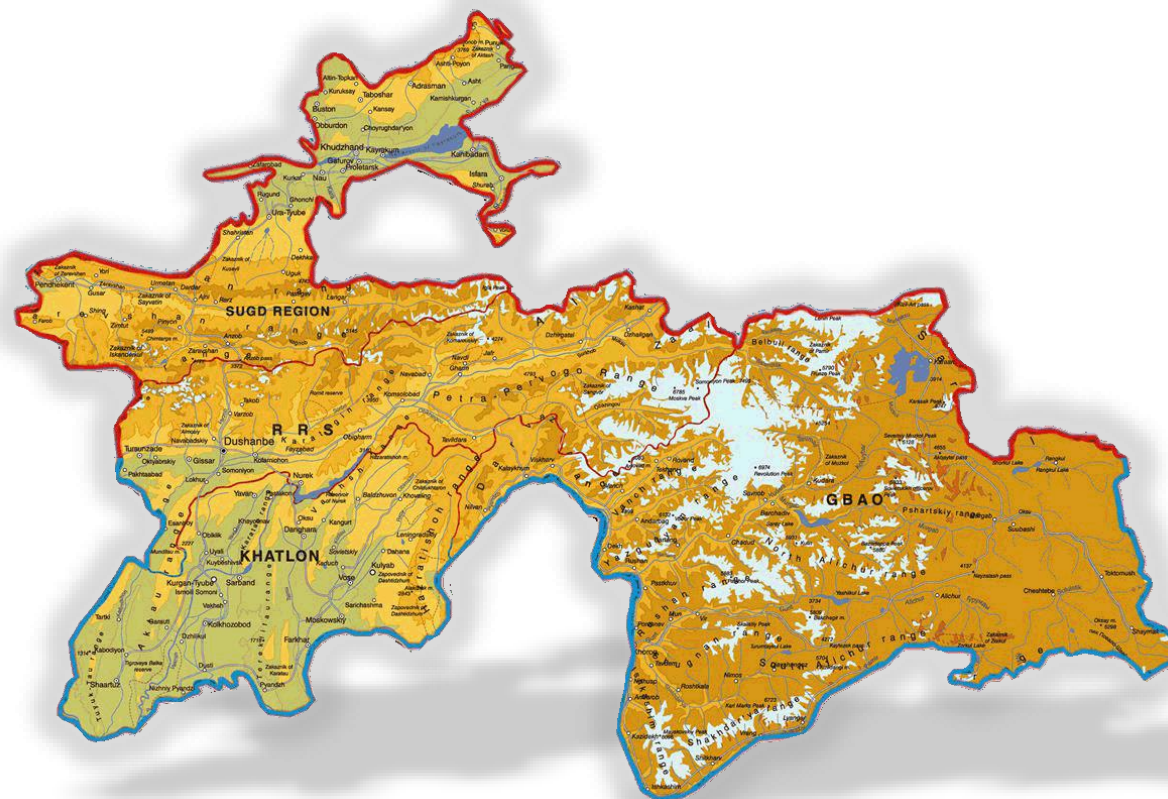

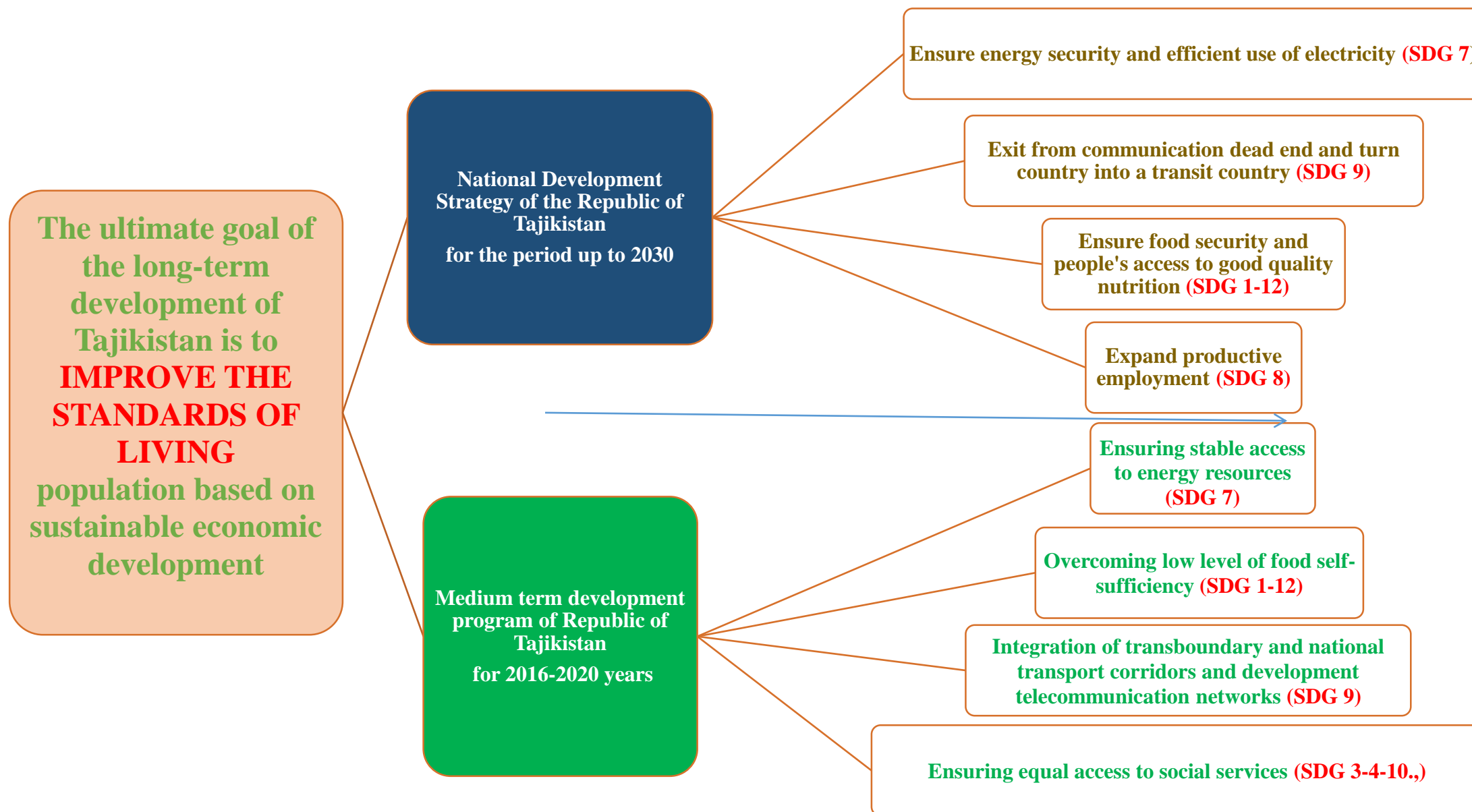

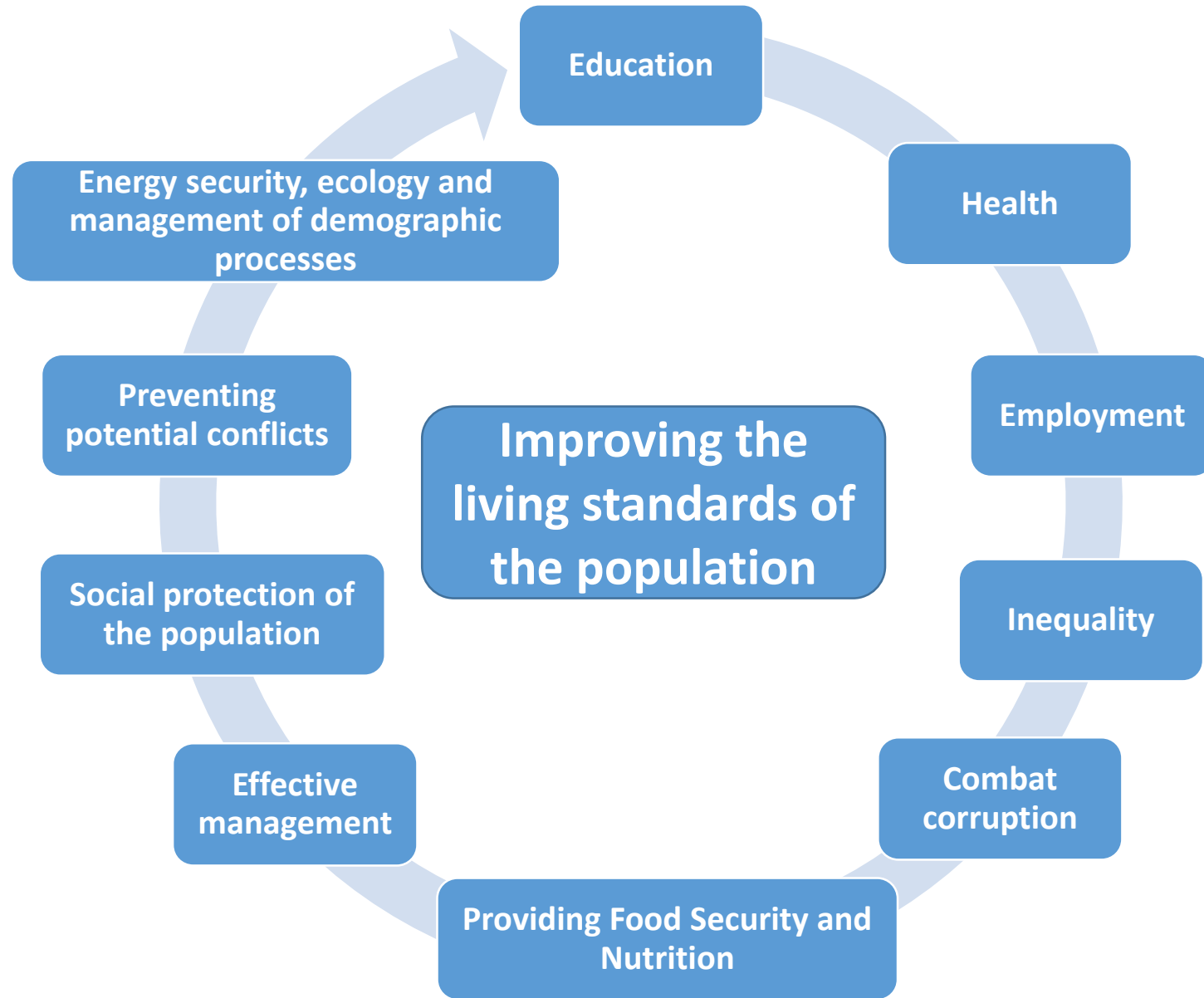


