Sustainable Food Systems and Nutrition: Making agriculture and food systems nutrition-sensitive

BACKGROUND

This is the first of a series of free and open technical webinars that are organized by UN-ESCAP (United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific), Agreenium (l'Institut agronomique, vétérinaire et forestier de France) and FAO (Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations), in 2019.

These technical webinars are focused on a number of thematic areas related to the global challenges humanity is facing and are an opportunity for all of us to share experiences and lessons learned, discuss challenges and propose innovative solutions and models. The idea, for each thematic area, is to bring together the “development” perspective from one side and the latest findings in “innovation and research” on the other, in order to give participants a holistic and comprehensive view on the global trends and challenges.

Kathryn Ogden is committed to understanding what drives hunger, food insecurity and malnutrition in the world. She works in the Nutrition Division of the World Food Programme (WFP) supporting the organizational strategy to make good nutrition an important outcome across the WFP portfolio. She provides expert advice on how diets can be improved in sectors complementary to nutrition, such as agriculture and education and how this nutrition-sensitive approach is



Sylvie Avallone is professor in Montpellier Sup Agro (National Institute of Further Education in Agricultural Science) and researcher of the Joint Unit Research “QualiSud”. She is the head deputy of the Institute for Higher Education in Tropical Agri-Food Sciences and member of the executive committee of the UNESCO Chair “World Food Systems”. She holds a PhD in Food Sciences and has published 30 papers in peer reviewed journals on micronutrient deficiencies and the nutritional



Domitille Kauffmann worked as a Nutrition, Food Systems and Resilience Adviser in FAO for six years. She supported efforts in mainstreaming nutrition in food and agriculture policies and programmes – within FAO and with governments. She coordinated several capacity development initiatives including the production of guidelines and eLearning modules on Nutrition and Food Systems. Domitille is the co-author of several technical guidance notes on nutrition-
