Why integrating gender into disaster statistics? To design comprehensive responses

Deaths, illness & health services

- Gender differentials based on locations, jobs, different access to healthcare, types of care available, hh composition (inheritance rights)

Displacement

- Refugees/IDPs, dependents/family reunification, access to essential services in camps, incl. rep. health & hygiene, safety

Assets/Capacity to cope

- Ownership of land & livestock, access to financing, type of employment (formal/informal), sector of employment (climate sensitive)

Time use

- Unpaid childcare, adult care, care for the sick, unpaid domestic (cleaning, cooking), water collection, firewood collection, animal feeding

Resilience

- Sustainable livelihoods, production/consumption, decision-making over natural resources, sources of income, health insurance, social protection, location (child marriage)