The Republic of Tajikistan is in the Central Asia, with more than 93% of the territory covered by mountains. The population of the country is 9 million. 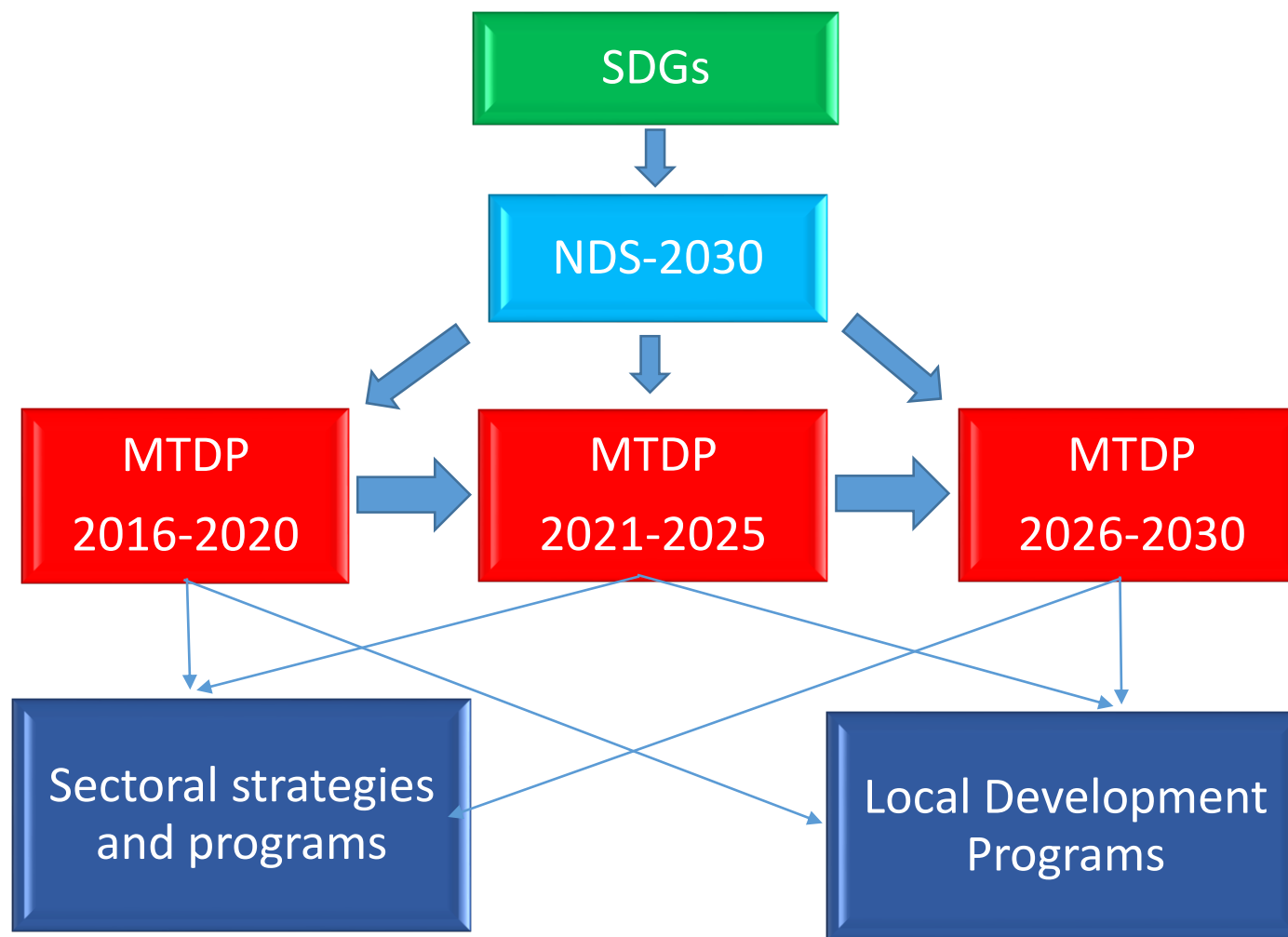
Tajikistan in 2030



