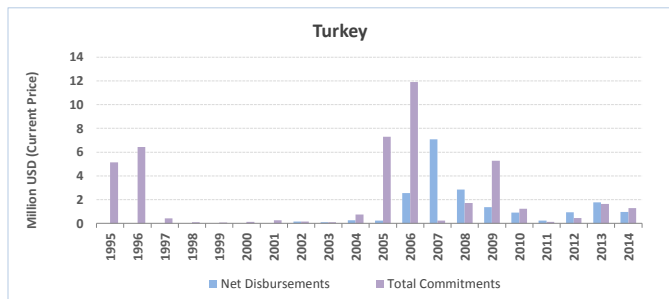
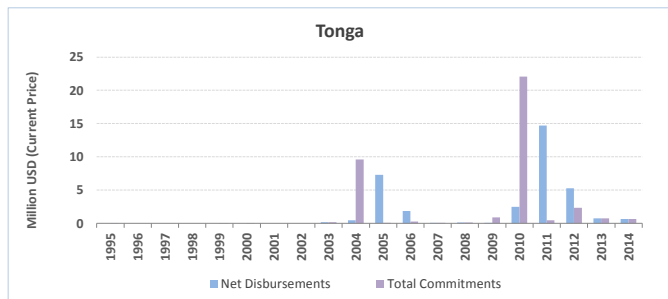
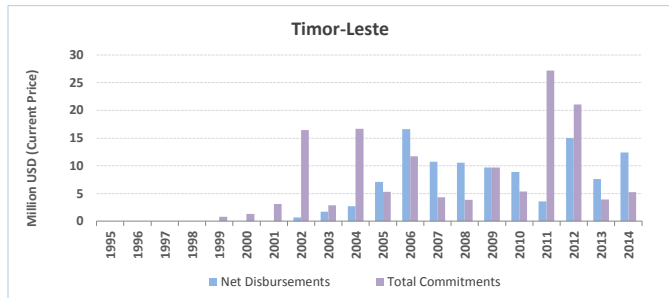
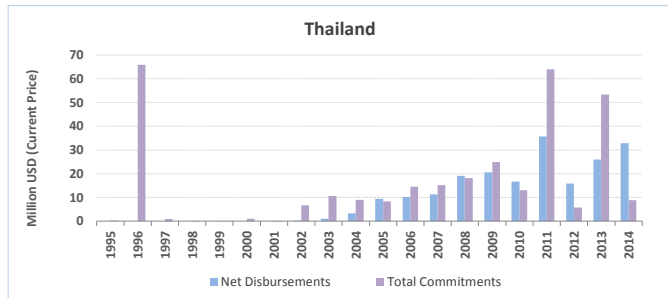
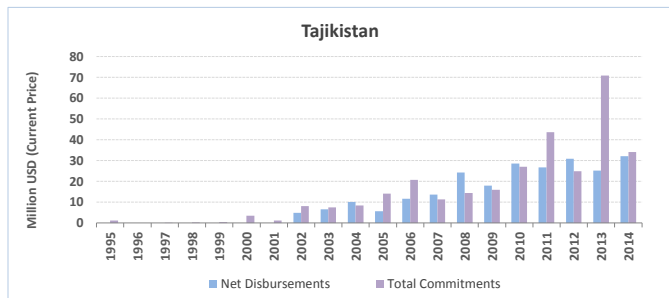
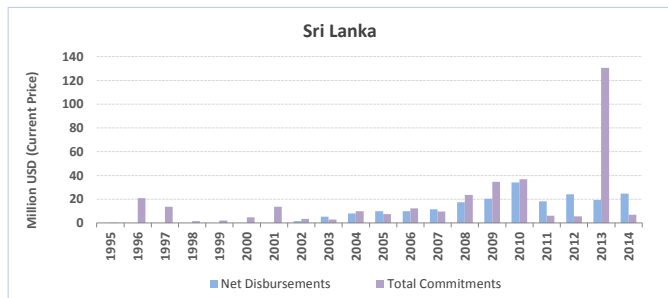
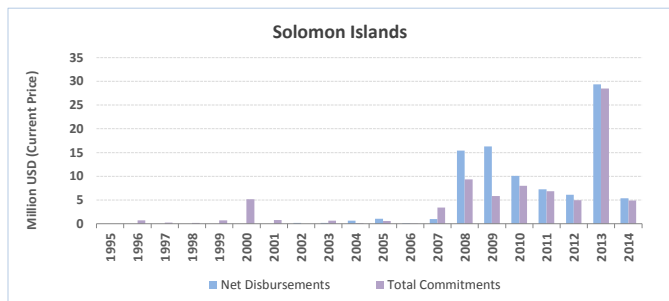
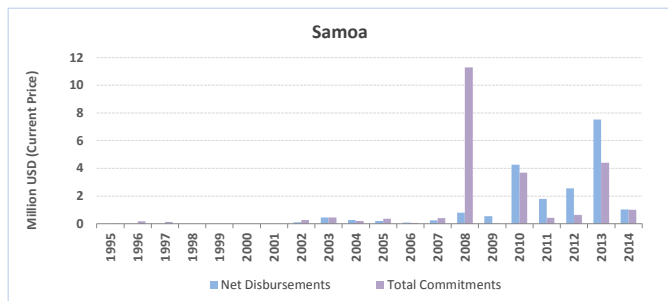
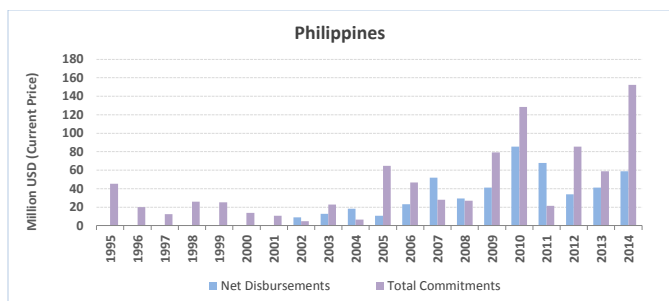
