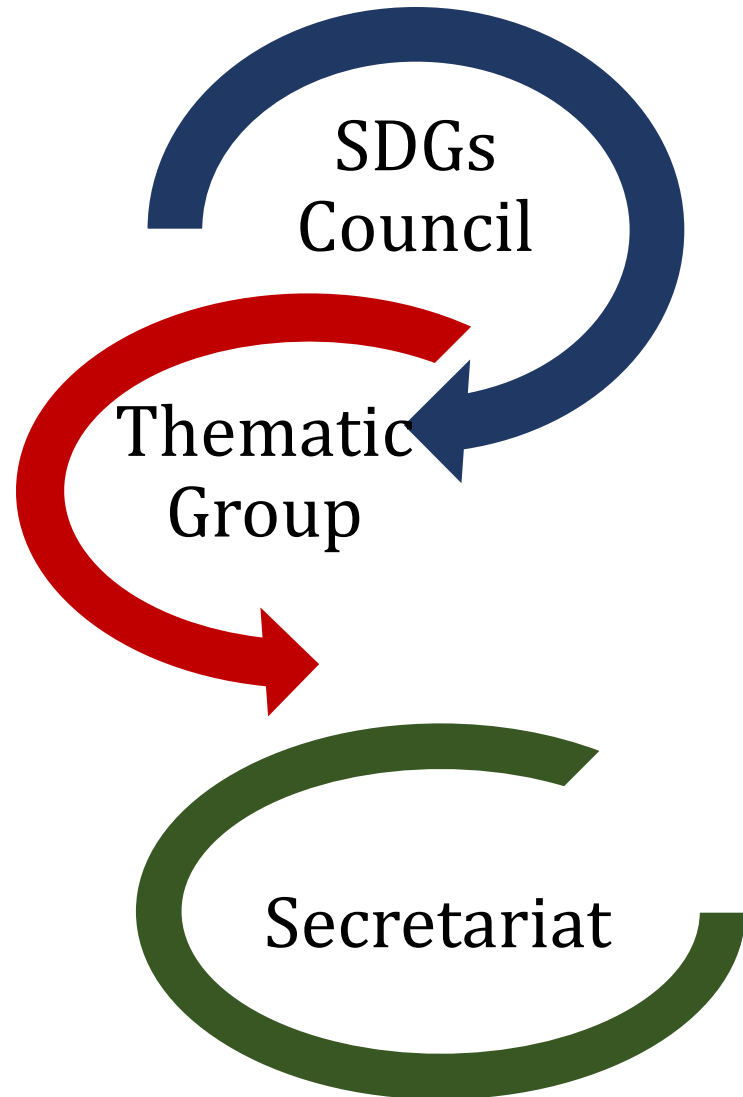

1. Baseline and Target (2030) Indicators



16.1 Reduce all forms of violence and related death rates everywhere

- **2015:** 16.1.1 118 victims (Criminal code of Georgia, Article 108- murder, Article 109);
- **2030:** 16.1.1 Number of victims of intentional homicide per 100,000 population, by sex and age, reduced by 10-15% by 2030, relative to baseline



8.5 By 2030, implement effective state policy in order to achieve productive employment and decent work for all women and men, including for young people and persons with disabilities, and equal pay for work of equal value

- **2015 :** 8.5.1 Average hourly earnings of females - 3.9 GEL;
Average hourly earnings of males - 6.1 GEL
- **2030 :** 8.5.1 Average hourly earnings of females - 14.4 GEL
Average hourly earnings of males - 17.4 GEL
- **2015:** 8.5.2 Unemployment rate 2015, total - 12.0%; women 10.2%; men 13.5%;
- **2030:** 8.5.2 Unemployment rate by 2030 - 9.5%

2. Baseline and Target (2030) Indicators



1.1 By 2030, eradicate extreme poverty for all people everywhere in Georgia, currently measured as people living on less than \$1.9 a day

- **2014:** 1.1.1: Proportion of population living under extreme poverty: 2014: 9.77%;
- **2030:** 1.1.1: Proportion of population living below the international poverty line: < 1 %

1.4 By 2030, ensure that all men and women, in particular the poor and the vulnerable have access to basic services

- **2015:** 1.4.1: About 99% of households have access to electricity; About 68% of households have access (active consumers) to natural gas;
- **2030:** 1.4.1: Almost 100% of households will have access to electricity; About 75% of households will have access (active consumers) to natural gas

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4.4 By 2030, increase by 85% per cent the number of youth and adults who have relevant skills, including technical and vocational skills, for employment, decent jobs and entrepreneurship

- **2015:** 4.4.1 47% of graduates were employed or self-employed;
- **2030:** 4.4.1 Over 60% of VET graduates are employed/self-employed

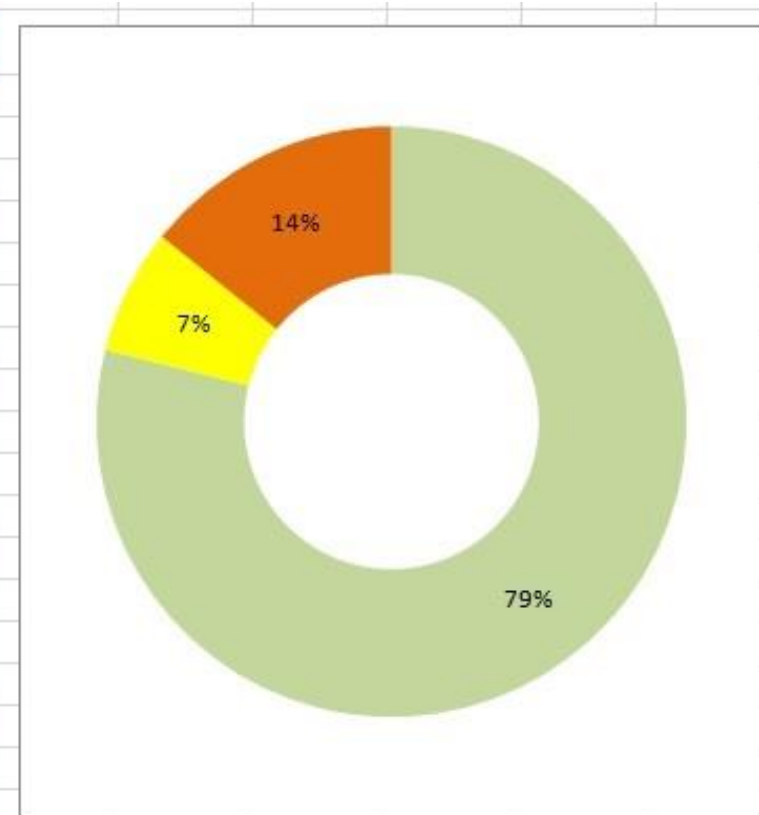