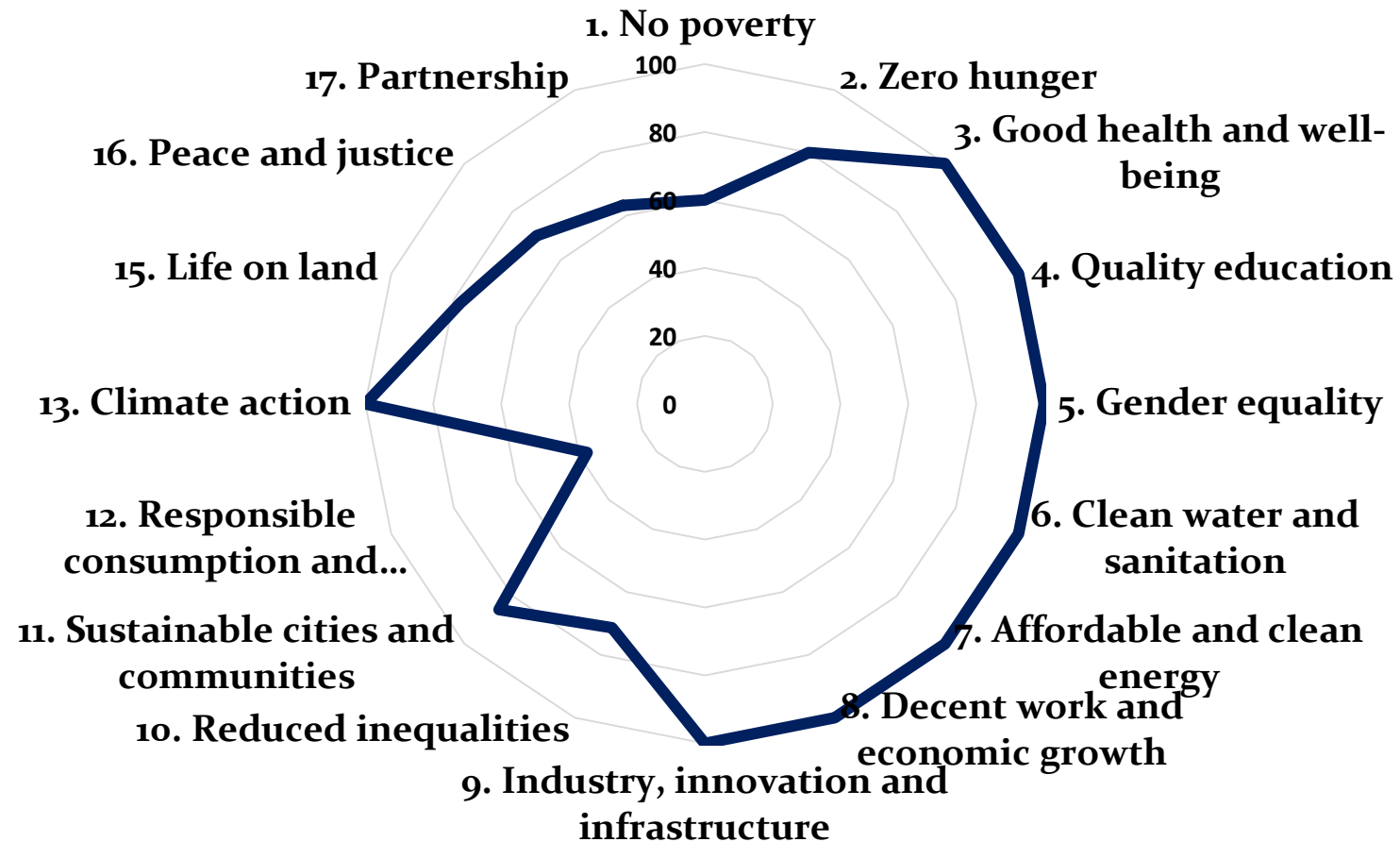
The main priorities of the NDS-2030



Integration system of the SDG into the strategic documents of the country



