- Preparing standardization draft

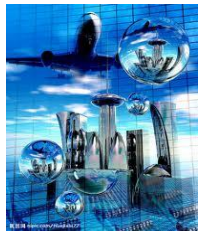
Step #2: Discussions and meetings

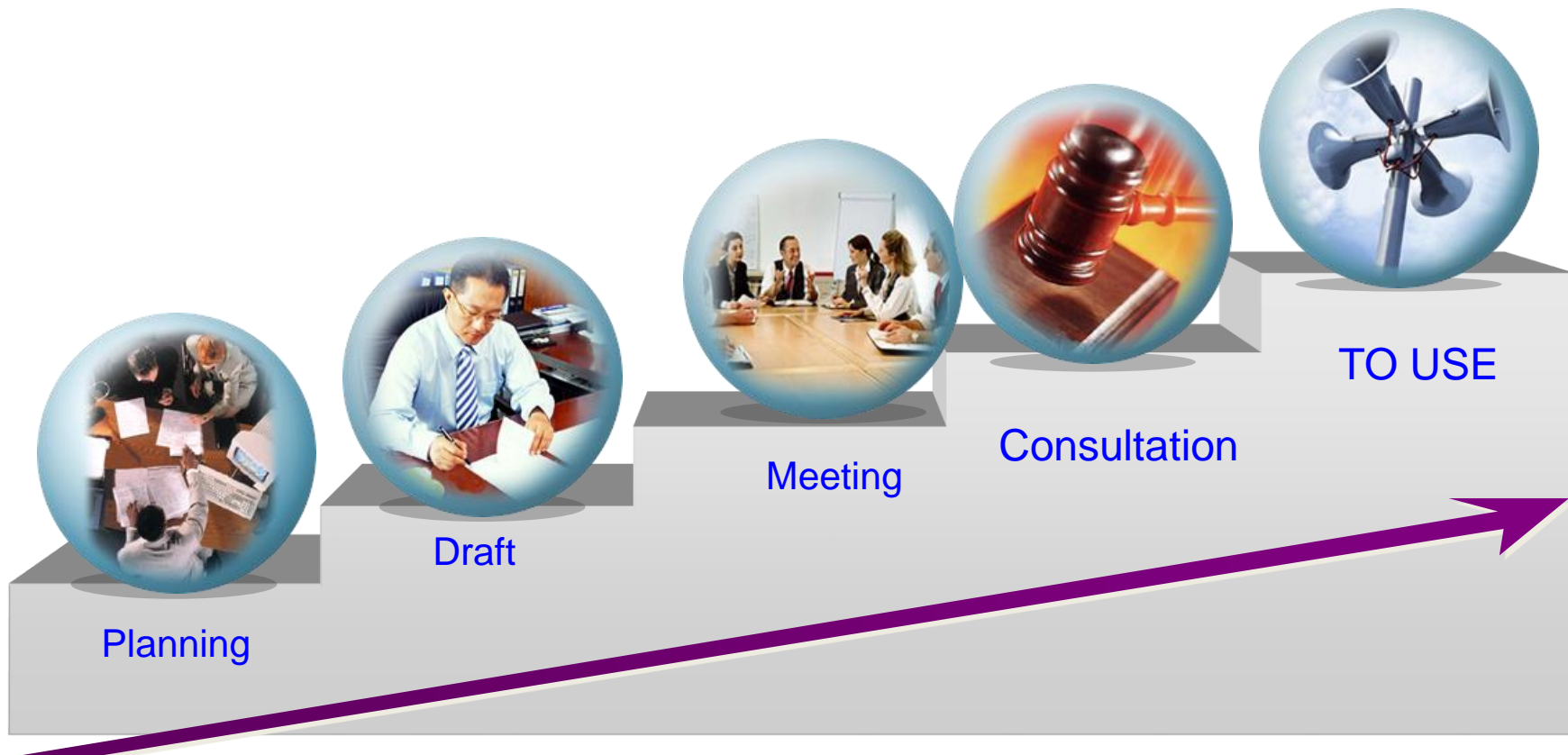

Mongolia's legal environment on road and transportation sector

Mongolia's latest standard environment of road and transportation sector shown as below:

- General requirement for technical condition of road vehicles MNS 4598 : 2011;**
- Petrol engine vehicle – maximum acceptable level and measuring method of exhaust emission MNS 5013-2009;**
- Diesel engine vehicles – Maximum acceptable level and measuring methods of opacity 5014-2009;**

