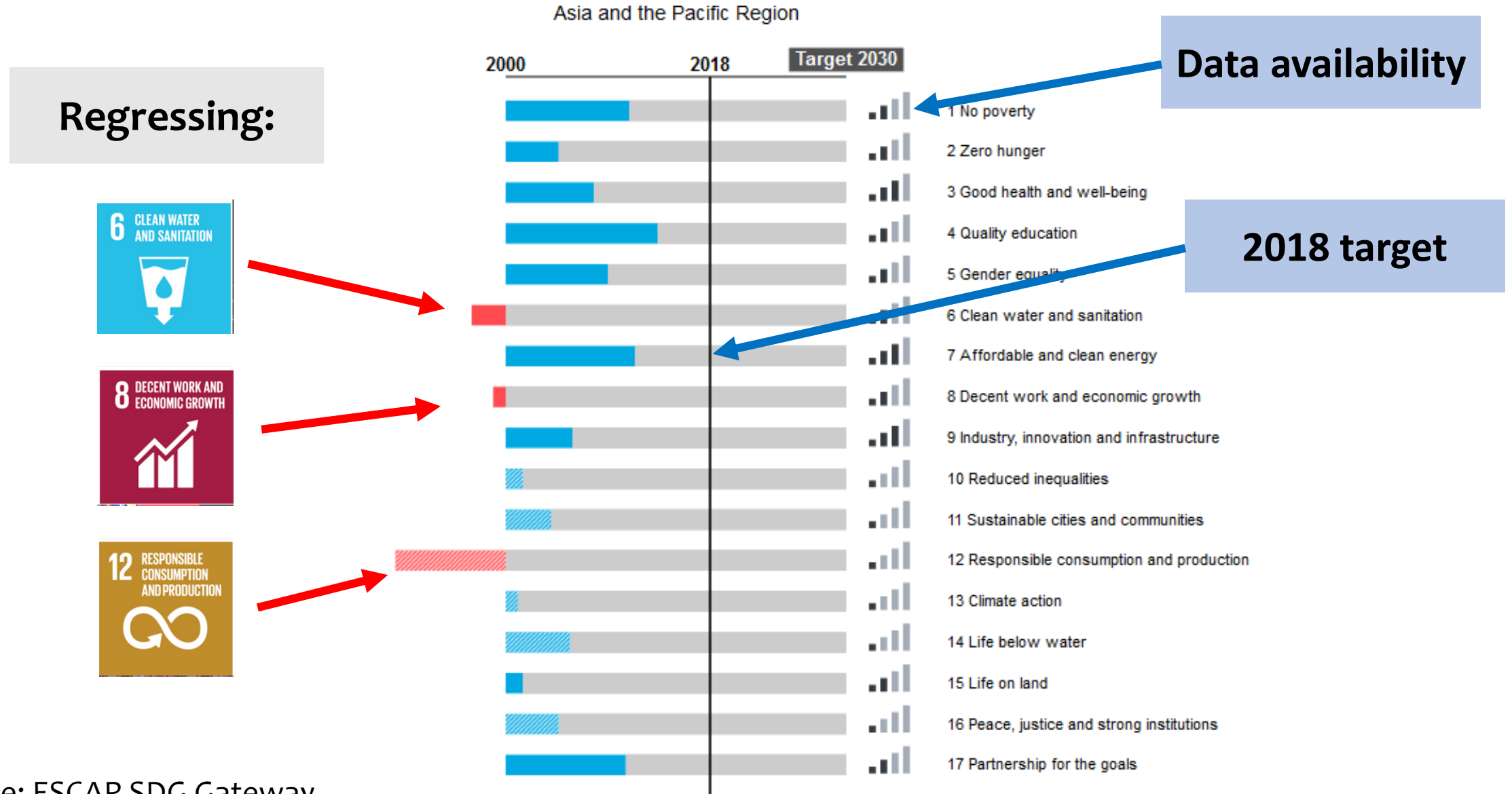

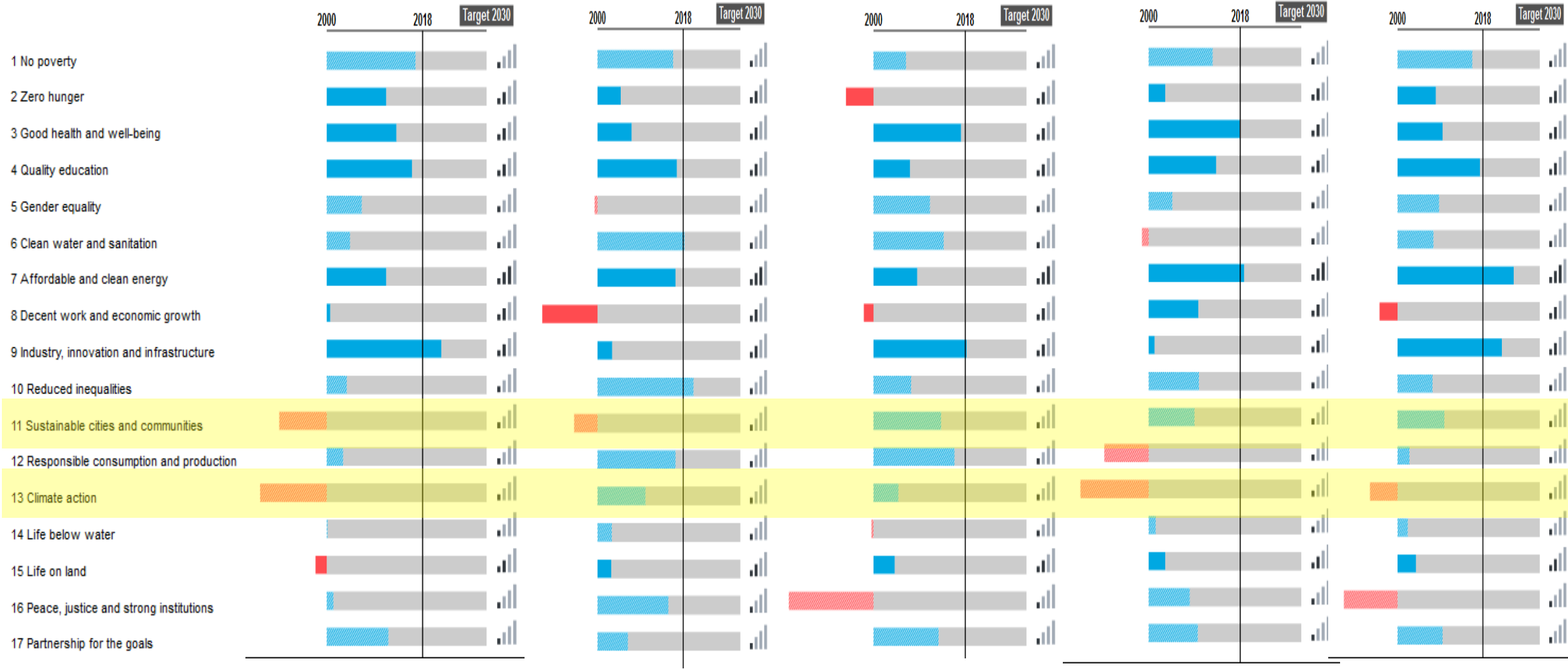

