households	13,669	4,103	17,772



**48%**

of households headed by a woman have access to mass media (1,977 households have radio and/or Internet)

# Way Forward

- Strong coordination between key-stakeholders
- To have a separate ICT statistics survey
- Proper training for enumerators
- ITU to provide a more simpler model questionnaire
