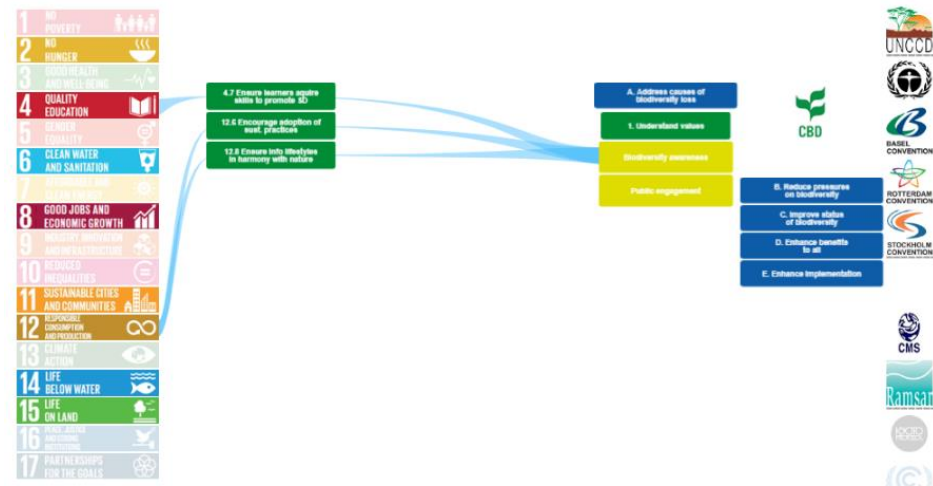
Environment Live

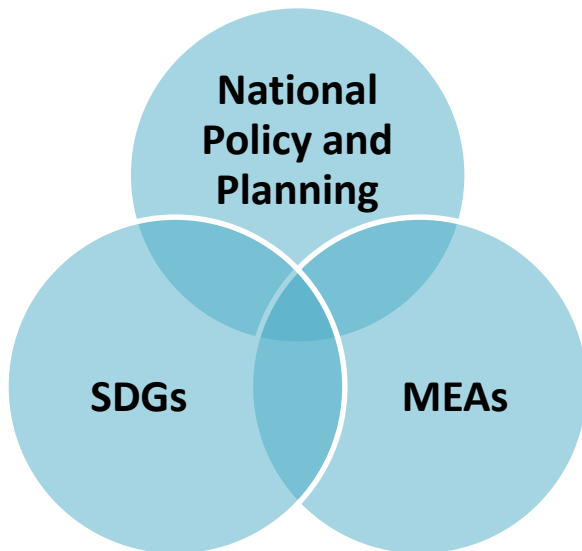
Indicator Reporting Information System (IRIS)