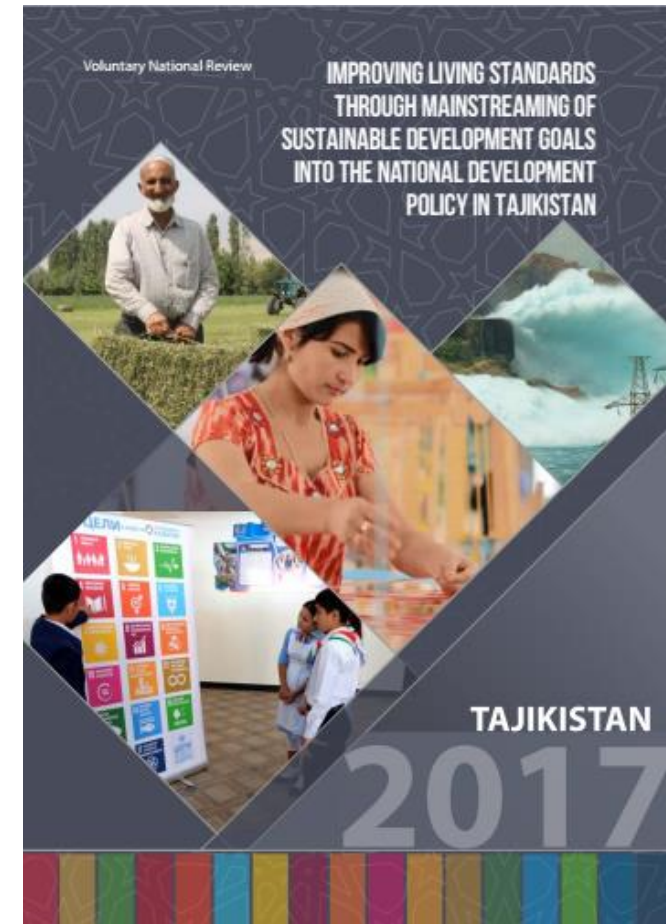

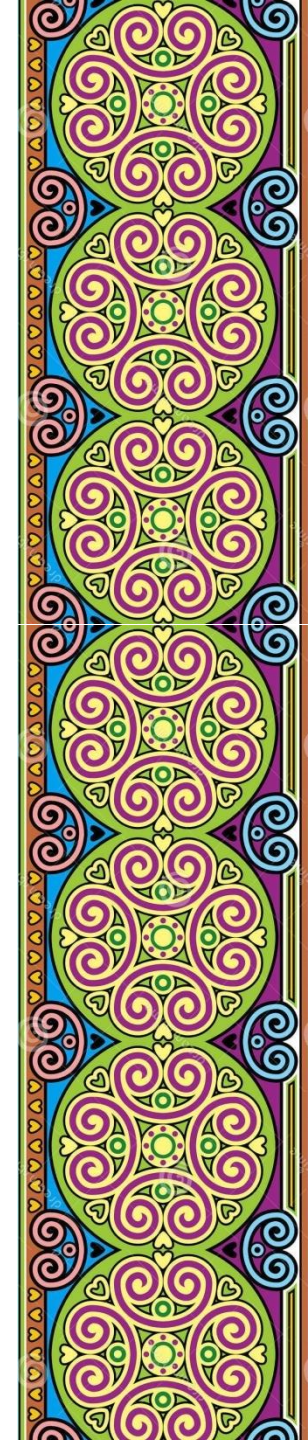
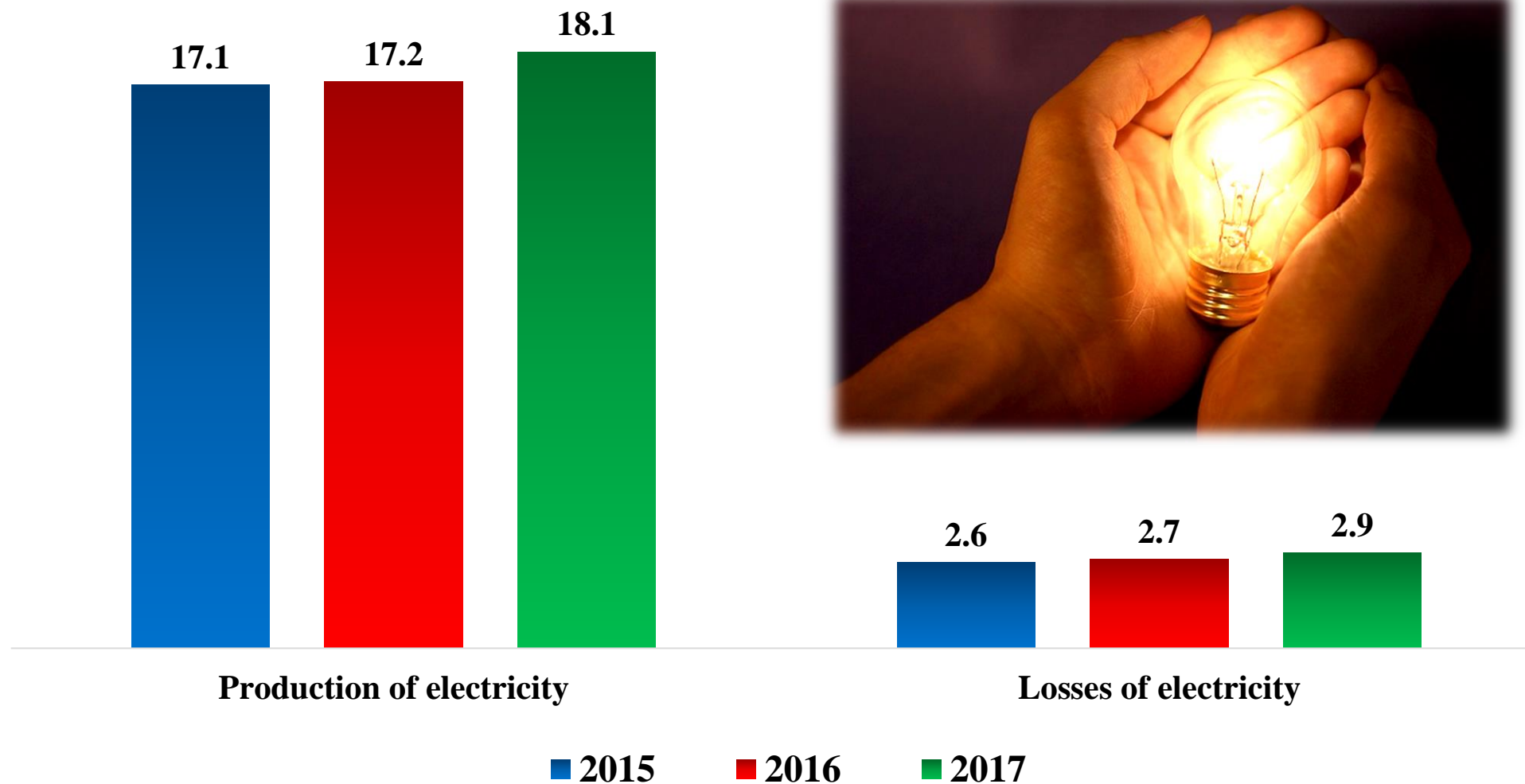

Two strategic goals are reviewed:

