FOREIGN TRADE STATISTICS FOR THE FIRST 7 MONTHS OF 2015

Total turnover of foreign trade : **5021.7 mln.USD,**

Export exceeded import in **604.0 mln.USD,**

Foreign trade balance became positive.

FOREIGN TRADE STATISTICS FOR THE FIRST 7 MONTHS OF 2015

Mongolia has exported goods to **55** foreign countries:

- ✓ **China (86.1%),**
- ✓ **United Kingdom (5.1%),**
- ✓ **The Republic of Korea (1.8%),**
- ✓ **The Russian Federation (1.8%)**

FOREIGN TRADE STATISTICS FOR THE FIRST 7 MONTHS OF 2015

Mongolia has imported goods originating from
135 different countries:

- ✓ The **Russian Federation** (26.7%),
- ✓ **China** (35.5%),
- ✓ The USA (3.2%), **Japan** (8.0%),
- ✓ **Republic of Korea** (7.5%)
- ✓ Federal Republic of Germany (3.3%)

1. Paperless clearance

- ✓ Launched in 2014
- ✓ Focused on export of the mining products
- ✓ Land transport-85%, of this export of coal in Shiveekhuren-100%
- ✓ Railway transport-30%



Developing CAIS and connecting it to other organization's system



2. Increased the possibility to declare through the internet for the foreign trader by them selves.

- ✓ 53 foreign trader
- ✓ 30.65% of the whole customs clearance

3. Connection CAIS to other related organizations

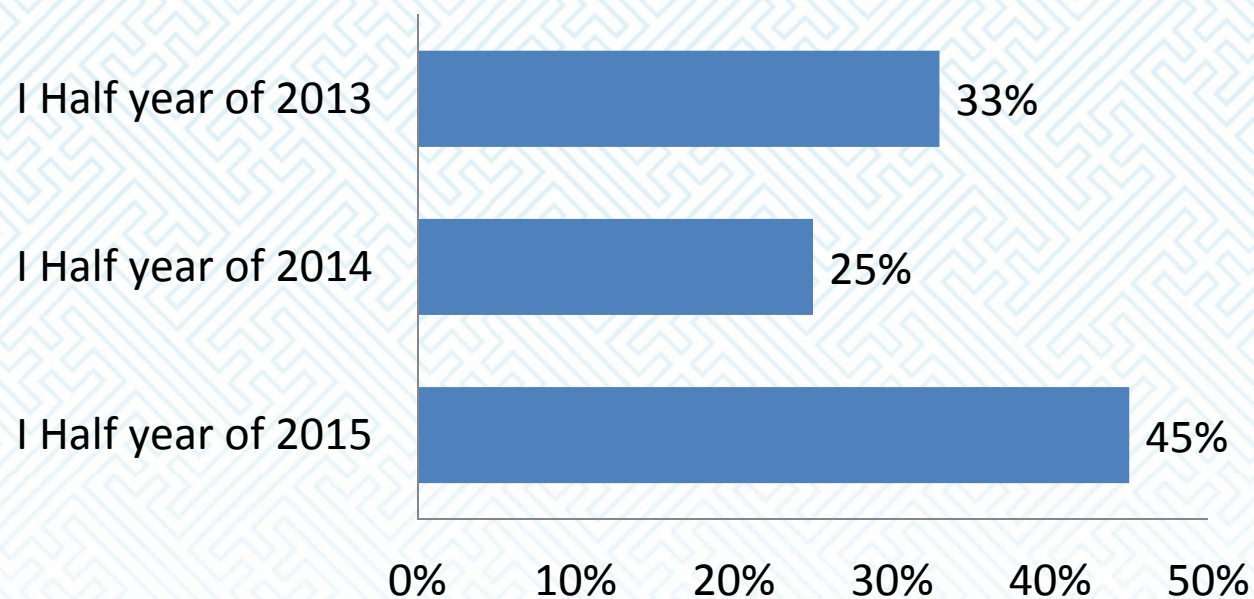
- ✓ Embedding e-payment