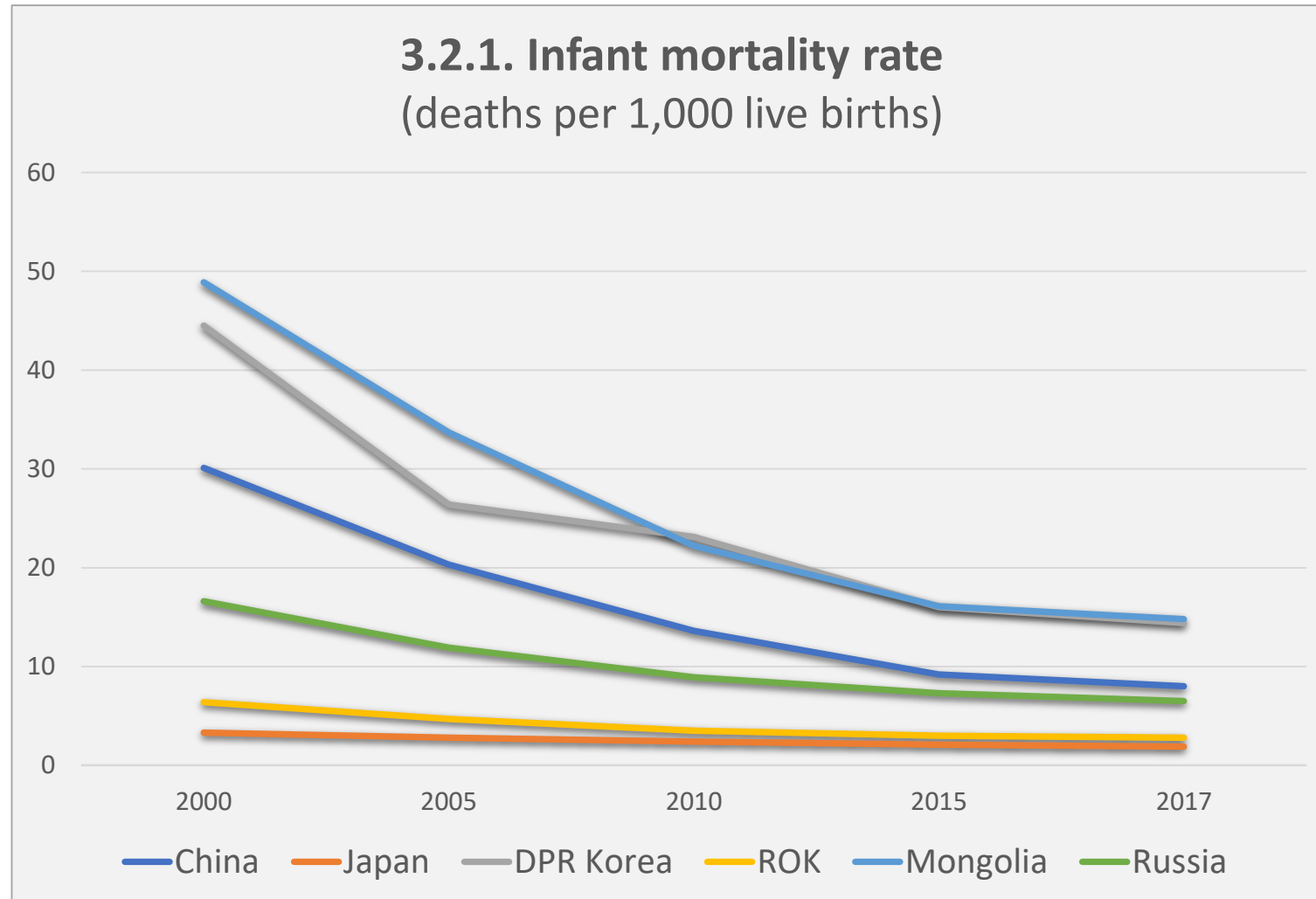

