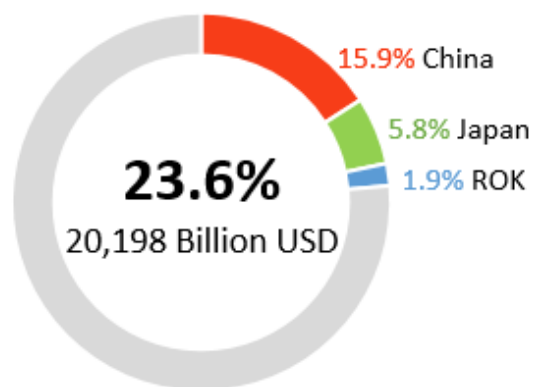

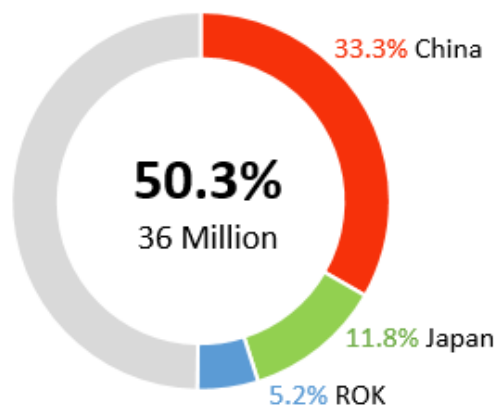

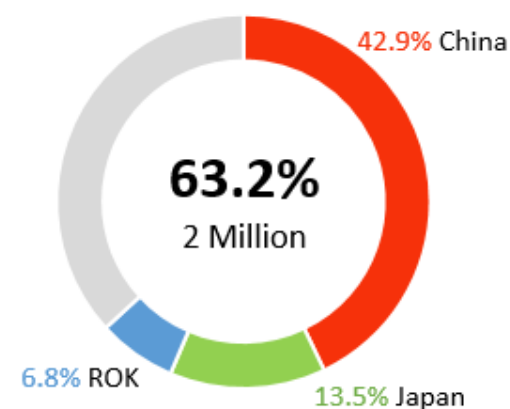
GDP

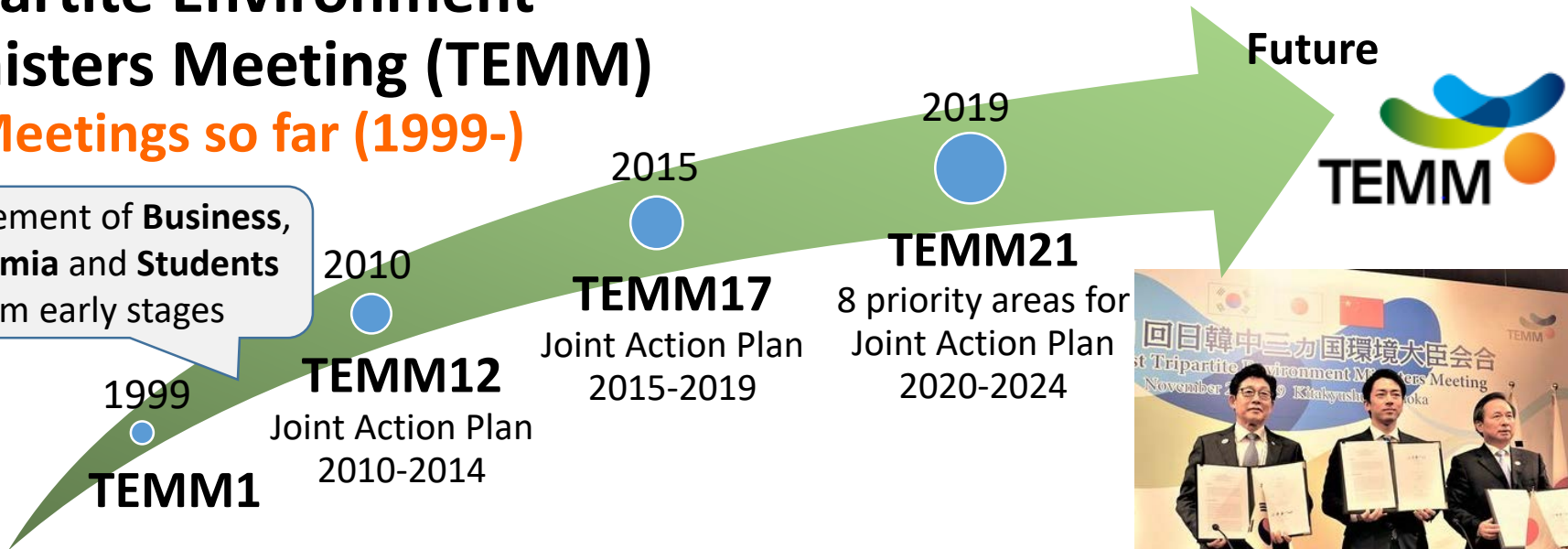