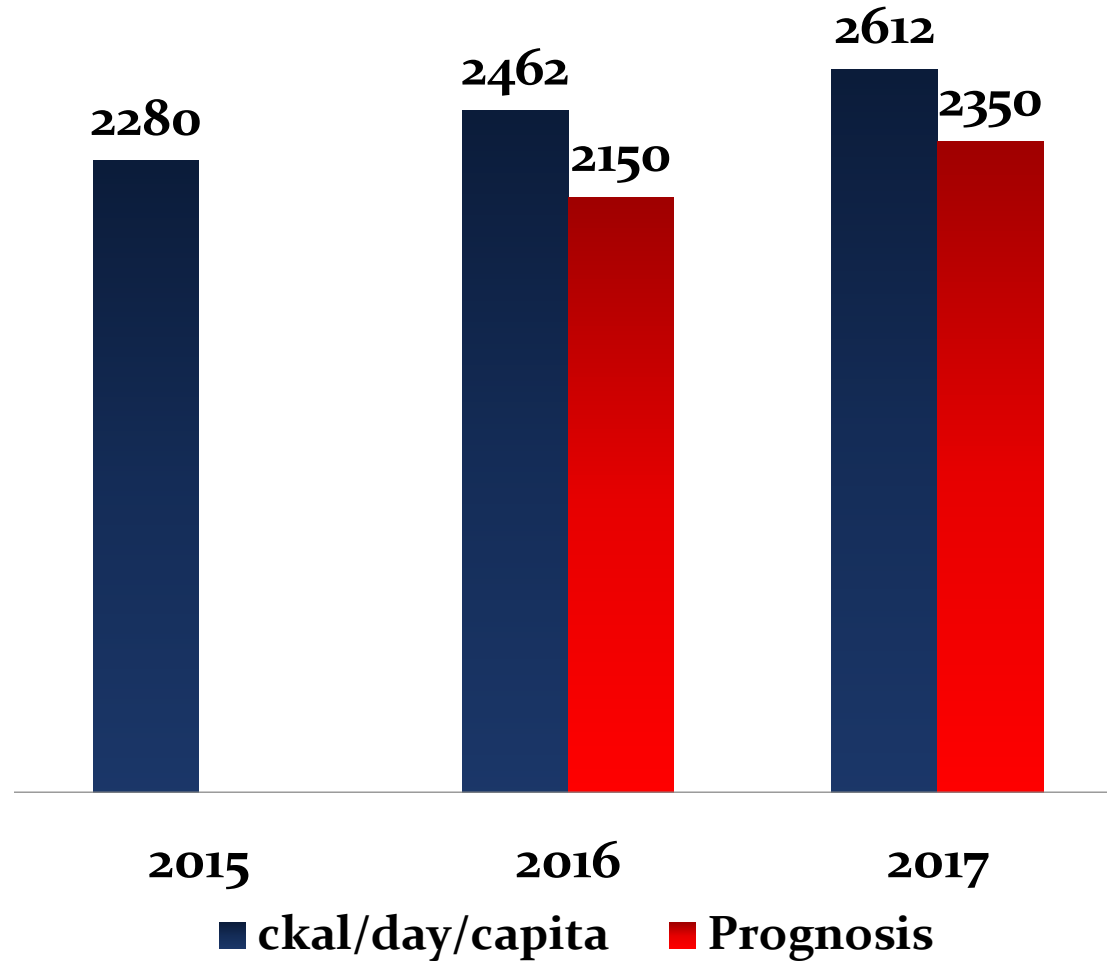
1. Ensuring energy security and efficient use of electricity;
2. Ensuring food security and people's access to a good quality nutrition.



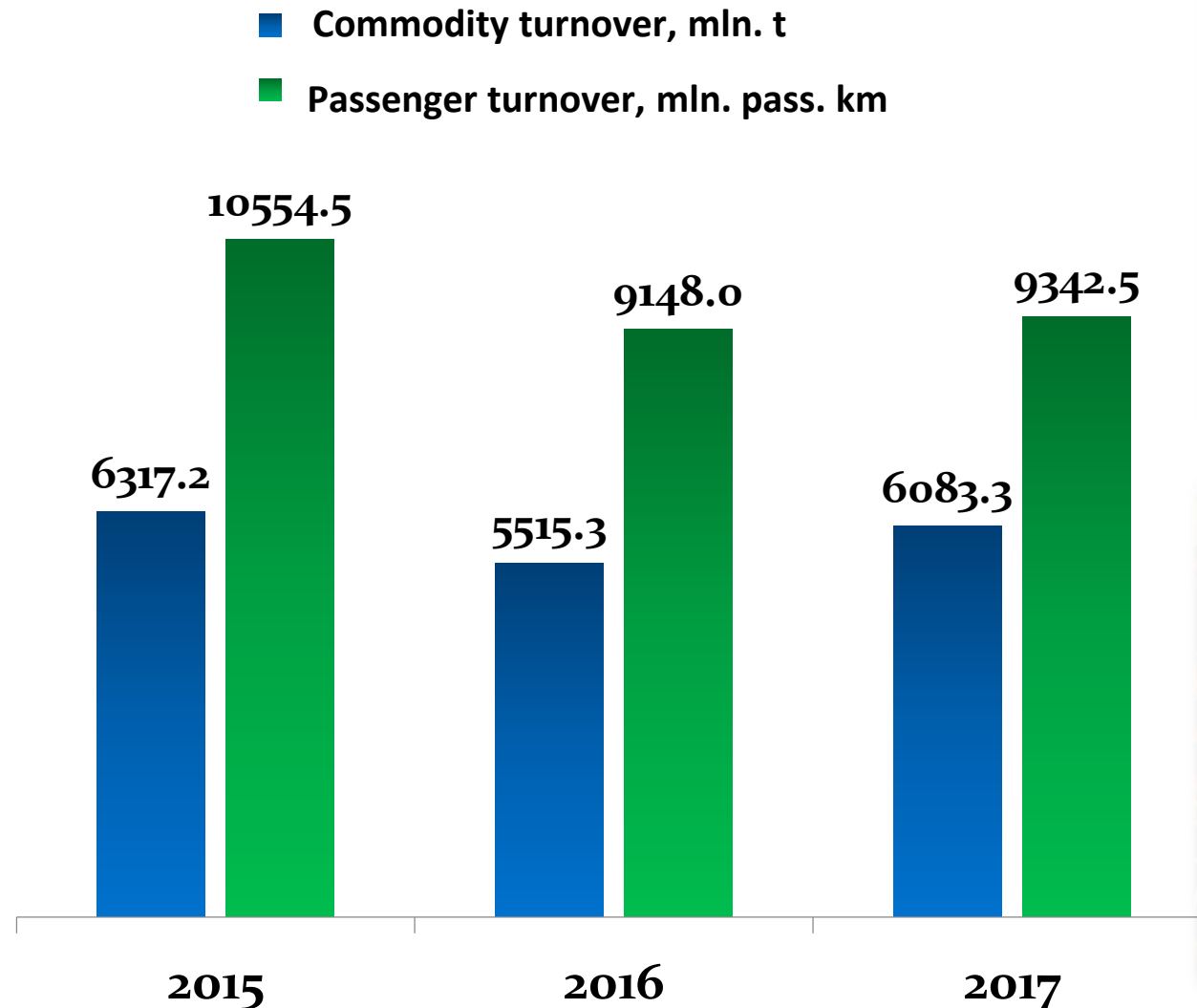
Production and losses of electricity (bln. kWt/h)



