CCTF'S COMPLETED TASKS

11 normative acts draft decrees of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan were drafted and submitted:

6 normative acts have been approved



1 is under consideration of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan



4 are under consideration of the relevant ministries and agencies



CCTF'S COMPLETED TASKS

The Action Plan for reduction of time and costs of enterprises for export, import and transit of goods was approved (Decree of the Government of Tajikistan from 31 May 2018, #286)

Customs Service was appointed as a coordinating body for the transit actions (Decree of the Government of Tajikistan from 25 December 2017, #580).

Amendments to the Customs Code (under revision of ministries and agencies) were approved;

New import customs duties were approved (Decree of the Government of Tajikistan from 8 August 2018, #399);

CCTF'S COMPLETED TASKS

Roadmap of the Committee was developed

Program on development of transport services was prepared and sent for consideration of the ministries and agencies

Categorization of the obligations of Tajikistan under the WTO TFA was prepared and would be notified to the WTO Secretariat

With the support of the development partners Tajikistan Trade Portal was established