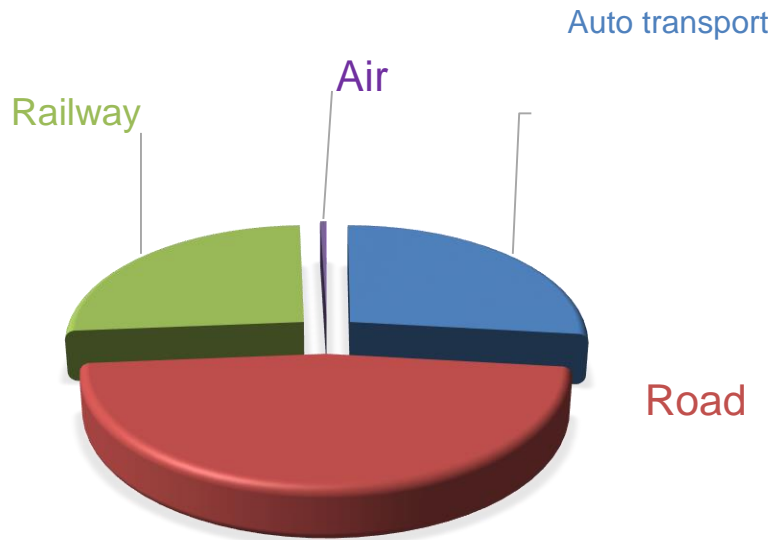
Mongolia's legal environment on road and transportation sector

Technical support required for improvement of legal aspects for Mongolian transportation sector