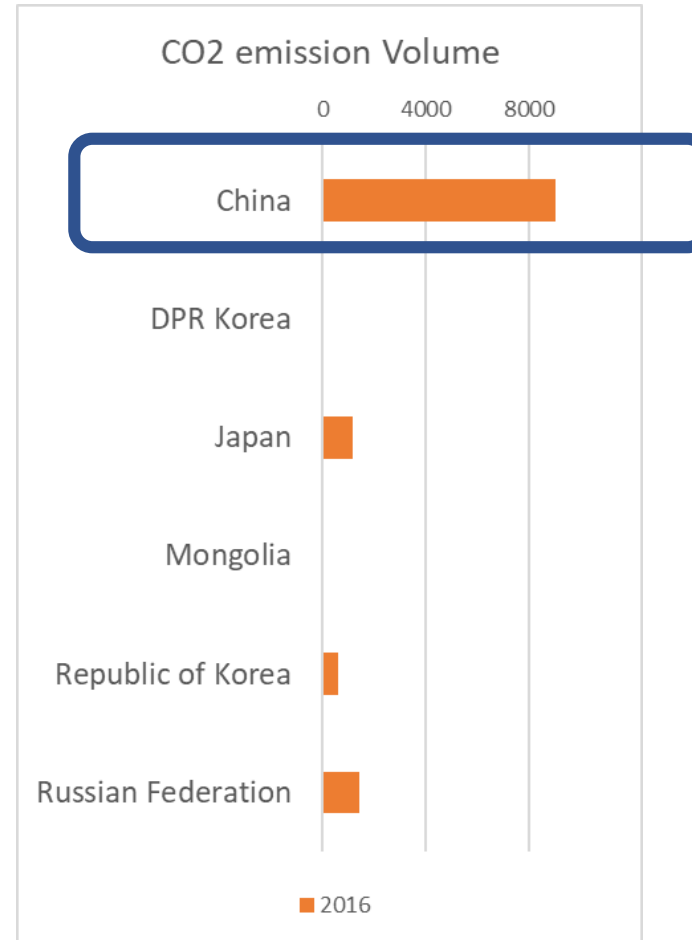
Access to clean energy – gaps among countries