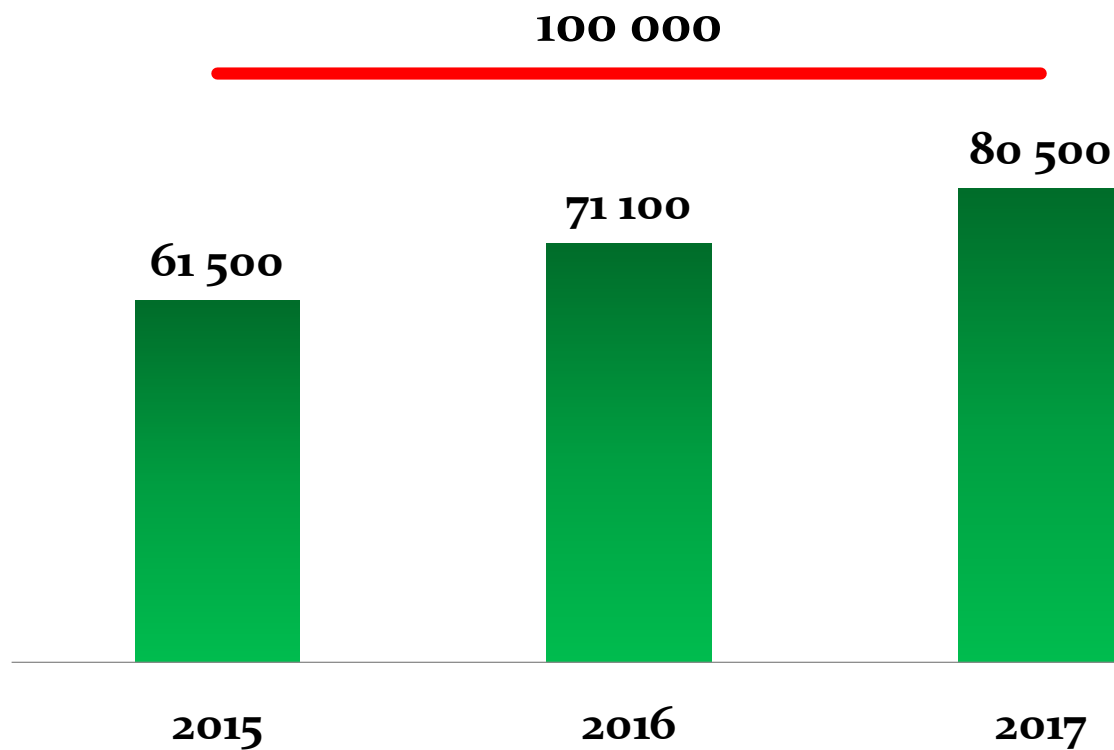
Calorie intake (kcal/day/capita)



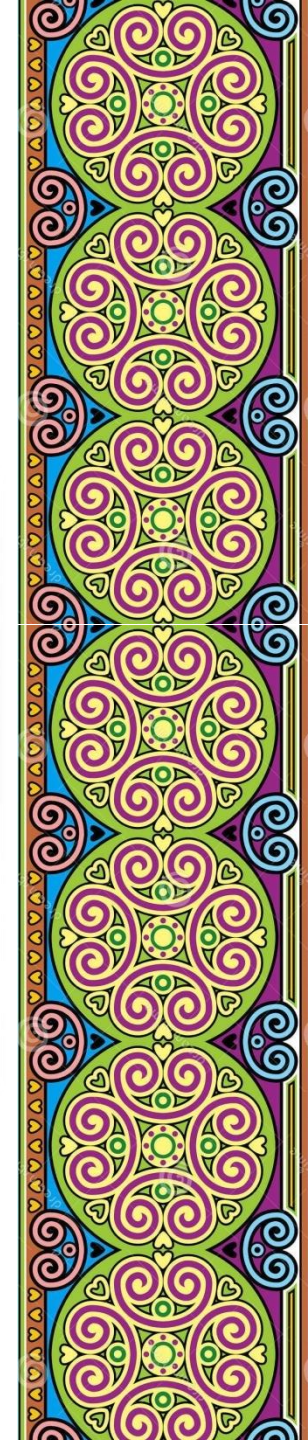
Total amount of commodity turnover and passenger turnover