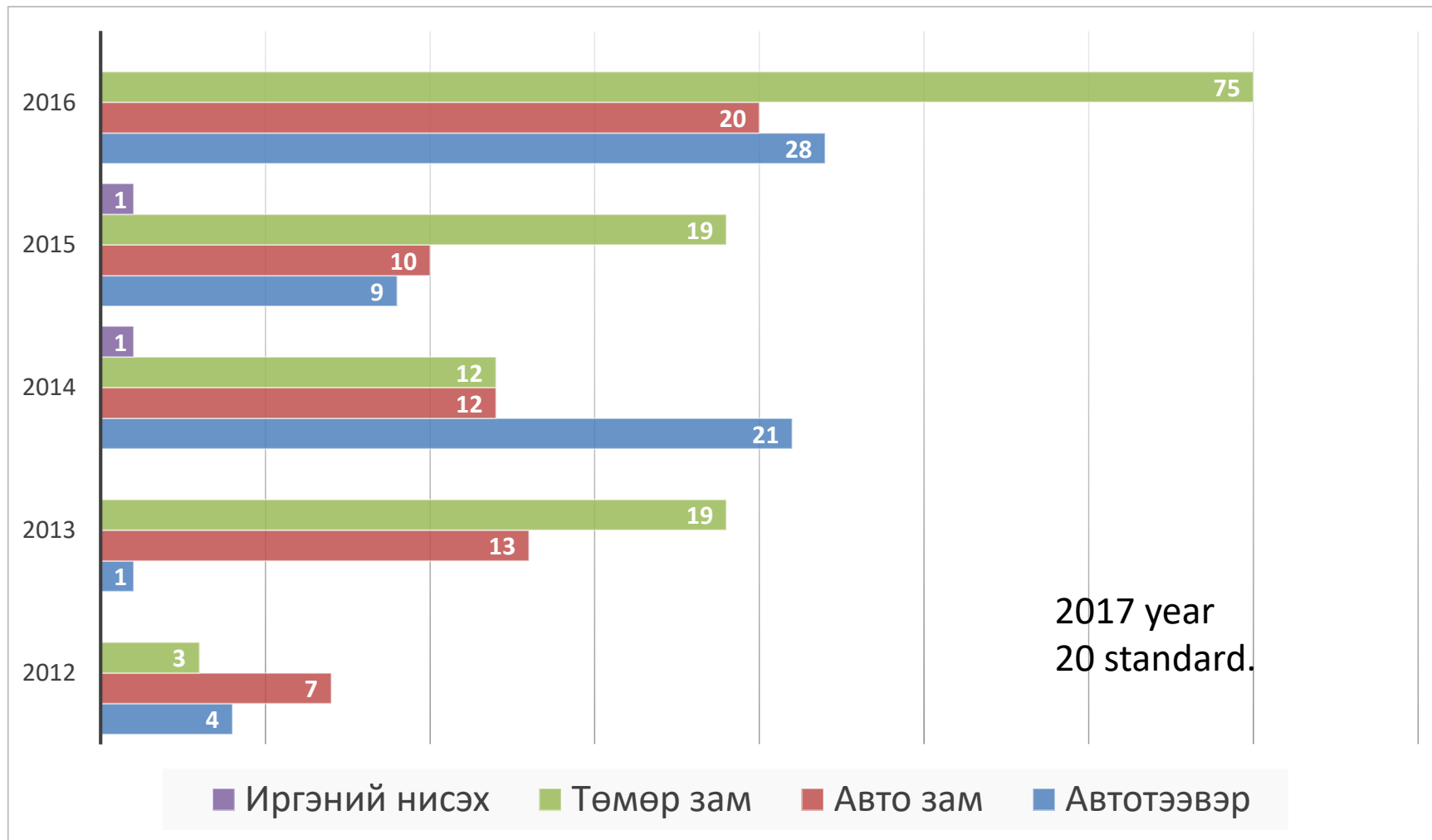

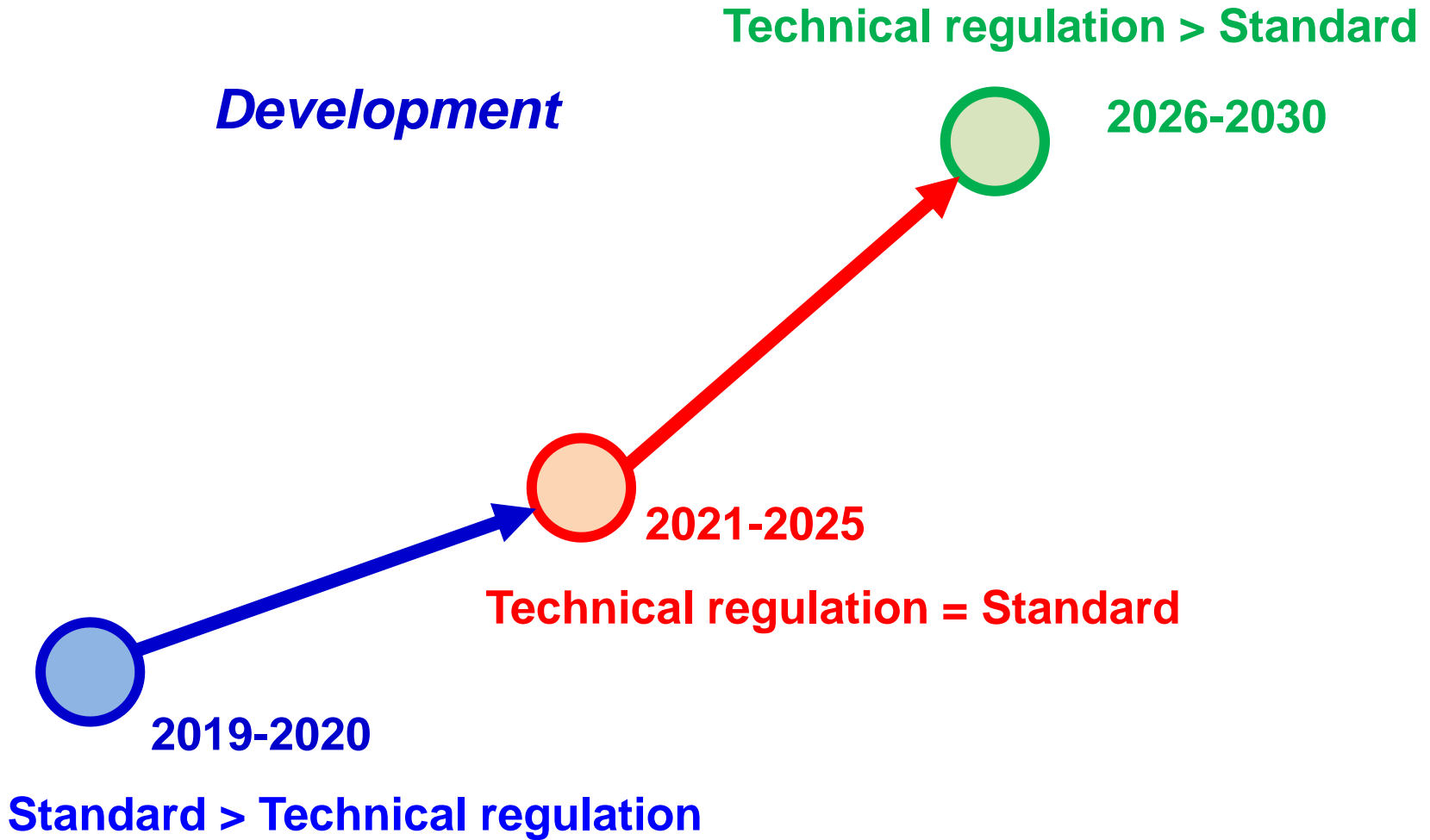
509 standards are valid in transportation sector