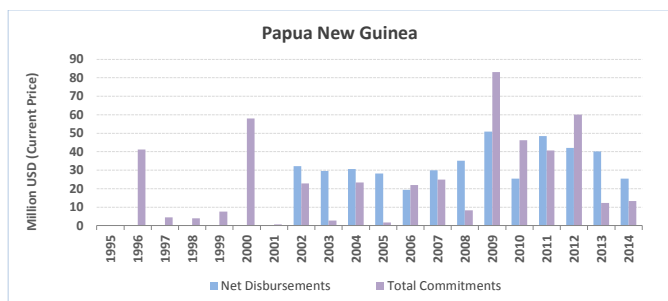
Indicator 3.b.2 Total net official development assistance to the (i) medical research and (ii) basic health sectors

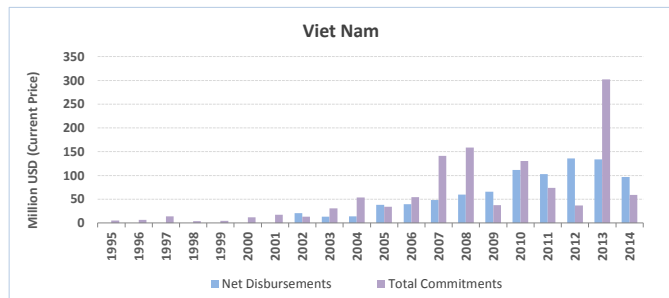
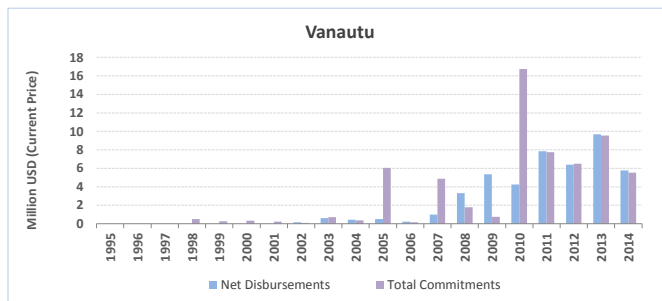
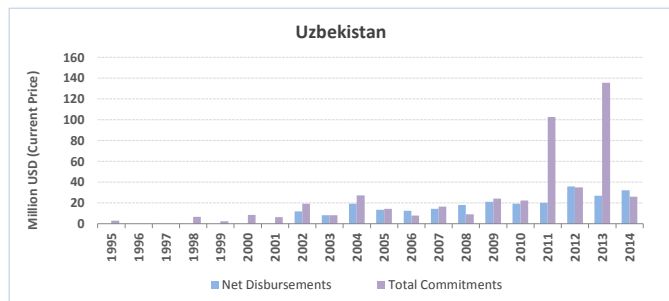
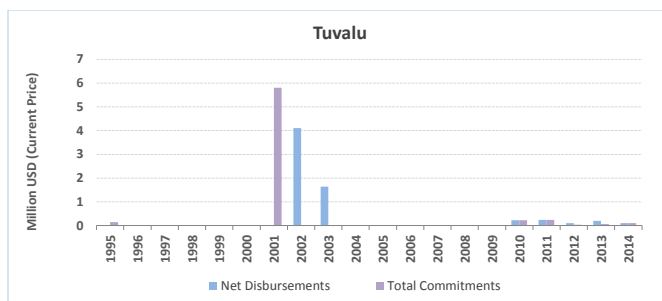
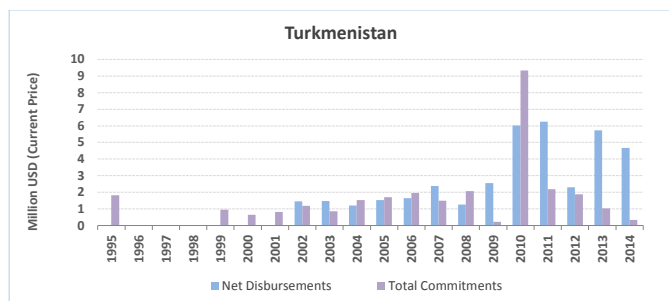