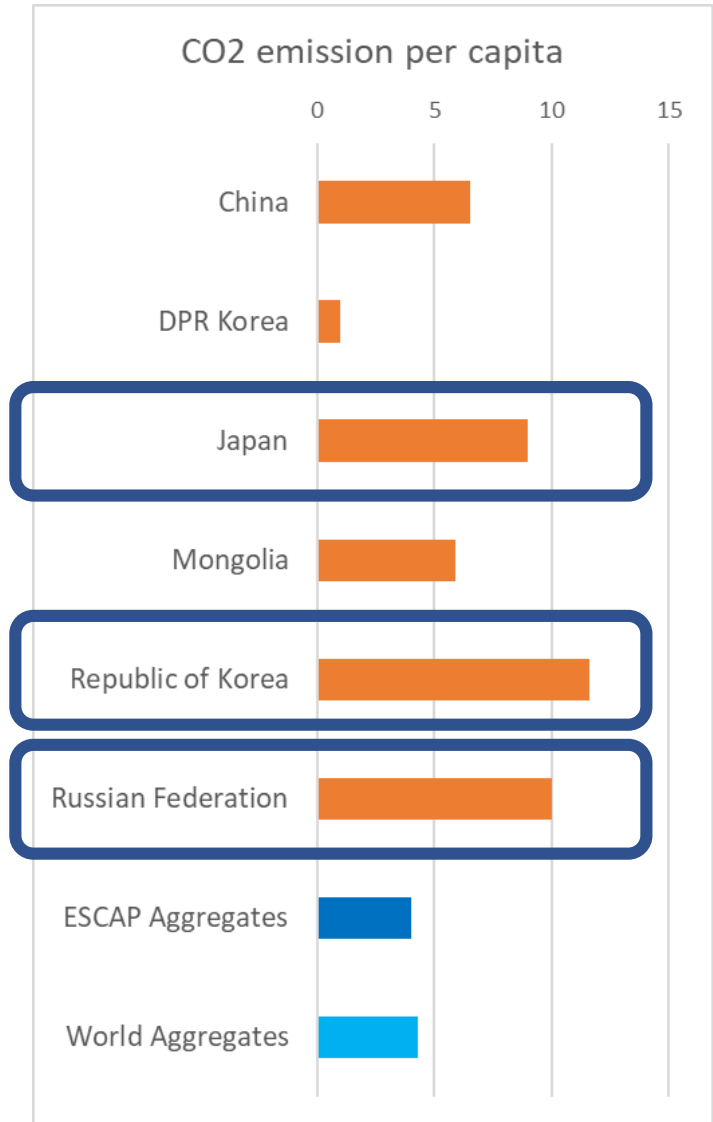
High CO₂ emission

