The Philippines through the leadership of the Philippine Statistics Authority would like to share that we already have a Data Roadmap for Data Revolution that shall guide us in addressing the data challenge of emerging concerns in the Philippines including the SDGs. This data roadmap is a result of various mapping exercises and workshops we did to determine data availability for monitoring SDGs implementation and CRVS decade. I highlight four important work under this roadmap.

First is the development of national and international data ecosystems composed of data from censuses, surveys, administrative data, registers, big data including private sector data and citizen-generated data.