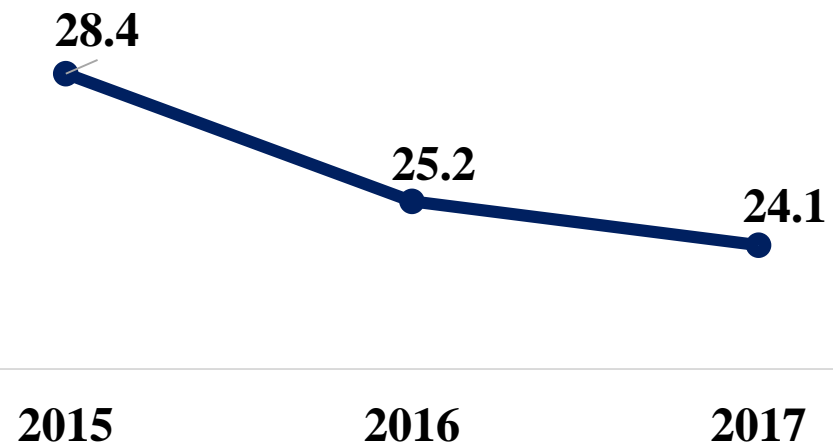
New permanent jobs creation



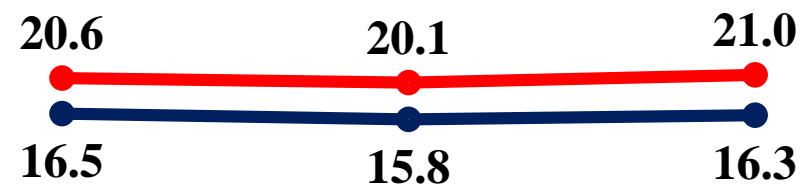
- New permanent jobs created

Maternal mortality (per 100,000 live births)



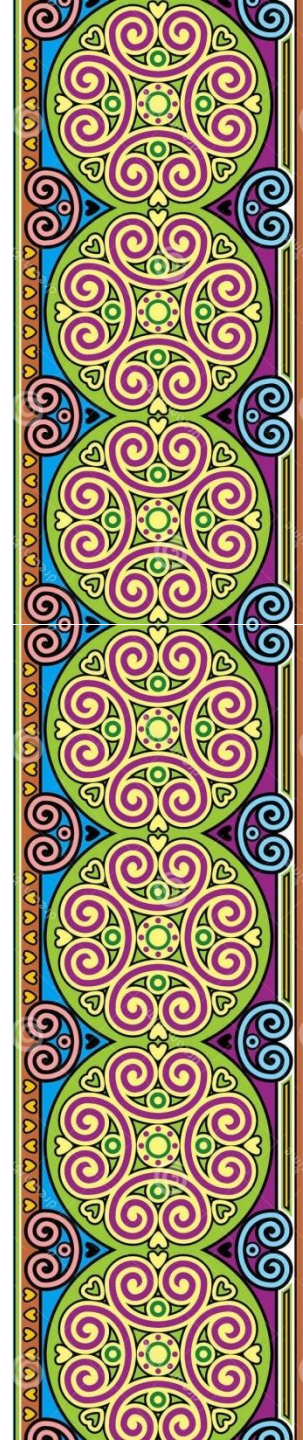
Child mortality (per 1000 live births)



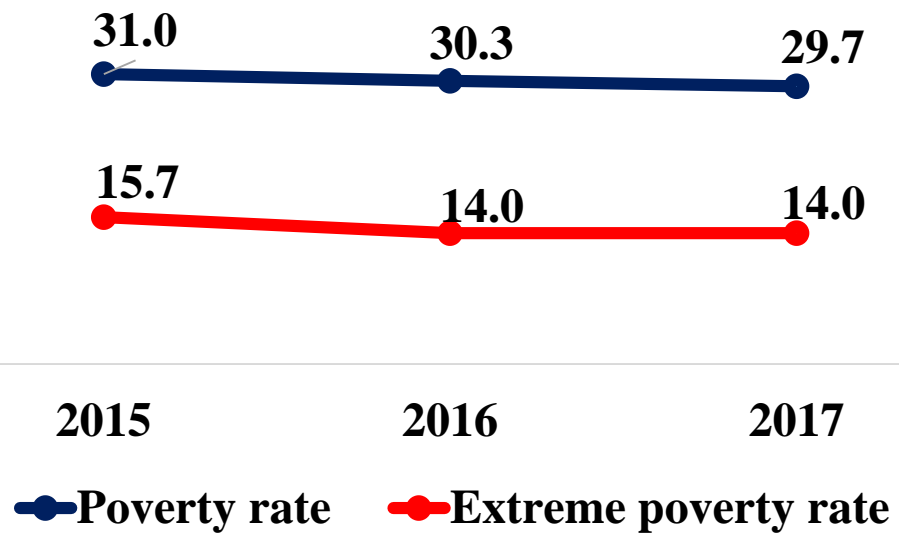

● Child mortality under 1 year

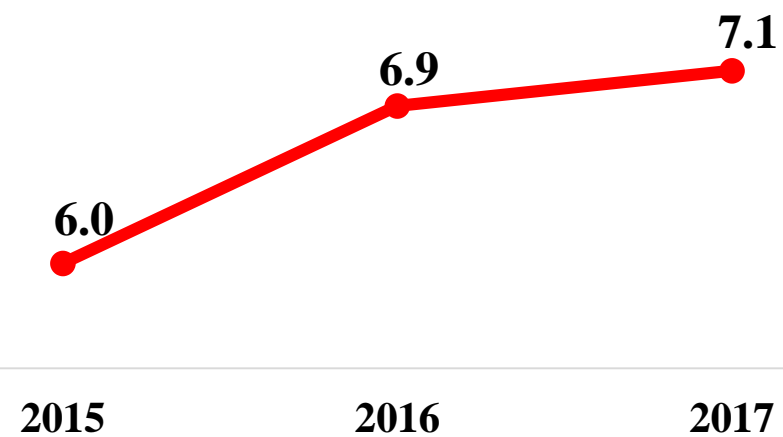
● Child mortality under 5 years