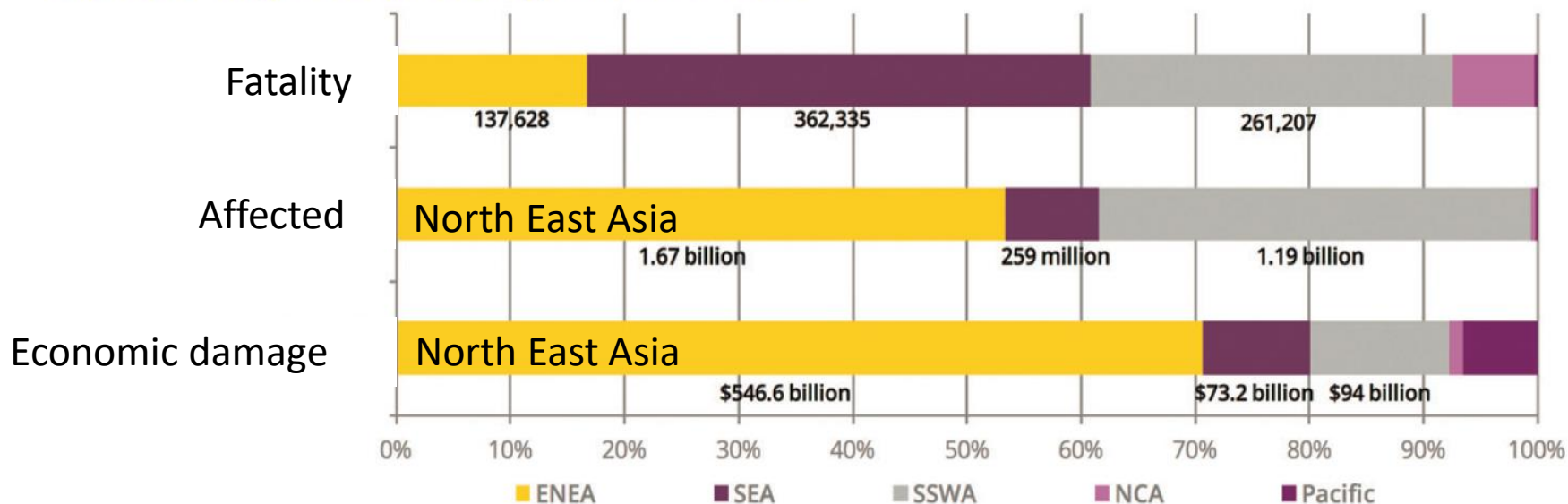

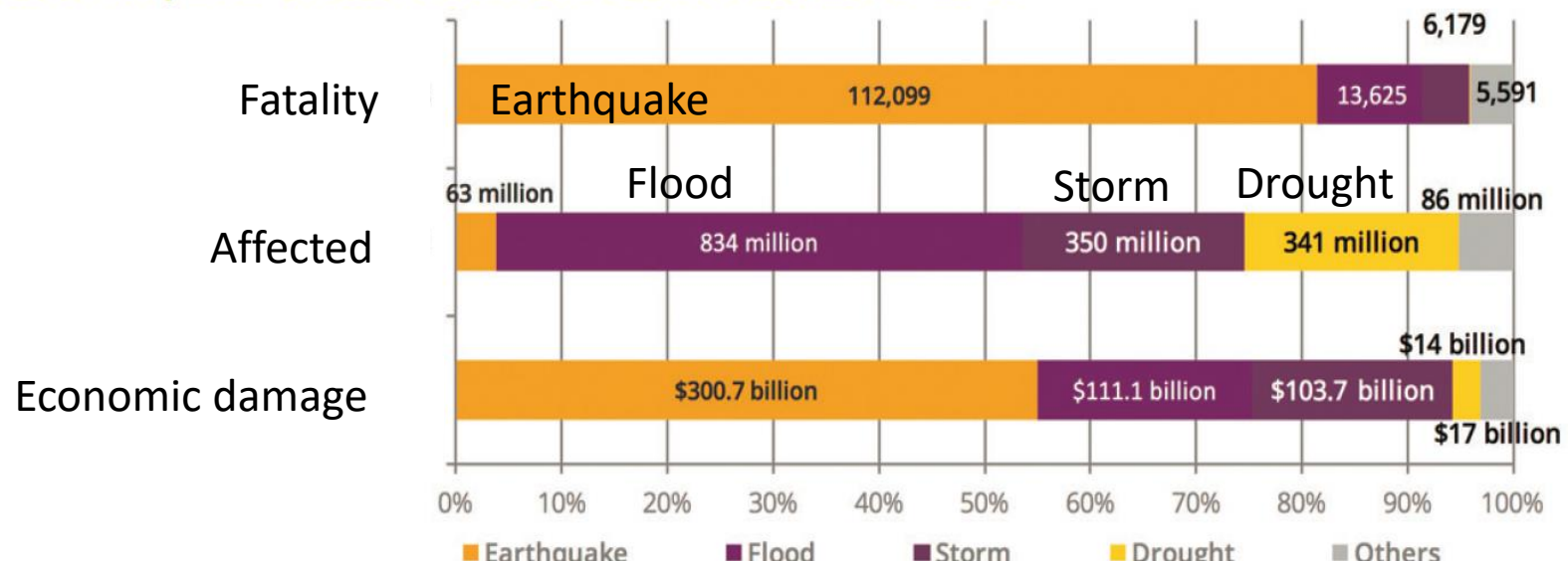
